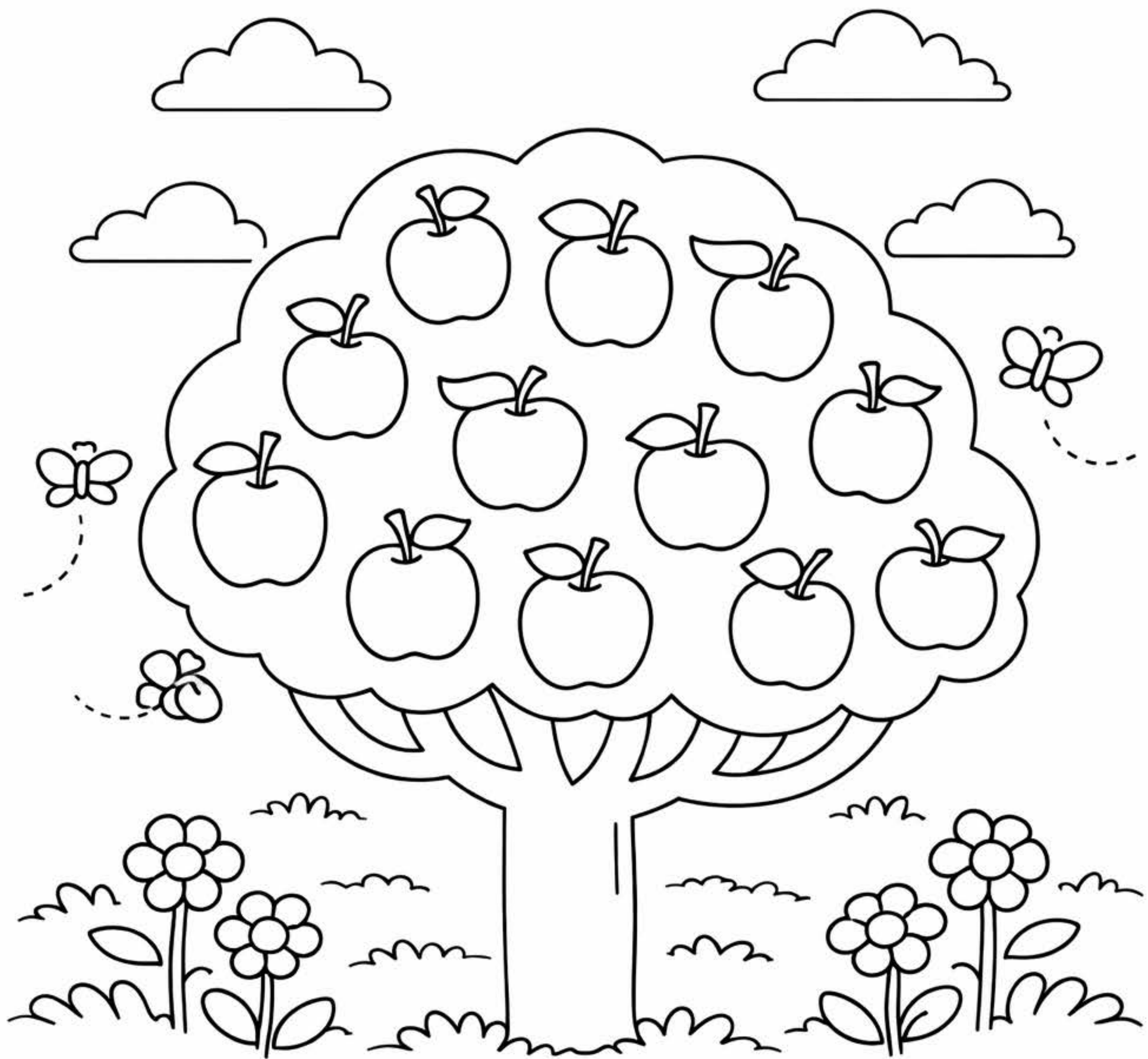
**This is our orchard. Can you find the

have space and sunshine.**



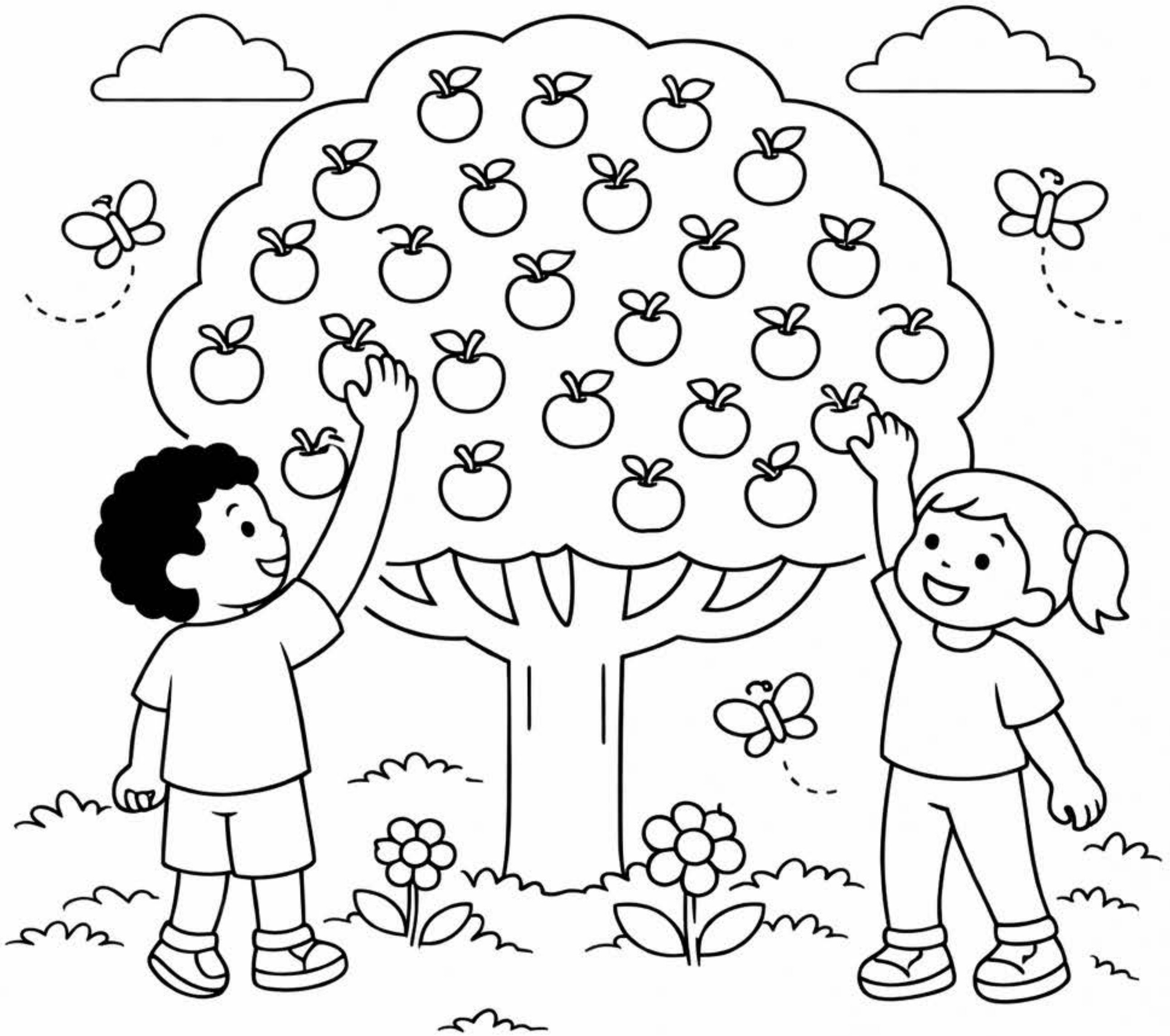

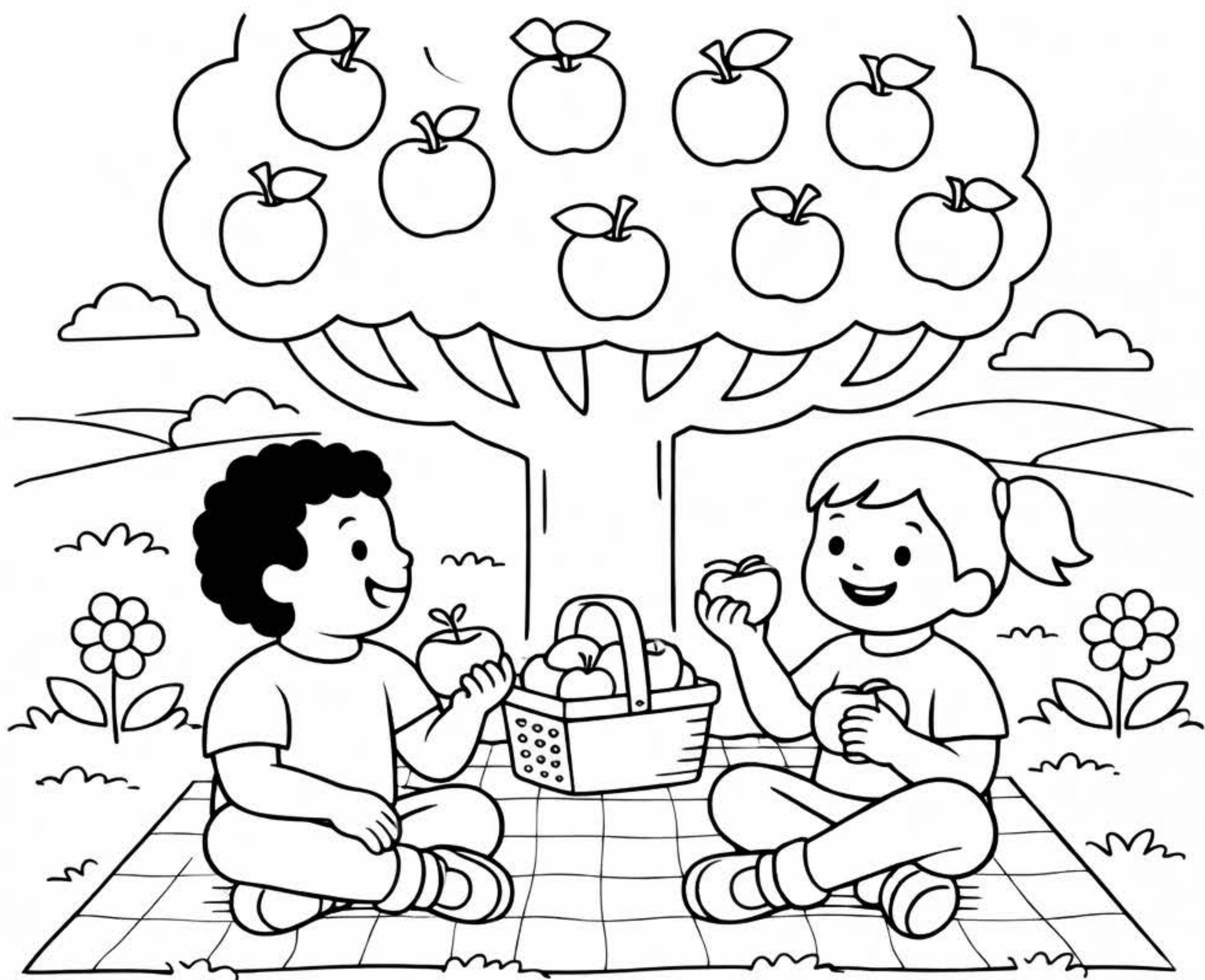
Galarina Apple Tree

Different apple trees grow different apples.

