1 pair of loon is on the lake and the female is nesting. Loons are protected and need to be given a proper amount of space by all boats and people. 2 Eaglets are again in the nest

It was decided to forgo lake grants for a shed for the Federal Campground and continue to store materials for the Clean Boats program at Martins dock.

#### Best Practices

Property owners need to continue to be aware of the chemical use near the water. Informational flyers were distributed.
