
Many, perhaps most, people are not saved. Seek life eternal, trust in God and turn to the Lord for true hope!

## Five things you need to know to live forever!

1. Those who believe in Jesus Christ will find eternal life.

John 6:40 For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son <u>and believes in him</u> should have eternal life, and I will raise him up on the last day."

Romans 6:5 For if we have been united with him [through baptism] in a death like his, we shall certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.

 The <u>only way</u> to have a valid, life-saving relationship with God is through His son, Jesus Christ.
John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. <u>No one</u> comes to the Father <u>except through me.</u>

## 3. To be saved from death by Jesus Christ we must "repent and be baptized."

Acts 2:37-38 ... and [the Jews] said to Peter and the rest of the apostles, "Brothers, what shall we do?" And Peter said to them, "Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins,

4. Repentance is a <u>continual task</u> as we turn away from sinful ways to instead follow the ways of the Spirit.

Romans 6:13 Do not present your members to sin as <u>instruments</u> for <u>unrighteousness</u>, but present yourselves to God as those who have been brought from death to life, and your members to God as <u>instruments</u> for righteousness.

Galatians 5:22 But the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control;