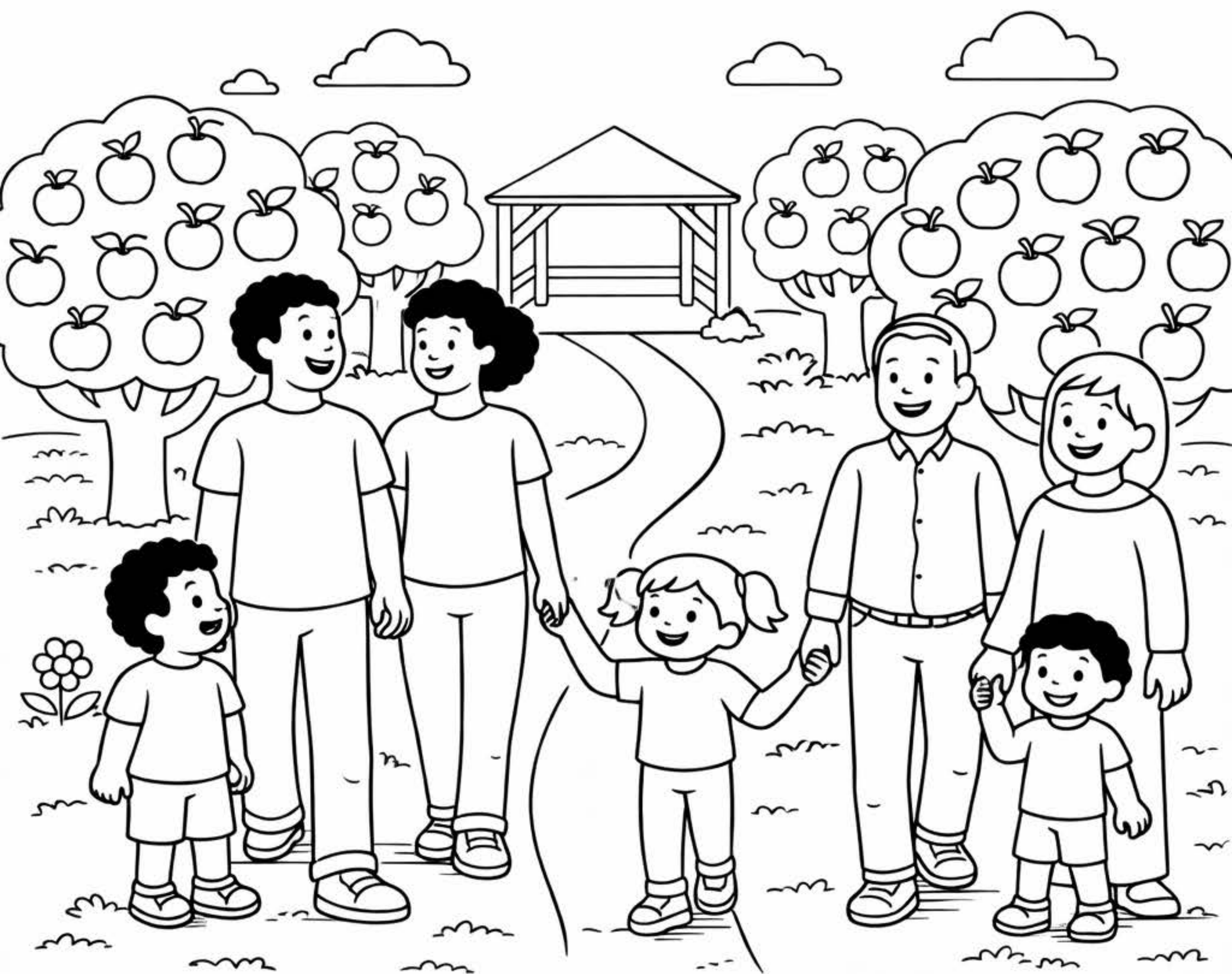
Pixie Crunch Apples



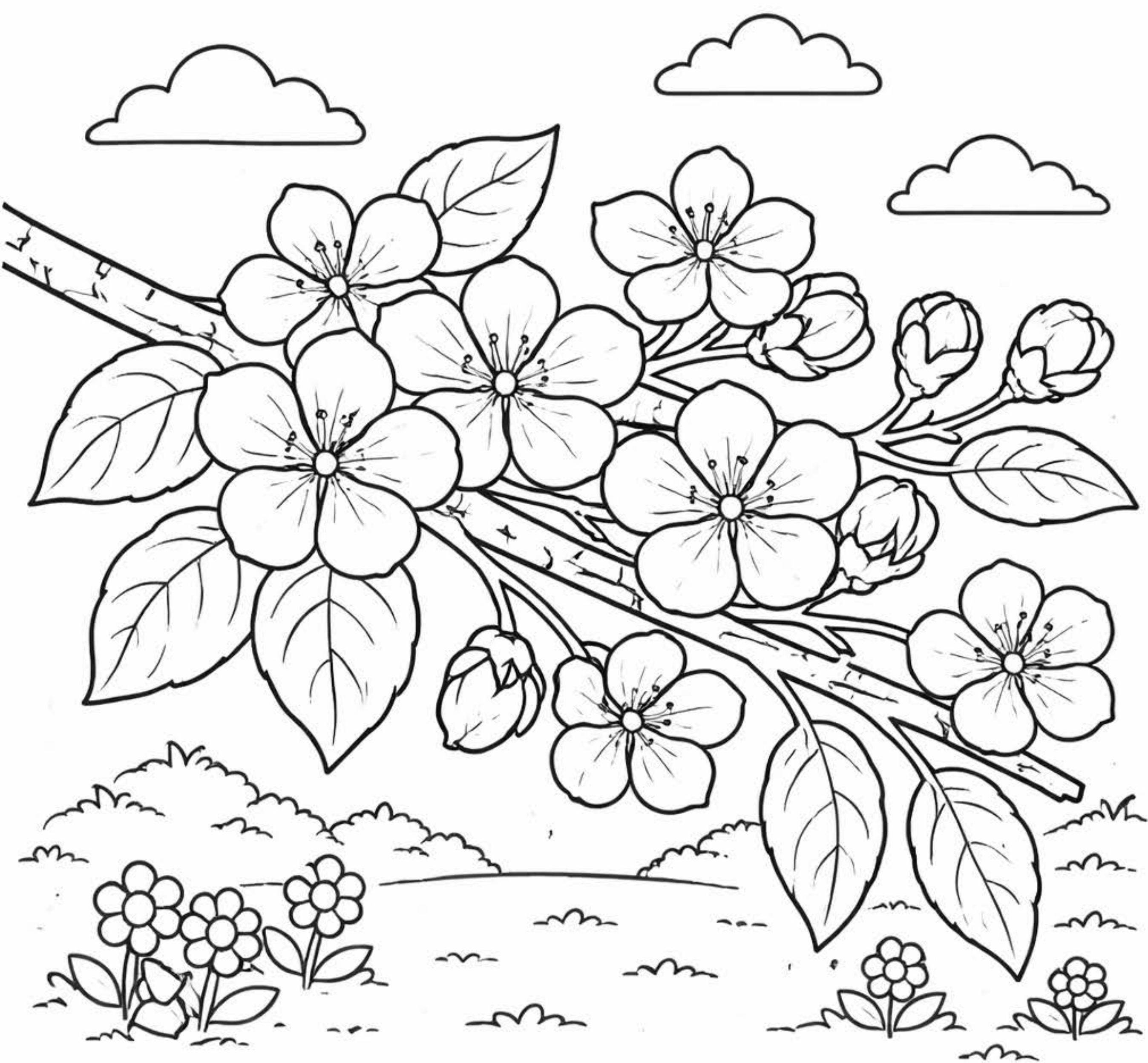
Tiny apples can be very crunchy!



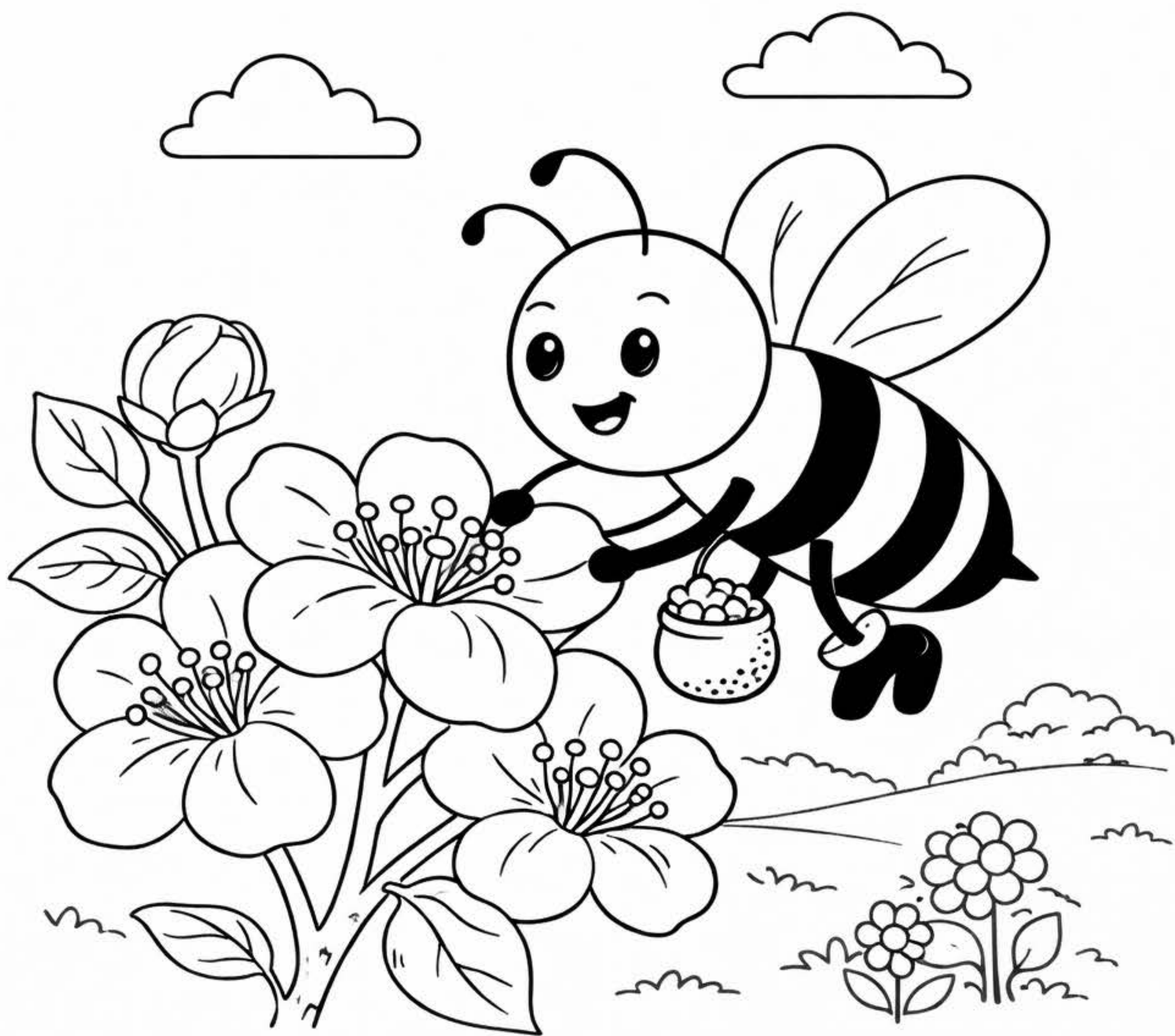
The orchard is a great place to rest and share.



