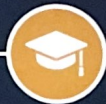

EDUCATION

Every young person in Massachusetts deserves access to a high quality education. Rodney will work to increase funding for the Massachusetts School Building Authority to improve aging school facilities. He will fight to ensure that our communities get their share of state funding to close achievement gaps and level the playing field for all students.



INFRASTRUCTURE

Crumbling roads and bridges in our district and across Massachusetts create public safety risks and contribute to traffic congestion. Rodney will seek increased investment in the state's Chapter 90 program to repave roads and sidewalks, and will advocate for overdue repairs to major bridges in our district.



MENTAL HEALTH

These challenges have grown worse as a result of the COVID-19 crisis. Rodney will work to improve the Commonwealth's failing mental health and substance use disorder treatment programs.
