



1st Grade E-Day Assignments

Choose one Reading, one Writing AND one Math Assignment.

The pencil and paper assignments should be turned in once they come back to school. Additionally, our weekly HW and phonics skill will be posted on Class Dojo to refer to.

WRITING

- Draw a picture about anything. Write 4 sentences about the picture.
- Draw a picture about what you did on your snow day. Write 4 sentences about the picture.
- Have the Student write out the alphabet and numbers 1-20 from memory. Correct any backwards letters or numbers and have them practice writing the backwards/wrong ones 15 times each.
- Have them write out any words from their current ufl phonics skill (on class dojo) or any spelling words from their previous units.

READING

- Spend 15 minutes reading a book at home. Write the book(s) down that your child read to you along with your signature.
- Go on a word treasure hunt. Have the student pick a book (any book will do) and write down ten words they can read and 10 words they can't read yet.

MATH

- Practice addition problems with 2 dice - adding the rolled numbers together. Write the problems down on paper and turn it in. (*do 10 to 20 problems*)
- Practice subtraction problems with 2 dice - subtracting the smaller number from the larger number. Write the problems down on paper and turn it in. (*do 10 to 20 problems*)
- Practice even and odd numbers with skittles or m&m's (*or anything you can count*). Get 10 - 20 items, have the student group it into 2. Say a number, have the student put that many out. Have him/her tell you whether it's even or odd. Have him/her write the number down and write if the number is even or odd. Write out the numbers that you did and turn it in. **Do at least 15 practices.**
