All games will begin at 3:30 unless other arrangements have been made between competing schools. There will only be one squad per school at this time. Games will consist of 4 – 12 minute quarters with at least 6 minutes at half time. No more than 7 players will be on the field at any time. A size 5 regulation soccer ball will be used. Field dimensions should be at least 40ft. by 75 ft. and soccer goals should be at least 14ft. by 7ft. All other rules of AYSO U-12 soccer will be in effect, including no heading and goalies cannot kick a ball directly into the goal of the opposing team. **Each home team is responsible for providing 1 official for every game**. In the case of a neutral field, the 2nd team listed will be the home team. Coaches will be responsible for providing support as line judges.