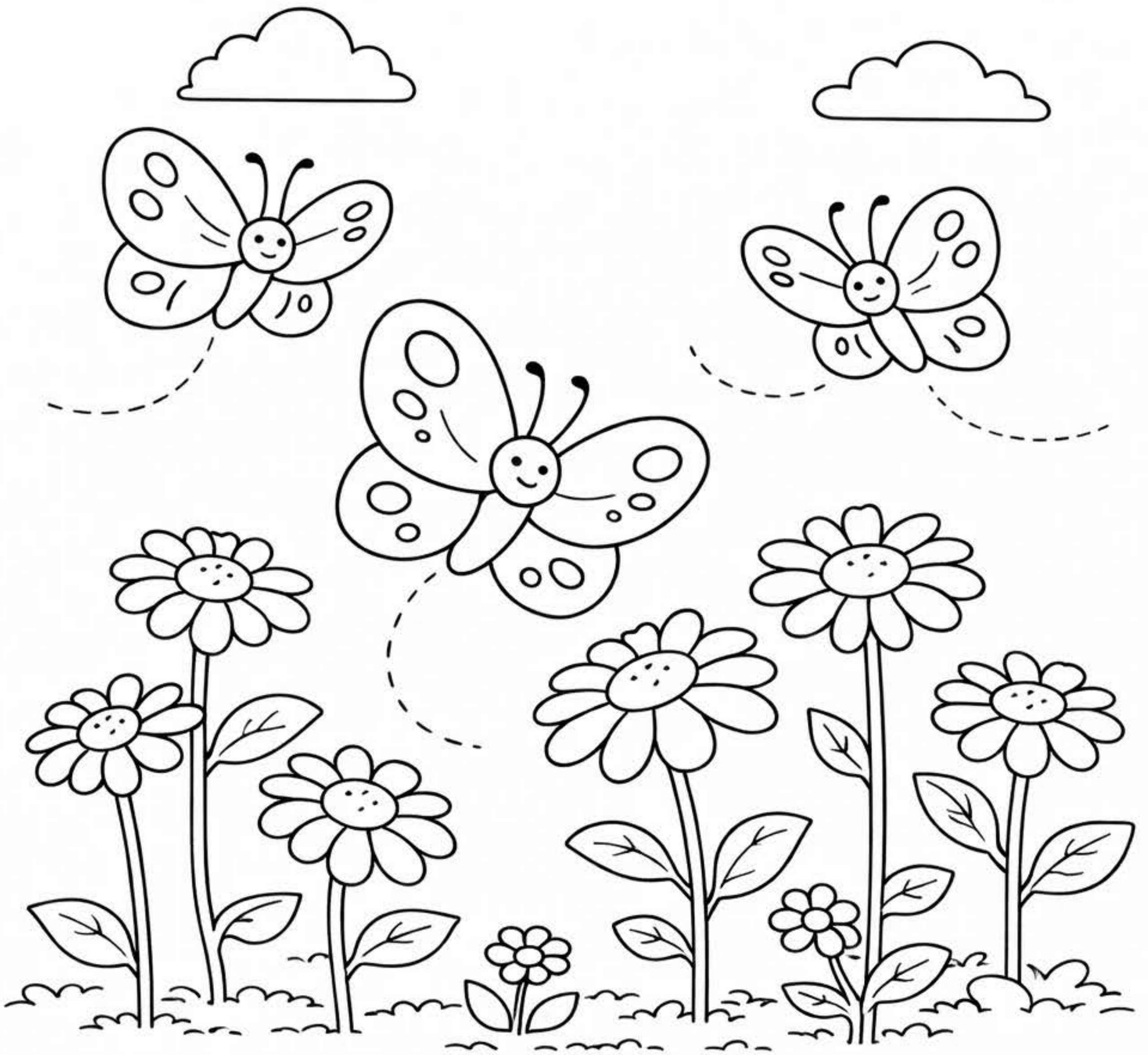

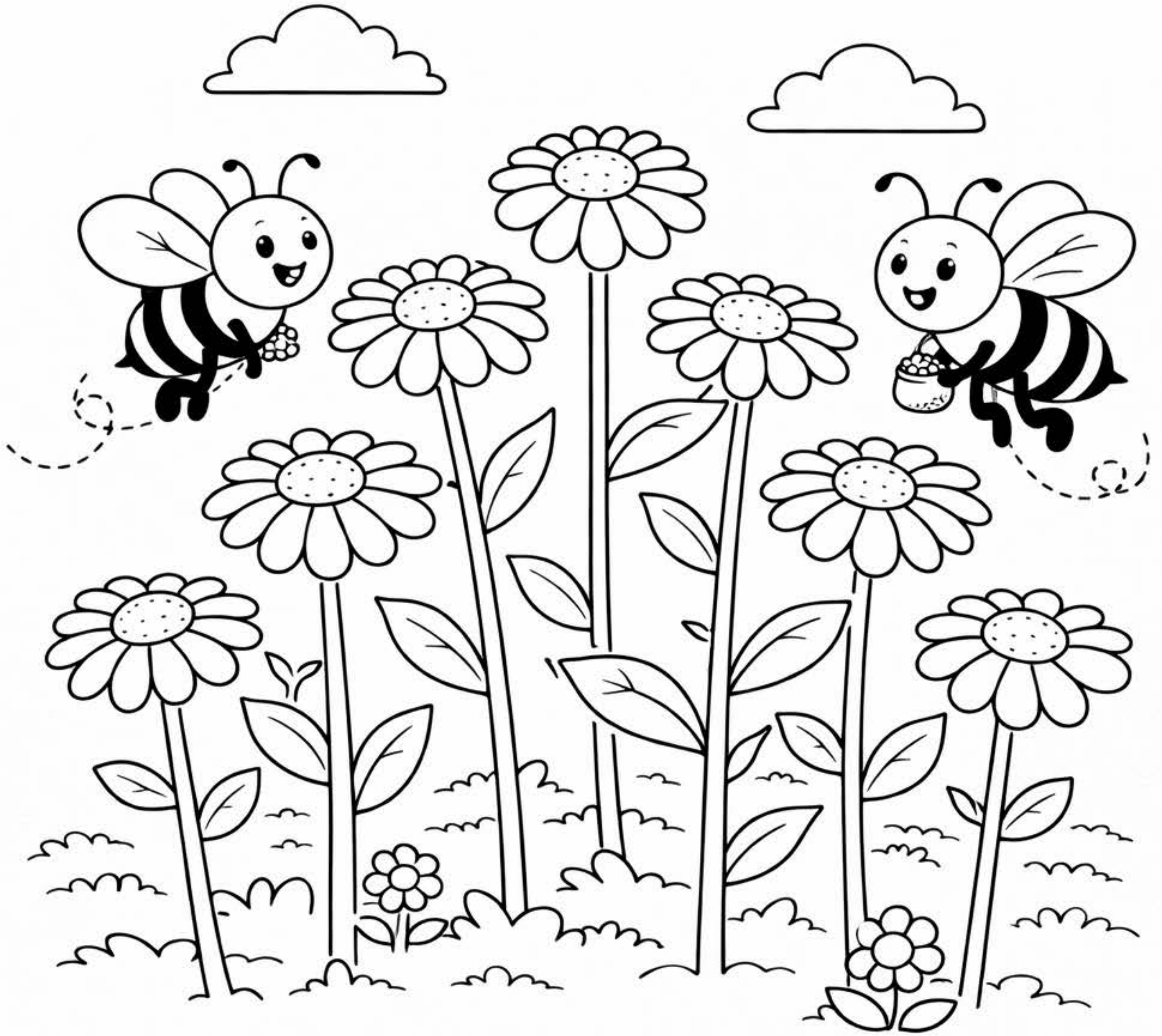
Flowers grow before apples.



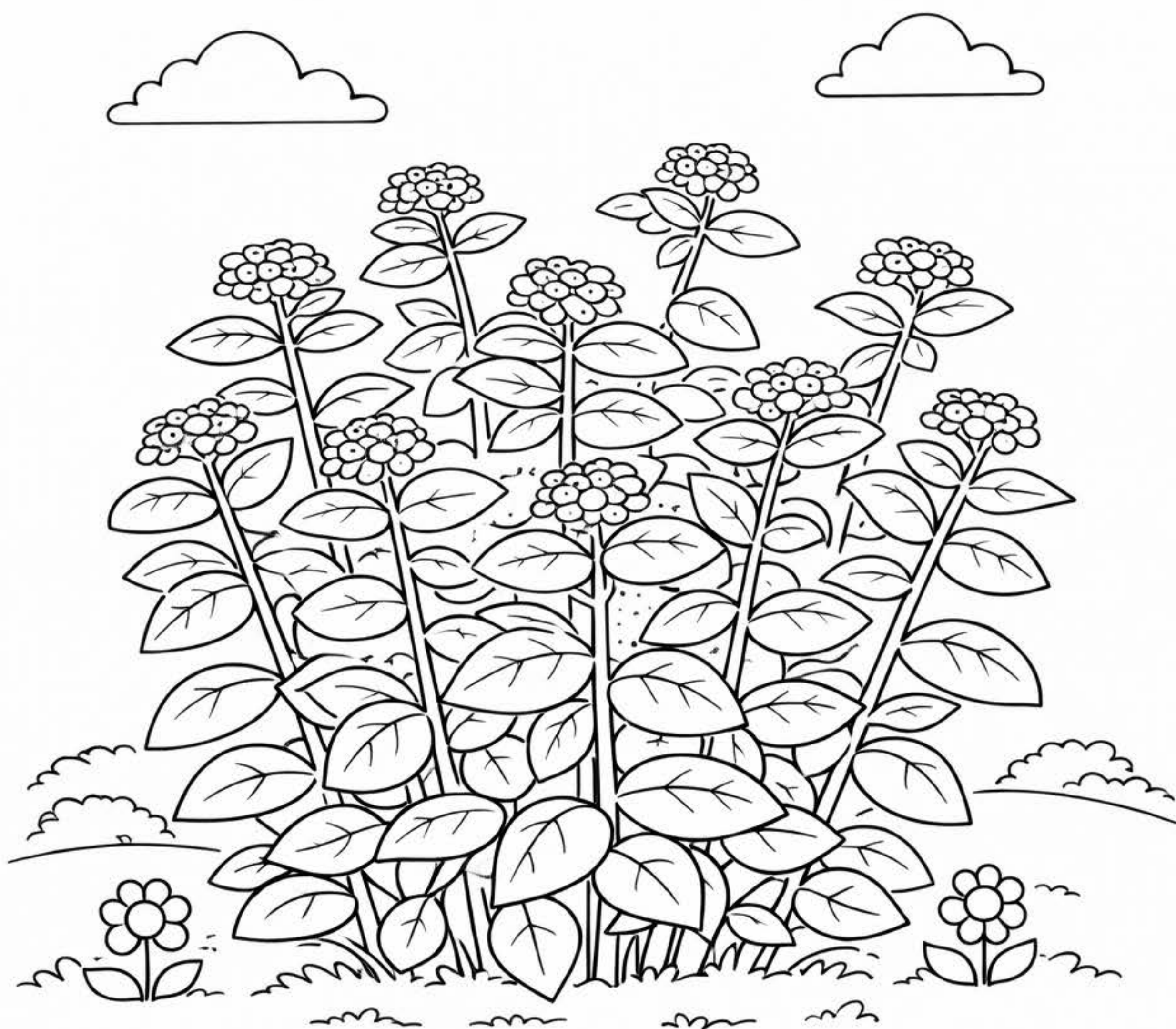
Bees help flowers become fruit.



