

Front Yards

Now that the front yards are the responsibility of the homeowner, we would like to remind you that as the weather gets warmer, the fescue grass grows more rapidly. Please make sure you are maintaining your yard once a week.

For those of you who are going to artificial turf, please make sure that any trees that will be in the artificial turf have "ring" irrigation,

which is called Netafim. Netafim needs to be placed at a distance from the trunk of the tree, not at the base of the tree. This is not where the tree gets its water. As you can see from this picture the ring irrigation is 3' and 5' from the tree trunk.
