General Business:

Lake Water Quality

Paul Martin reported on lake water quality monitoring. Water clarity was about the same as last year. The disk was visible to a depth of 11.5 feet. The lake is monitored in the months of May, June, July and August.

Lake Birds, Loon Watch

The loons returned to the lake and are nesting on their usual island in the northwest bay. On or about May 16th two eggs were layed in the nest. With the black flies being so bad the loons did not set on them. Two eagles were observed nesting in their old place along the shore north of Traxel's Point.

Buoys

Tom Grabow has taken over the task of setting out and taking in the buoys. Tom was helped this year by Doug Traxel. Some buoys were upgraded and #4 had the lid replaced. A total of \$25.34 was spent on repairs to the buoys The stenciling on some bouys is fadding and should be upgraded so we are covered for liability reasons. Tom is to check on pricing. Jim Tilkens mentioned Sawyer lake made their own buoys. Jim was going to check on the cost of making our own bouys. Thank you Tom & Doug.

Aquatic Invasive Species

Stuart Armstrong gave an update on the aquatic invasive weeds in the lake. Our grant expired on 12-31-15. The survey we had done found no weeds. Weather conditions can hinder the survey of weeds and it was discussed how accurate a survey really is. Homeowners are still our best tool for spotting the milfoil. It was stated that the DNR made comment that it was a bad year for the growing of milfoil. Stuart Armstrong observed one milfoil plant at Echo Valley and two plants south of Jim & Janet Tilkens. Stuart was going to mark the weed for everyone to get a chance to observe them in the water. It was also discussed to have someone contact the DNR and see what our options might be for additional funding. No one volunteered to contact the DNR at this time.

Zebra Mussel Discs

Zebra mussel discs were hung on Dodge's and Traxel's docks after the ice went out. They

were there all summer and had no mussels on them.

Fireworks Show

Jeff Seegmiller stated that \$800.00 was raised last year for the fireworks show. Of that \$600.00 was raised through donations. They are hoping to raise \$1000.00 this year for the fireworks show. Jeff also said we will have a pause in the show this year because they had an accident with the fireworks the year before. A motion was brought up to donate \$100.00 from the BLPHA.
