As Mayor and City Council, Rodney Elliott worked every day to take on the issues facing his constituents, and delivered results:

- ✓ **STIMULATING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:** Created the Downtown Economic Development Subcommittee to address challenges facing small businesses.
- ✓ **RESPONDING TO THE OPIOID CRISIS:** Created the Mayor's task force on opioids which brought together stakeholders to coordinate efforts to reduce opioid dependency and find innovative solutions to the issue.