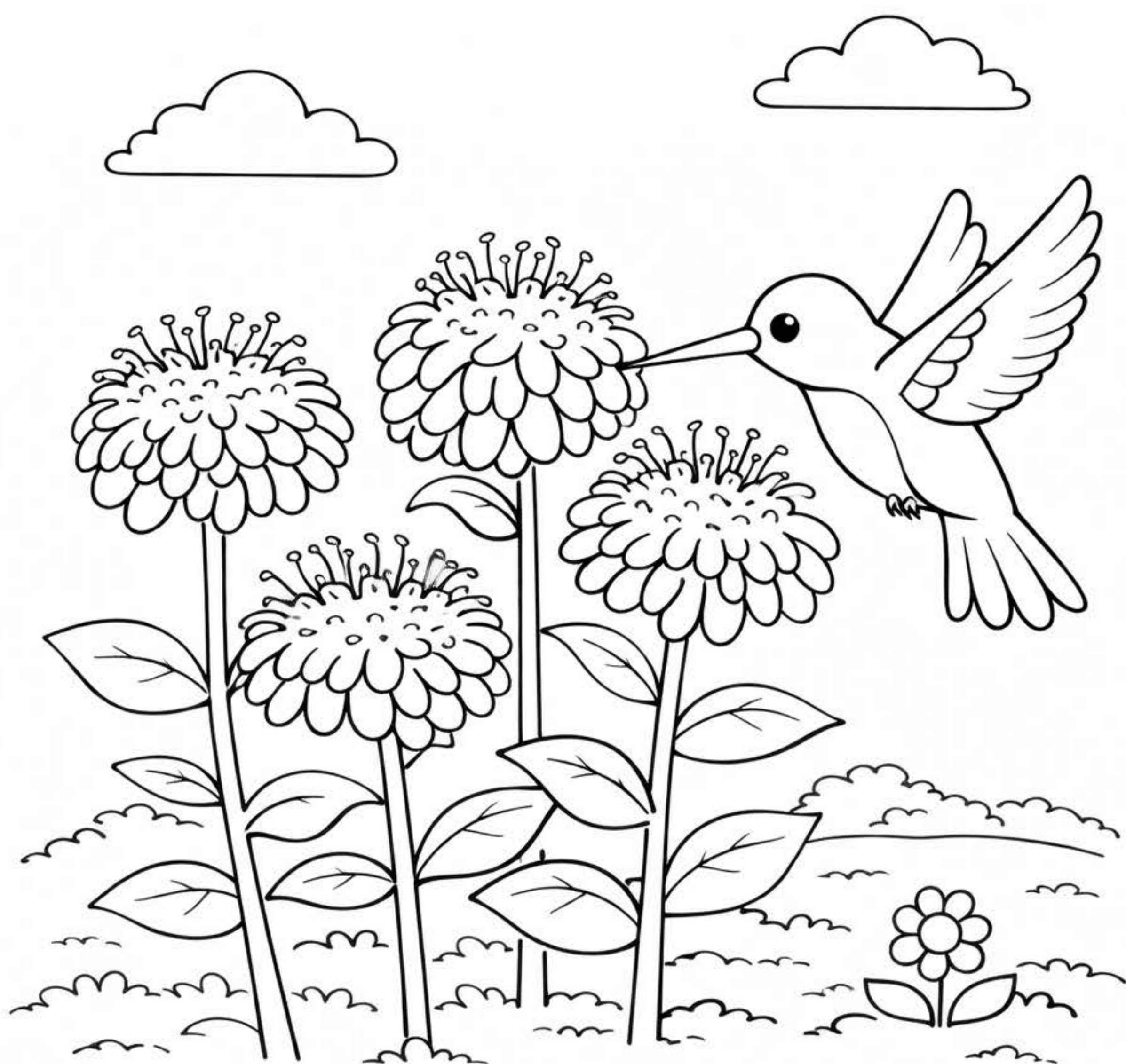
Butterflies love nectar from flowers.



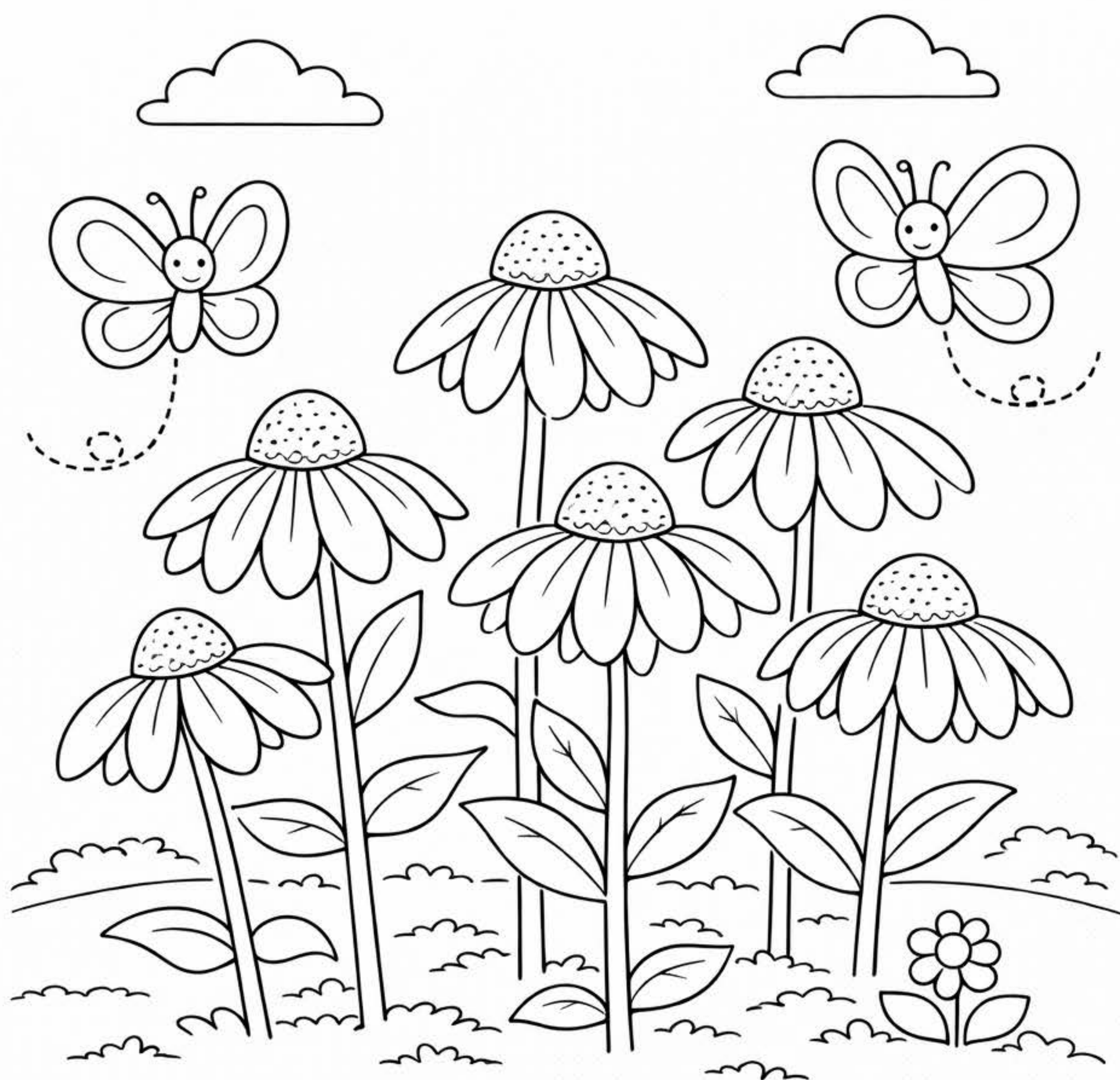
Pollinator plants help insects thrive.



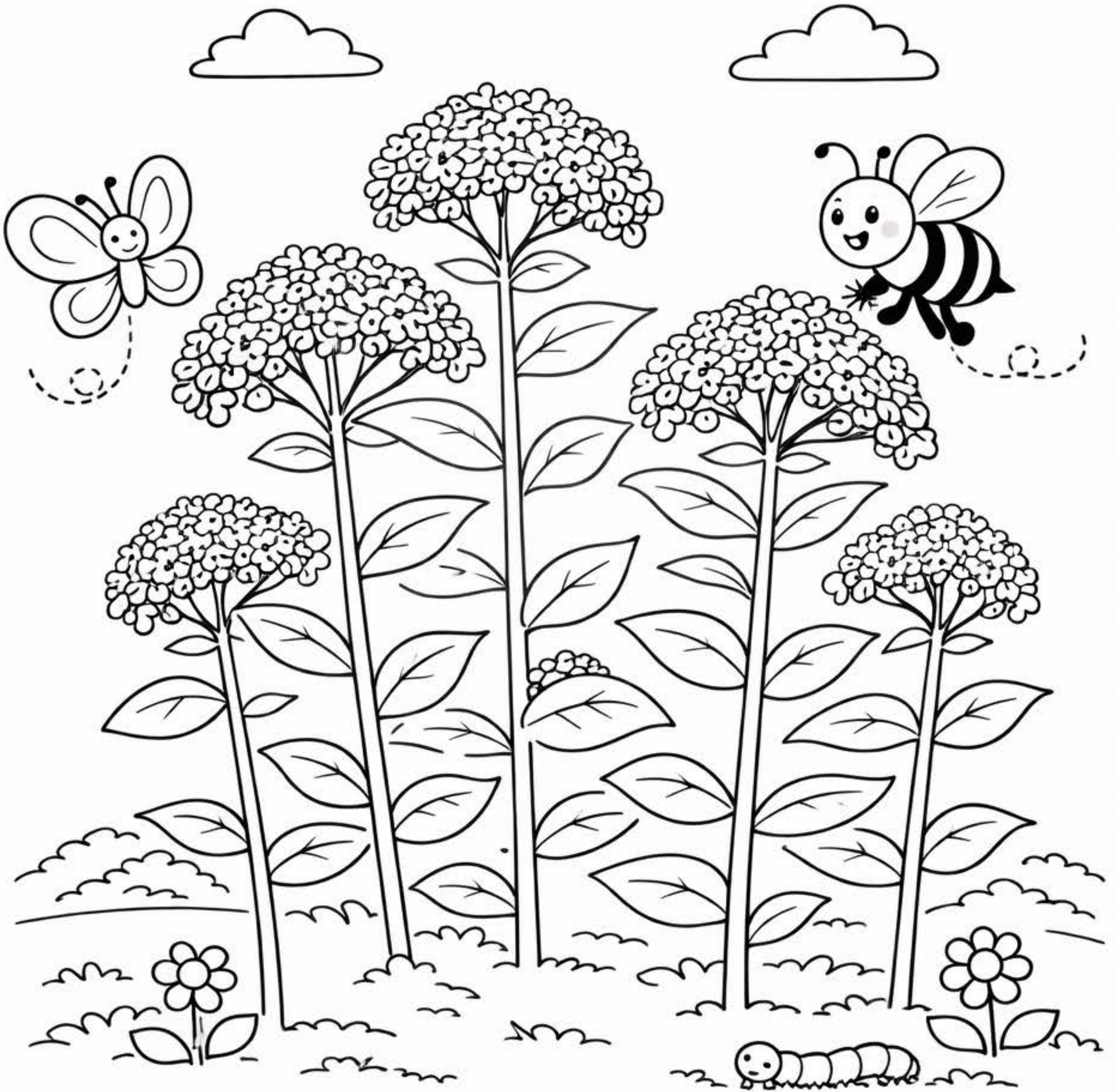
Mountain mint smells good and helps pollinators.



