General Business:

Christopher Haun, President, called the meeting to order and welcomed attendees.

Attendees introduced themselves. We have 5 new members.

Old Business:

Lake Water Quality

Paul Martin reported on lake water quality monitoring. Water clarity improved from last year. The disk was only visible to a depth of 10 feet, as opposed to a depth of 7 feet last year. The lake usually greens up some in July but clears by September. Phosphates in lawn fertilizer which are detrimental to water quality are now prohibited by law.

Lake Birds, Loon Watch

The ice was out on the lake 4-30-14. The loons returned to the lake and are nesting on their usual island in the northwest bay. The eagles were observed nesting in their old place along the shore north of Traxel's Point. Baby eagles were also observed. Stuart Armstrong also noticed an increase of ducks on the lake in early spring. Probably due to the lake opening earlier than most of the other area lakes.

Buoys

Doug Traxel reported that the buoys will be placed today. Doug also reported that the buoys are in good shape. Jim Martin stated that the rock buoy was already in.

Aquatic Invasive Species

Stuart Armstrong gave an update on the aquatic invasive weeds in the lake. In early May Stuart found about 4-5 Eurasian Milfoil plants in the weed bed in front of Echo Valley Campgrounds. He suggested having scuba divers pull the weeds because of the depth of the water. He would look into that option. A hand pulling effort will also be organized at the Echo Valley docks for 6-14-14. Stuart also observed Eurasian Milfoil between some of the docks at the campgrounds. He also alerted everyone to the areas to be looking for the Milfoil when out on the lake. The shallow bays and shoreline are the places to most easily observe the plants. Stuart also applied for additional money from the DNR for the boat landing monitoring and hand pulling projects. He has an application in for \$1,010.34. A fall survey of the lake will also be conducted.

Conservation Warden Lee Posusta gave a short speech on the boat landing monitoring and introduce himself as our DNR contact. No wake hours were also discussed and was decided by all present to keep the hours as they are posted at the boat landing. Mark Dodge will contact Amanda Strick regarding towels, brochures and bobbers for volunteers to hand out at boat landings as part of the effort to educate boaters on the importance of cleaning boats that are moved form one lake to another so as not to spread AIS. Vern & Nancy Romsos agreed to coordinate volunteers to be at the federal campground landing on the July 4th weekend.

Zebra Mussel Discs

Zebra mussel discs were hung on Martin's and Traxel's docks after the ice went out. They were there all summer and had no mussels on them. Mark Dodge will also put out a disc on his dock this year.
