



Northwest Junior Football League Parent/Player Code of Conduct



As a condition of participation in any NJFL activity, parents and/or guardians agree to the following:

- Not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, opposing fan or parent such as booing, taunting or using profane language or gestures, etc. Parents/Guardians are responsible for the behavior for any guests they invite to any NJFL activity.
- Don't question an official's call. You may not agree with a call, but it's not your job (or the players or coaches either) to officiate the game. NEVER should an official's call be argued by a spectator.
- Consumption/being under the influence of alcohol, marijuana or any other drugs not specifically prescribed by your physician are banned from all NJFL activities and facilities, including parking lots.
- Smoking or use of tobacco products including cigarettes, cigars, smokeless tobacco or vape pens and other similar items are prohibited at all NJFL sites. If you need to smoke, you must completely leave the facility, including parking areas, prior to use.
- Act your age. If you find yourself becoming too emotionally involved in what's happening on the field, take a step back and relax. Remember, your childhood is over, game day is for the kids, let them enjoy it.