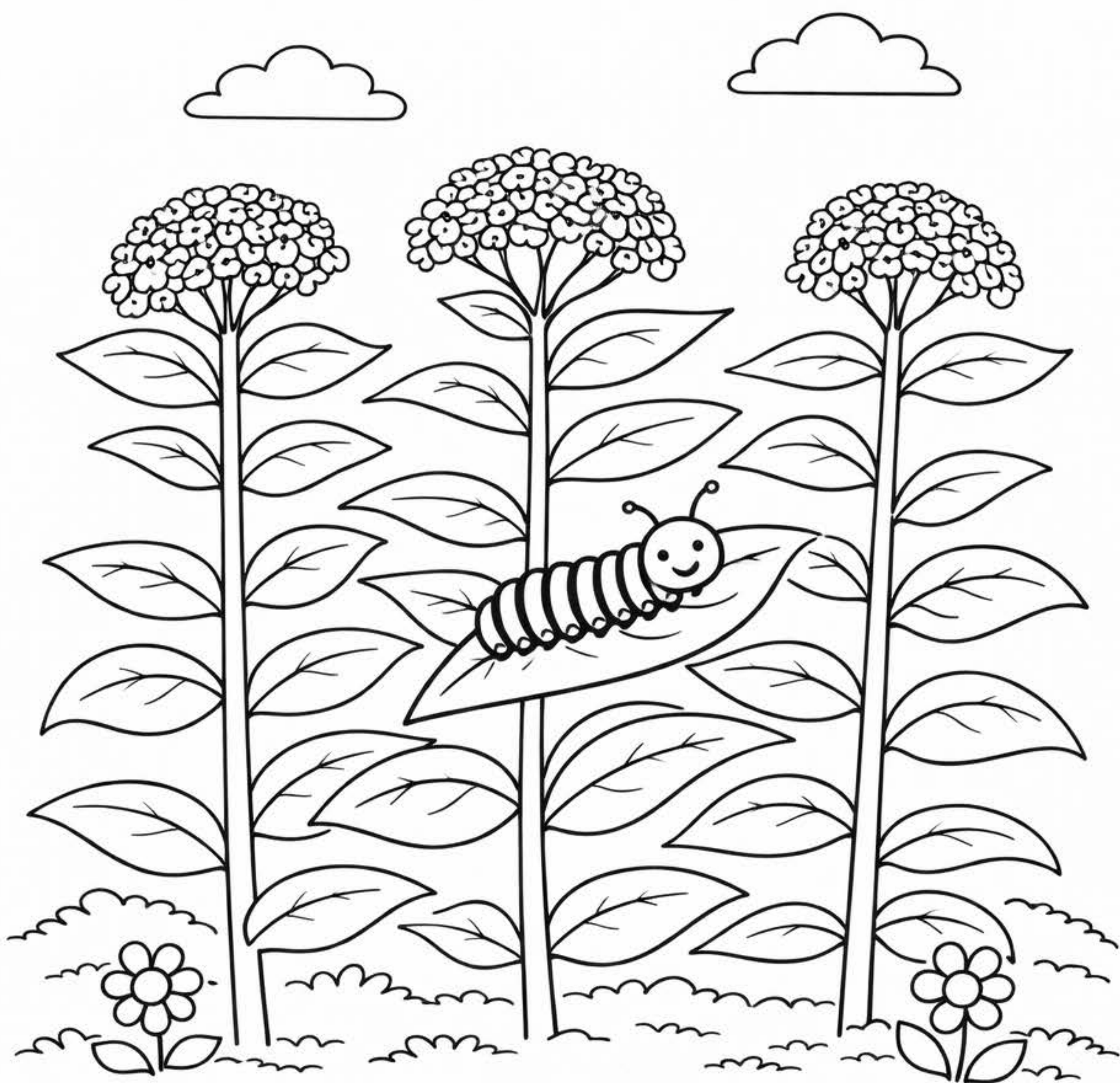
Some flowers feed birds too.



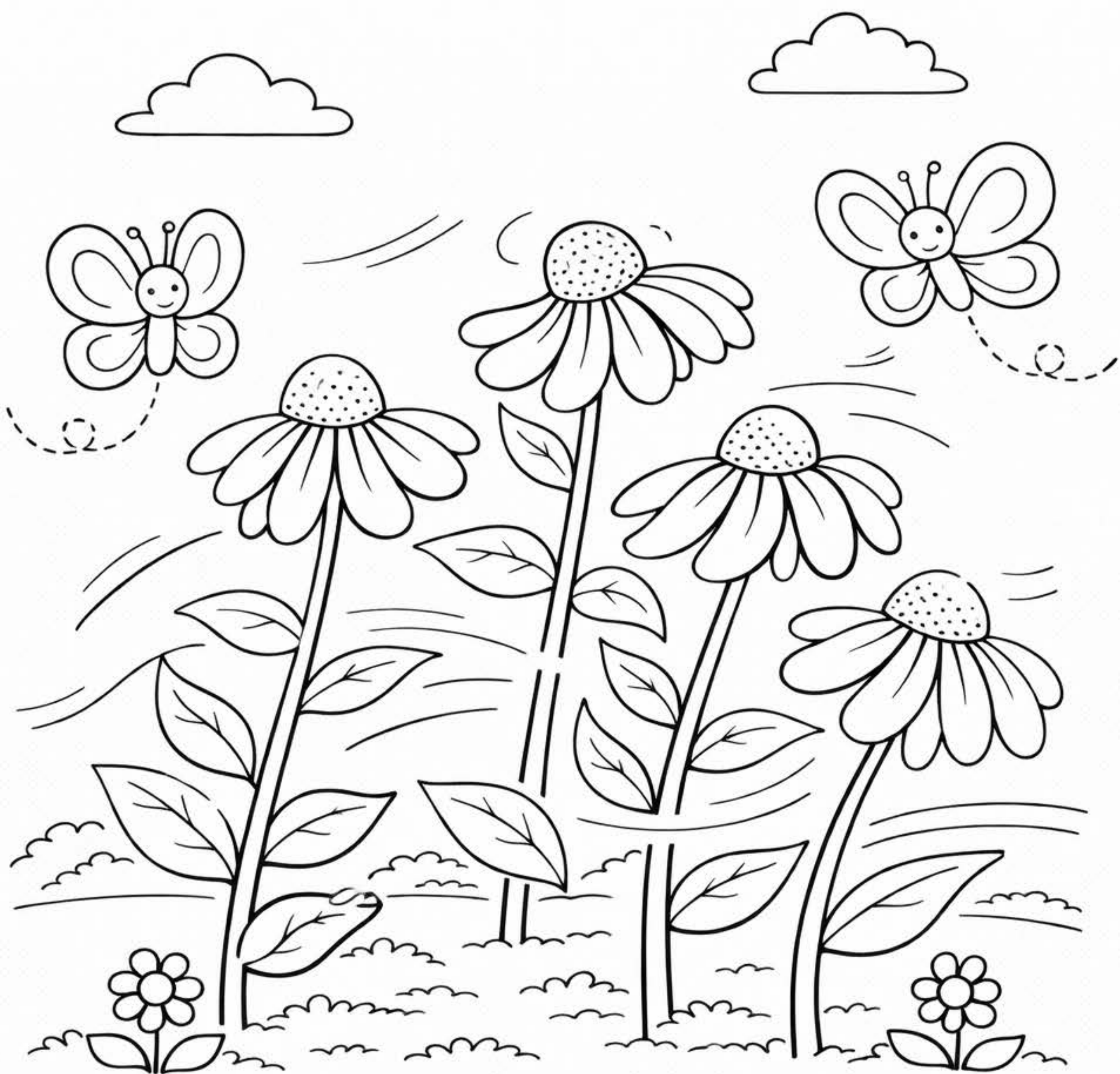
Purple Coneflowers are strong native plants.



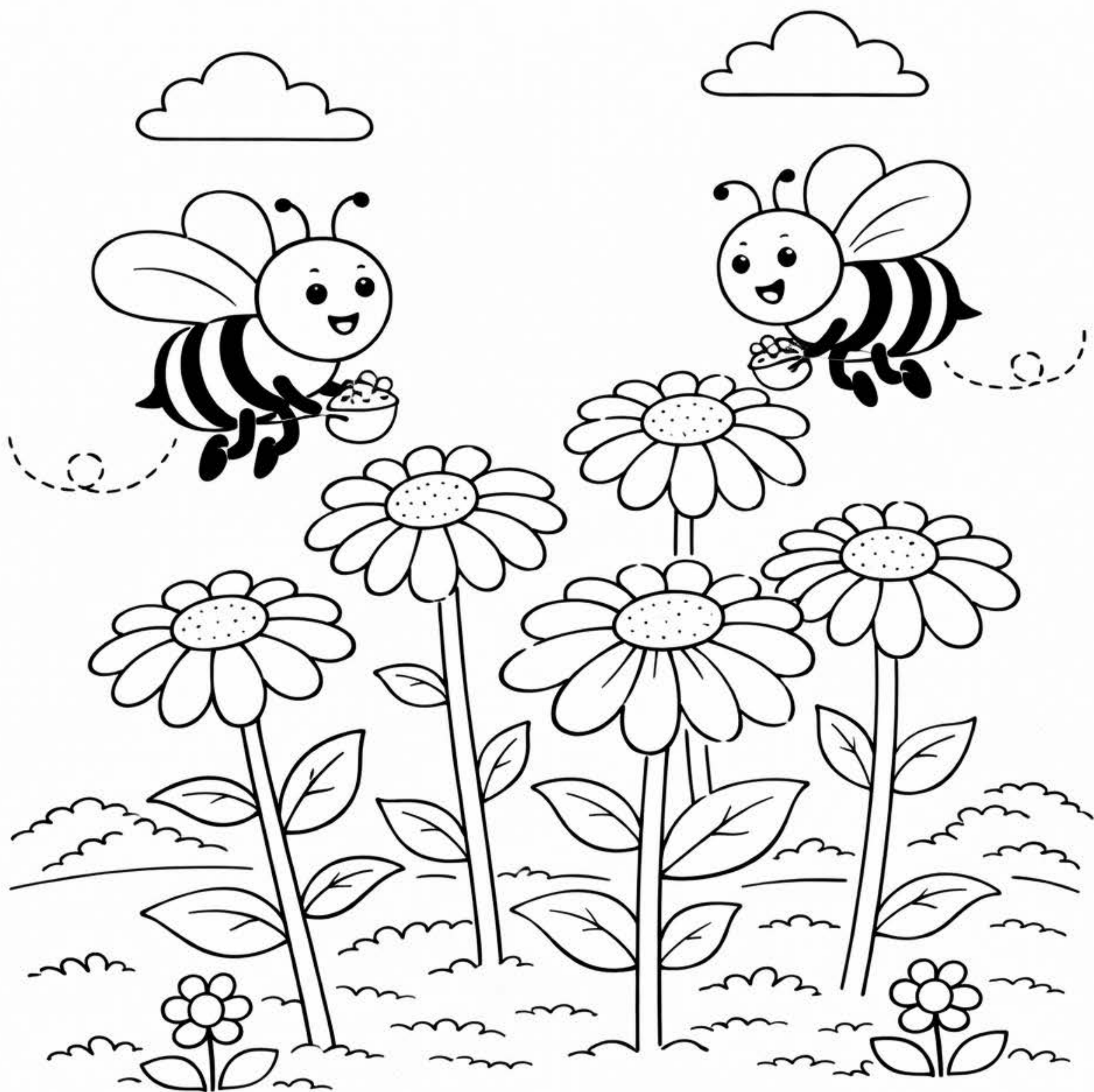
Tall plants make great habitats.



