Jim Tilkens reported that making our own buoys would cost about \$100.00 for two bouys. That cost was inclusive of everything including the decals. Thank you Tom, Richard, Jim and Doug.

Aquatic Invasive Species

We had a lengthy and varied discussion at the meeting regarding the evasive species in the lake. The eurasian milfoil was the topic that was discussed in greatest detail. Stuart Armstrong did report that the few plants that were observed last year south of the Tilken's dock have gotten much bigger. He stated that he would remove them soon but if anyone wanted to observe them in the lake that now was a good time to check it out before they are removed. We also had two DNR Wardens attend our meeting. Andy Dryja and John Press informed us on many topics which included all the evasive species for us to be aware of. They also informed us on our options regarding the enforcement of the lake rules. Doug Traxel and Richard Geurts attended the Oconto County Lakes and Waterways Association meeting. The BLPHA joined OCLAWA last year. They reported on what they learned regarding lake funding/grant options and fund raising. We learned we have more options regarding funding our continued evasive species issues than we had previously thought.
