Leon Prescott

A mysterious figure in the New Orleans underworld, Leon is many things... A boxing manager, a businessman, and an unreliable mentor. His shady actions are counterbalanced by his charisma and paternal nature towards the boys, leaving them unsure if he is to be trusted.



Cam

Jovial and light-hearted, Cam considers himself Brians best friend. Though comedic, Cam often corals the others with a lazer focus for a better life and success. Though down on his luck at the moment, Cam has the leadership qualities and ideas to be great with the right resources... often distracted by the other sex.

Von

Hotheaded with a mild case of head-up-assery, Von is the muscle of the group. A former athlete turned to a life of crime; he always seems to do the wrong things the right way. Getting his friends into worse situations, Von has to learn to unclench his fist and shut his mouth before he gets the whole squad killed.

Lucas

Kindhearted and soft spoken, Lucas was a former foster child who eventually aged out of the system. His intellect leaves him feeling often out of place, yet his brain often saves the boys where their braun could not. His heart is unflinching, and his loyalty to his crew is unquestionable.

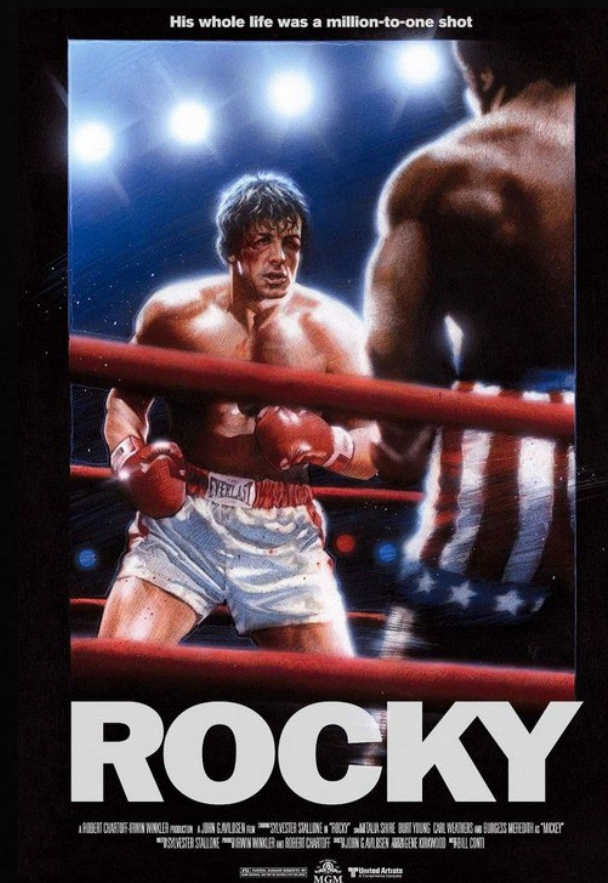

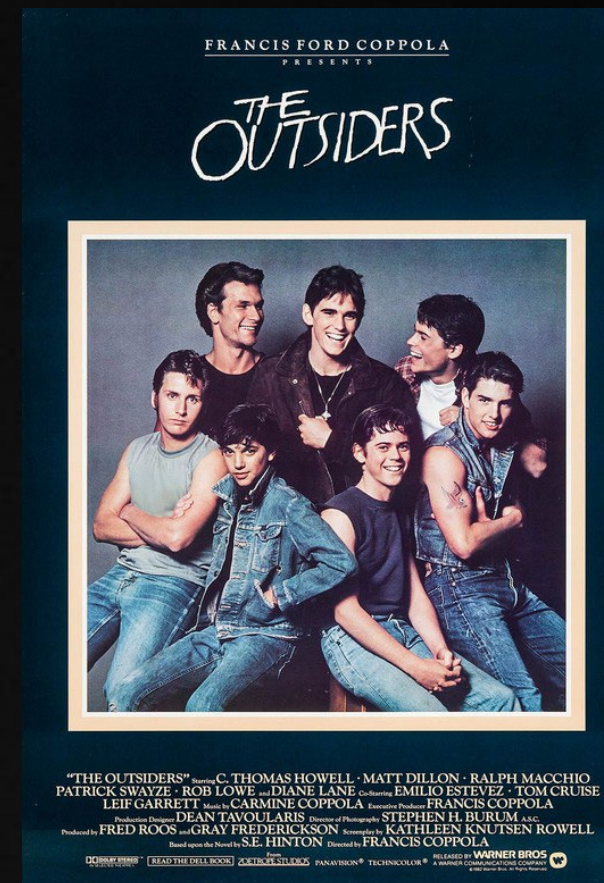