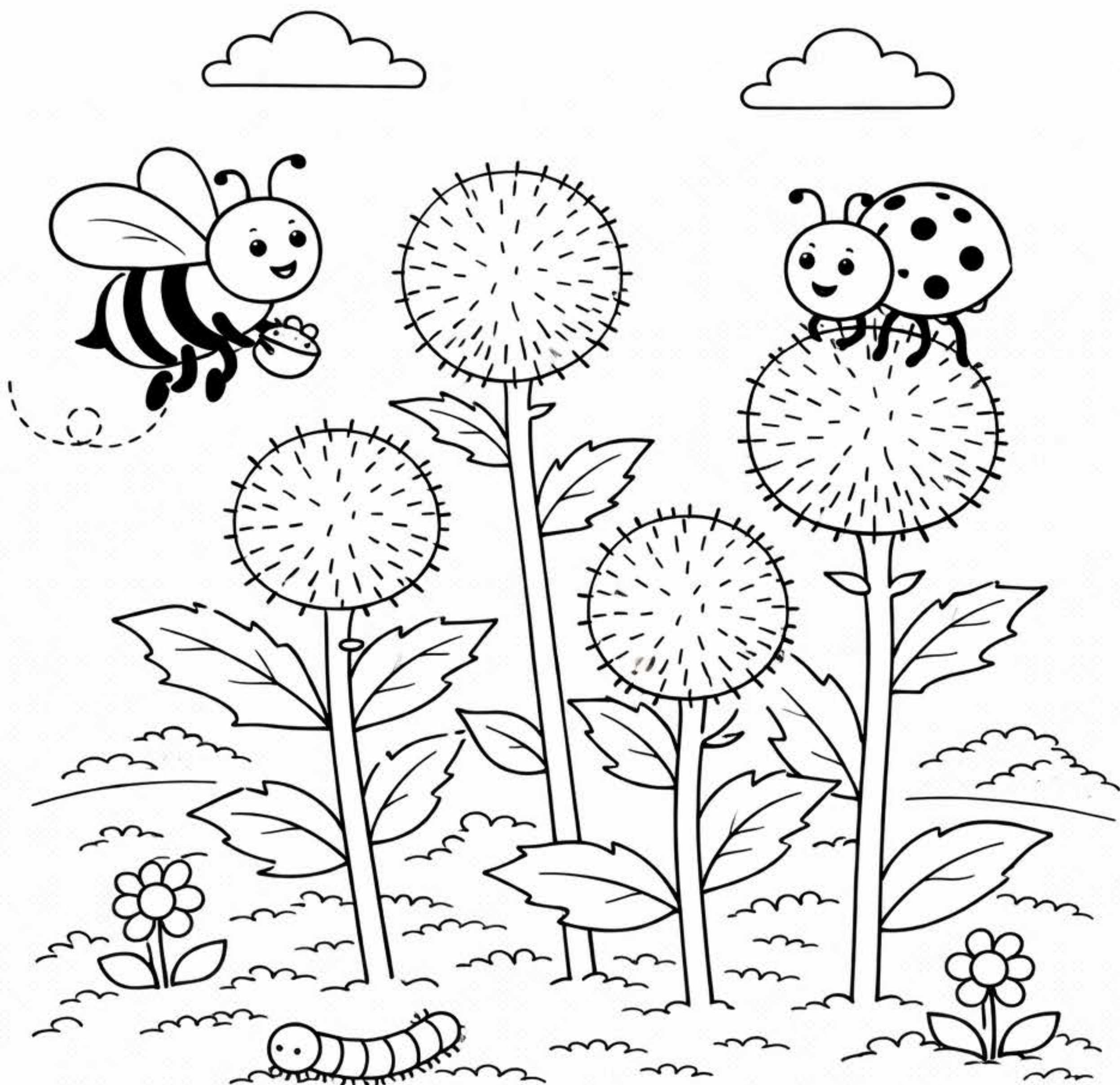
Monarch butterflies need milkweed.



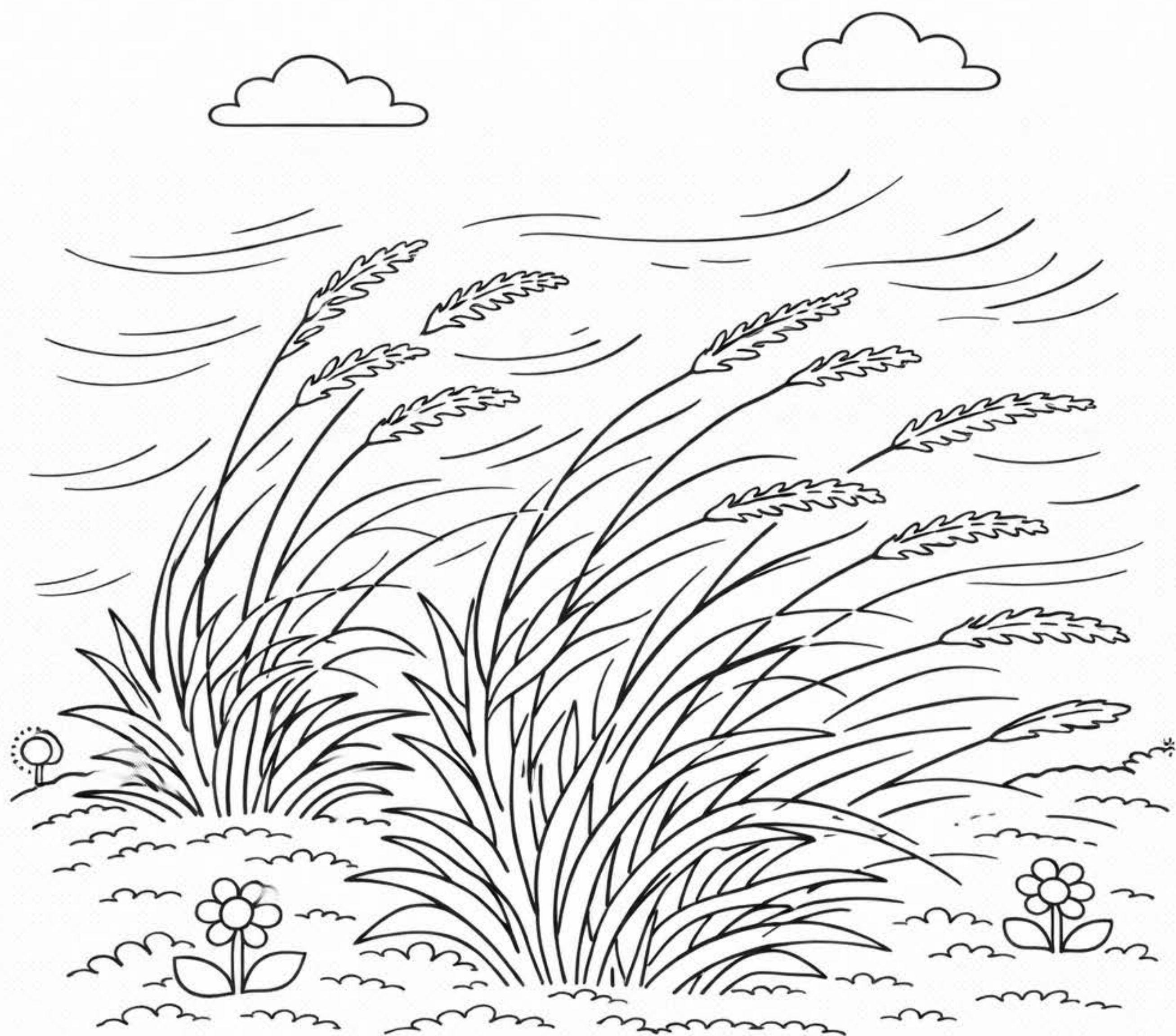
Yellow Coneflowers dance in the breeze.



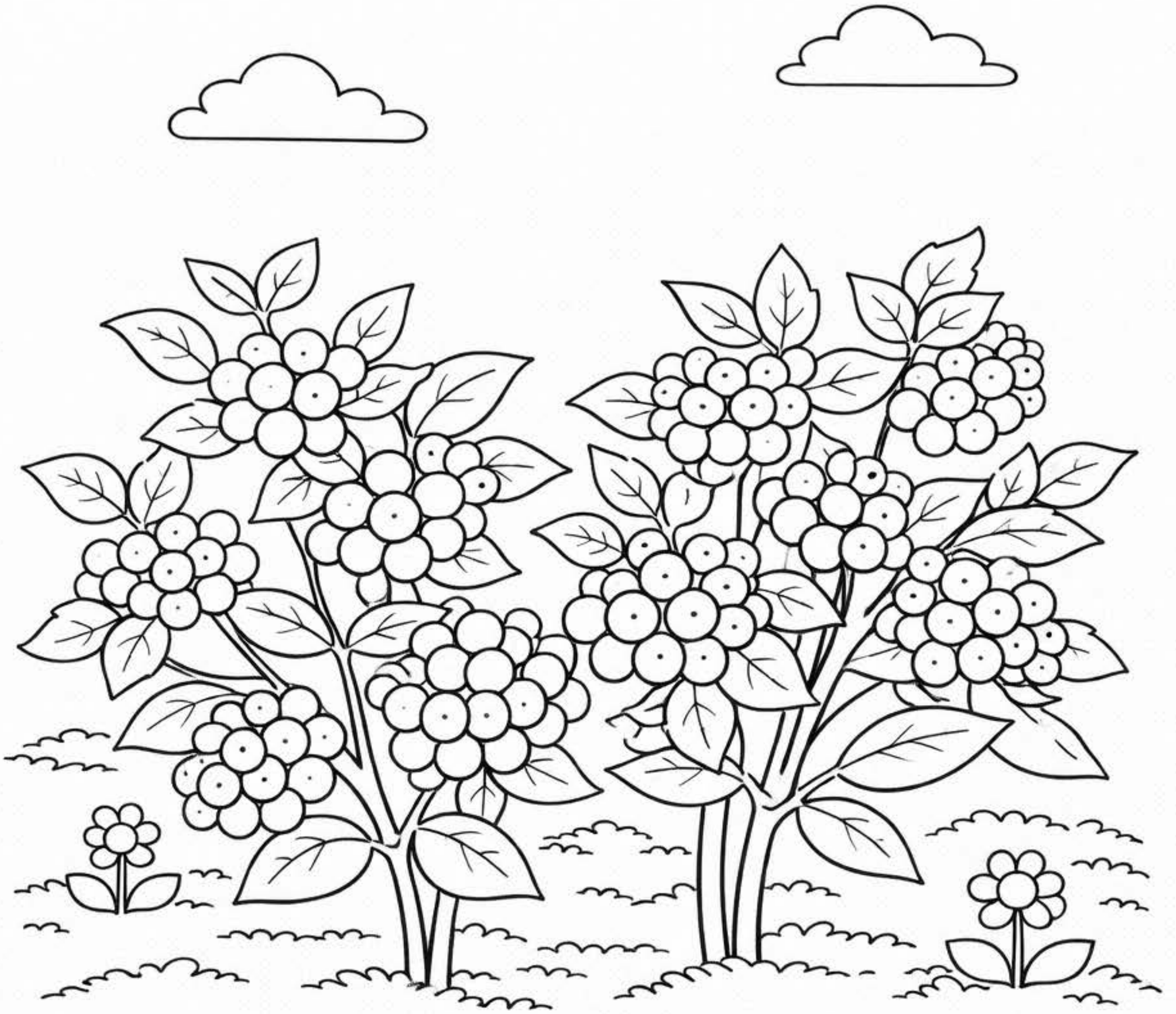
Bees visit many flowers every day.



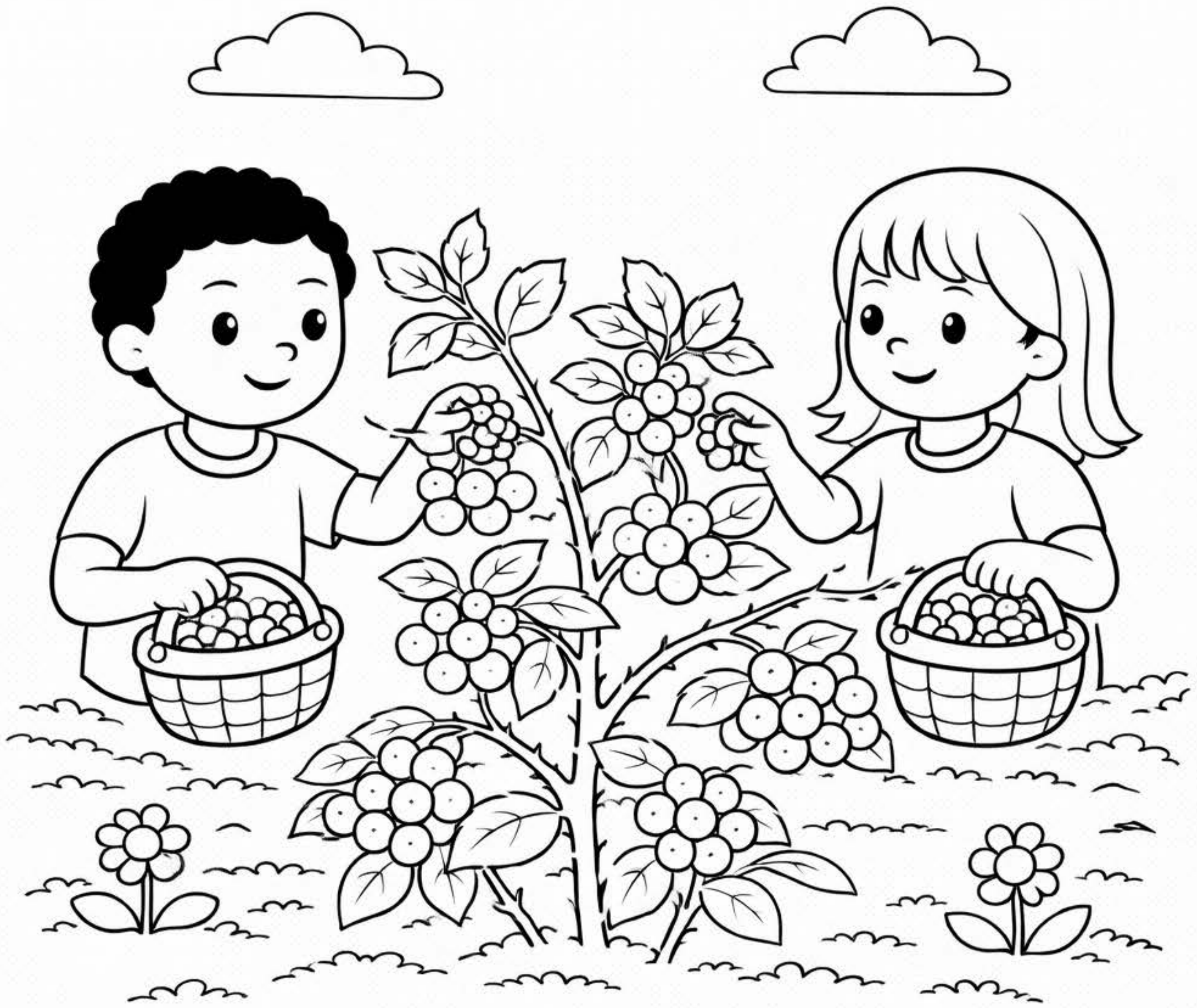
Some plants look very unique.



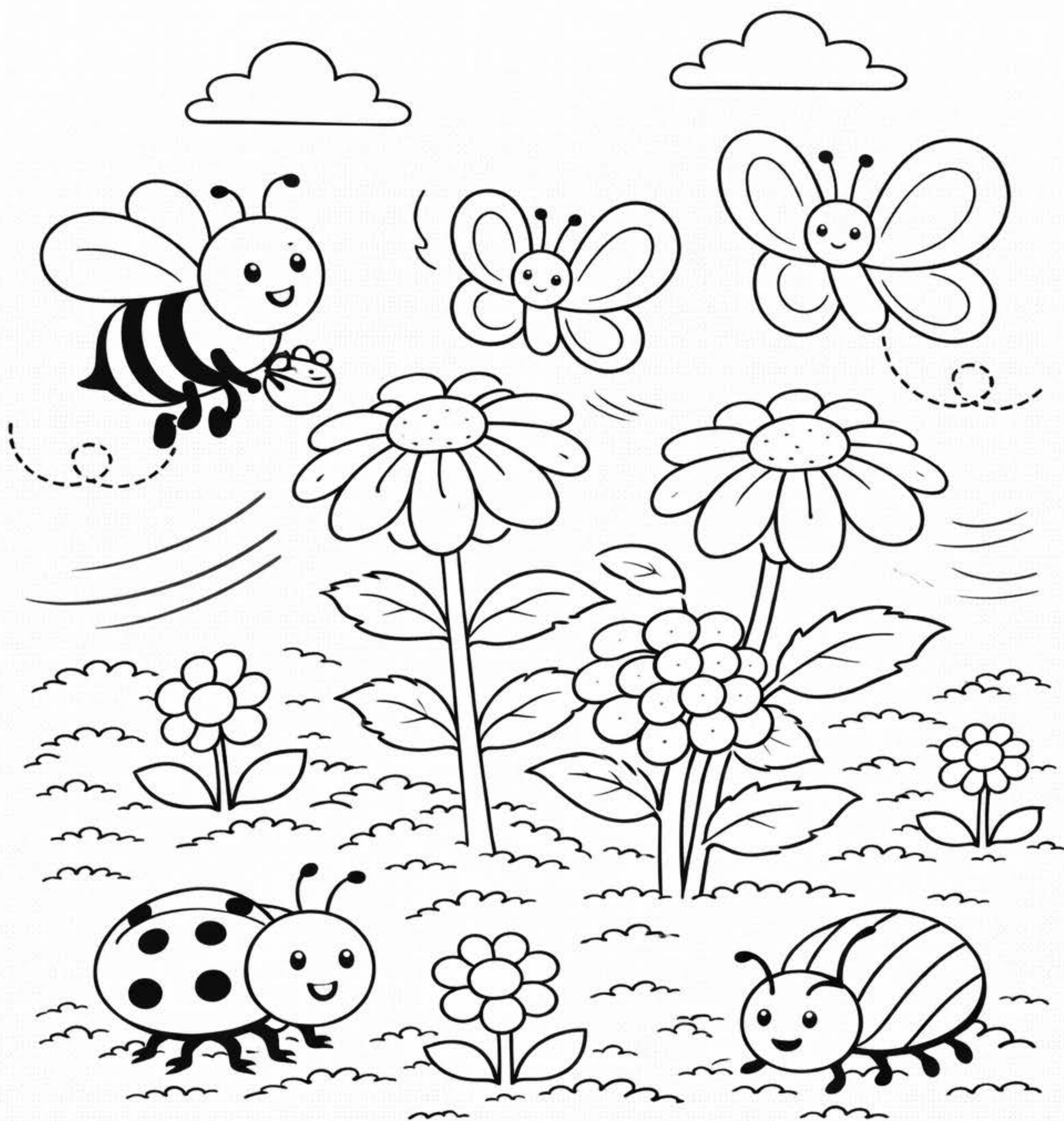
Grasses help protect the soil.



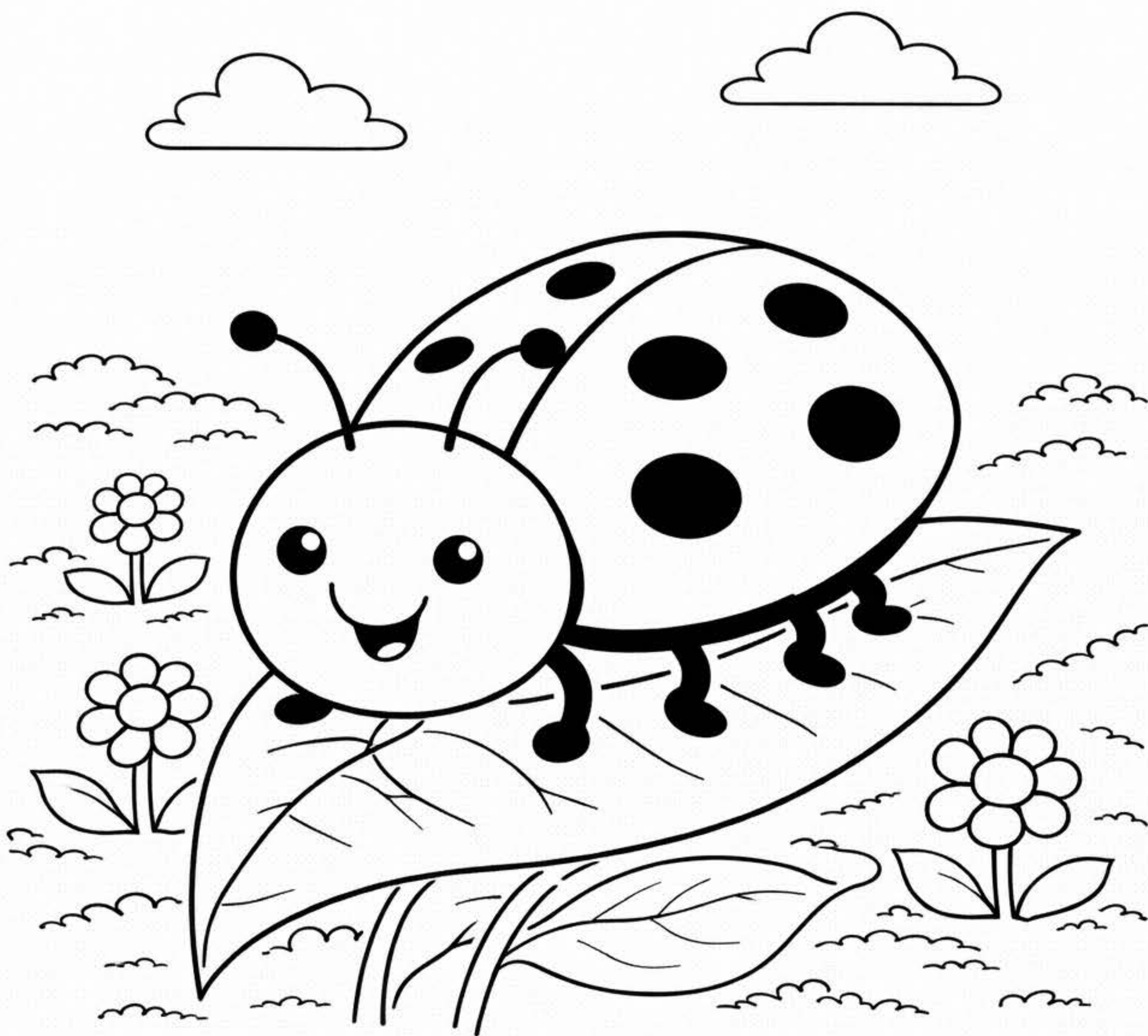
Berries grow on bushes, not trees.



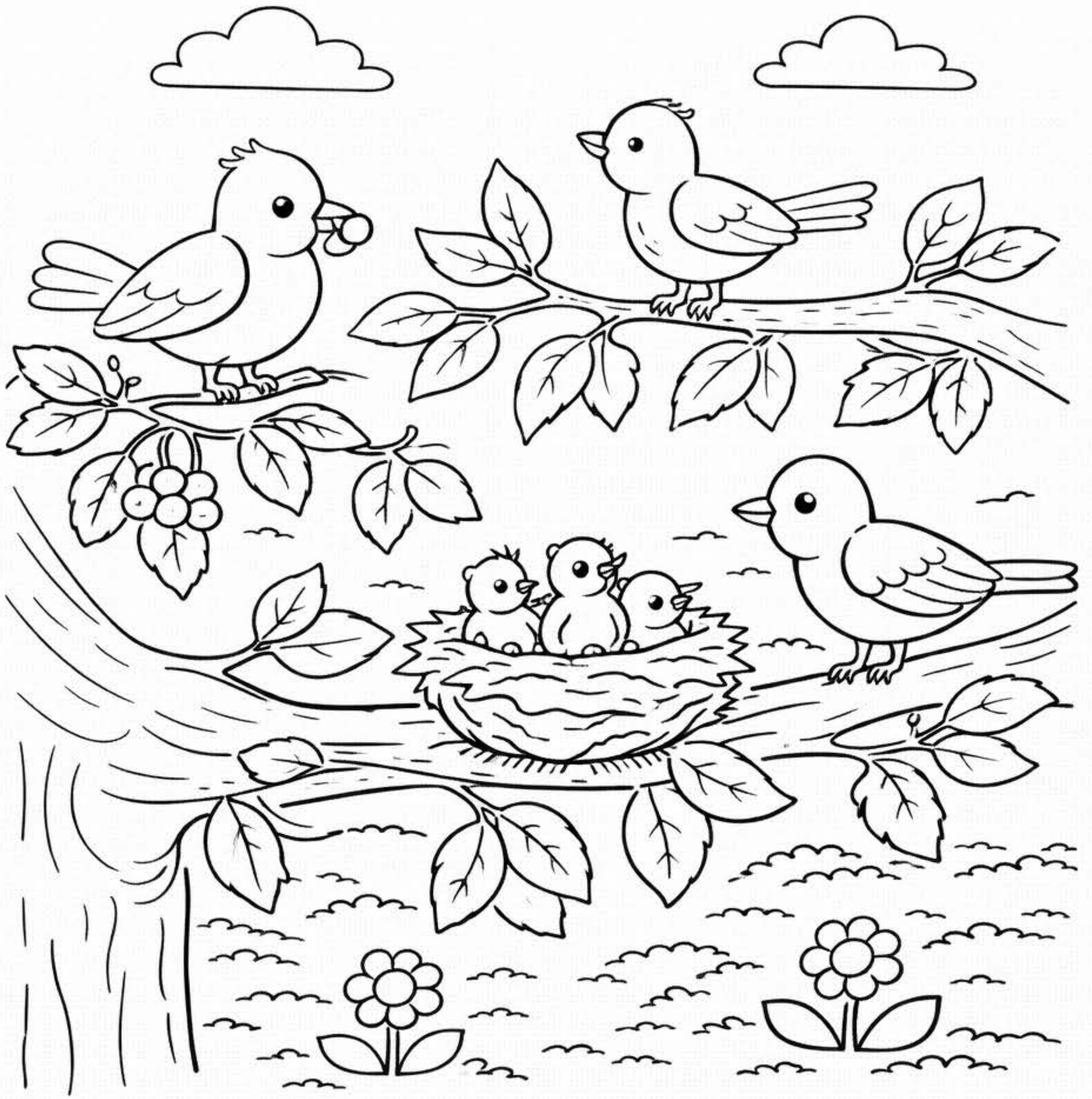
Some berries have thorns. Be gentle.



Many insects help plants grow.



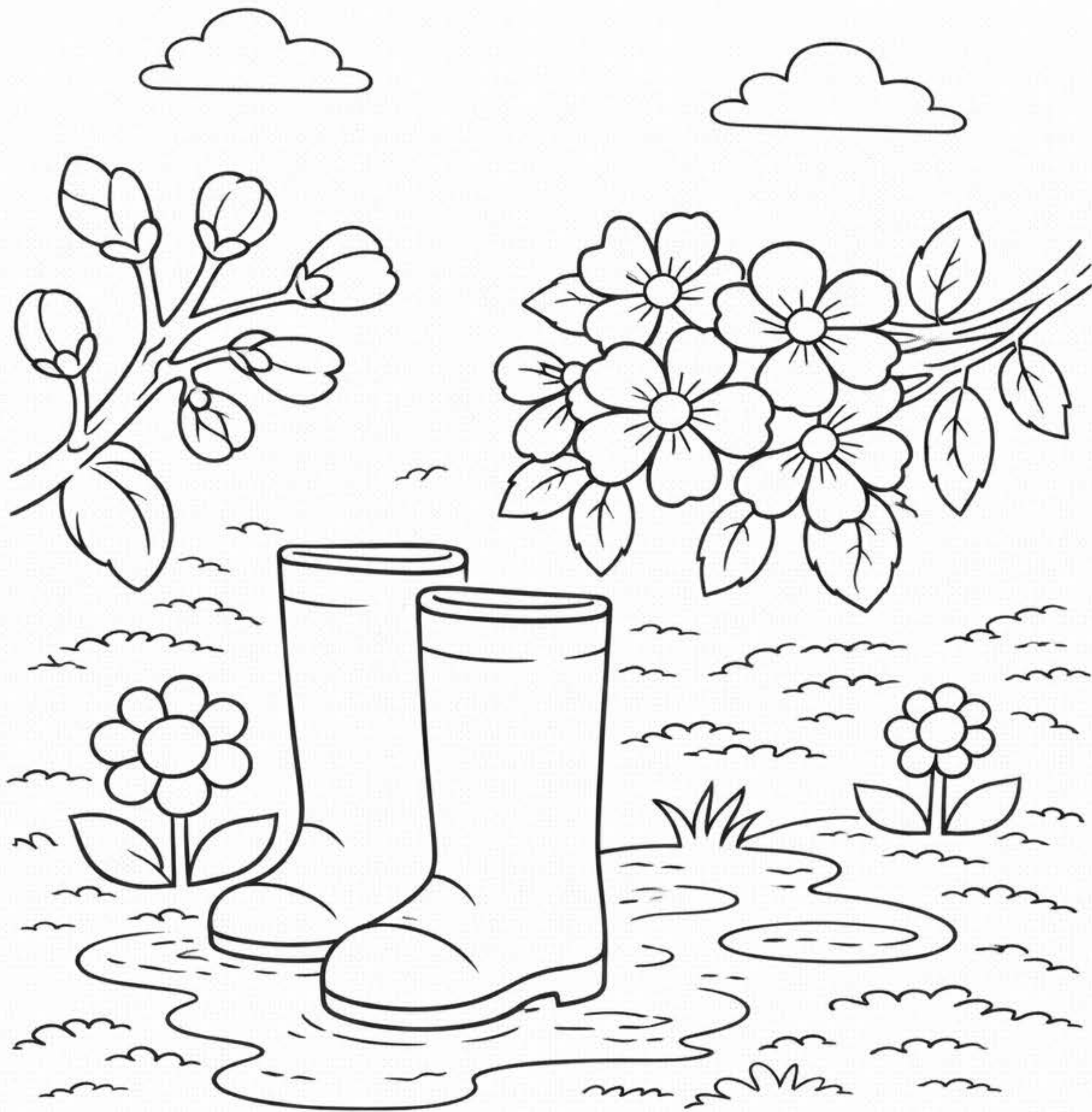
Ladybugs help keep plants healthy.



Birds find food and shelter here.



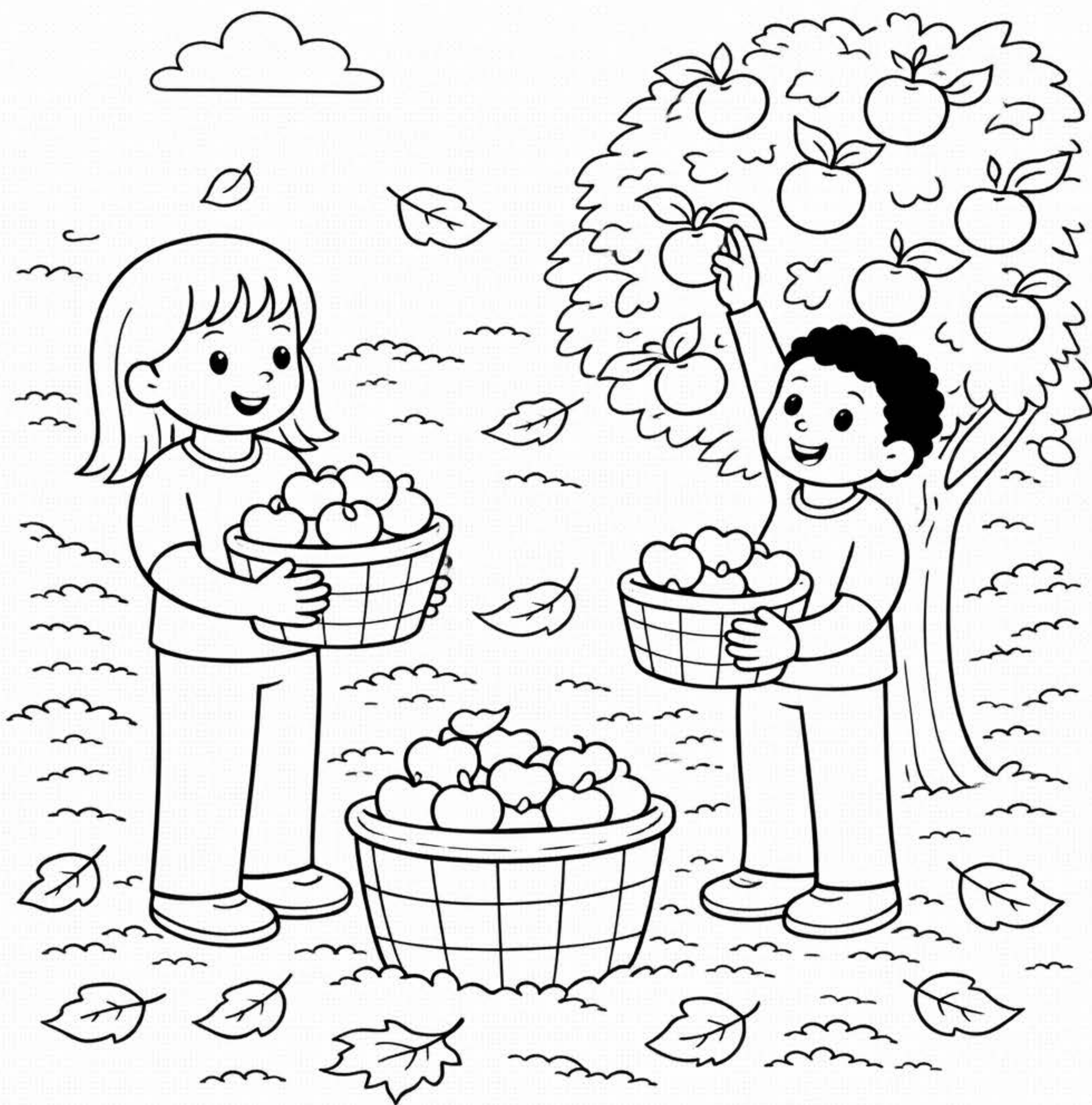
