Thank you for requesting the comments of the Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (OPRHP) concerning your project's potential impact/effect upon historic and/or prehistoric cultural resources. Our staff has received the revised avoidance plan you recently submitted which illustrates that Lot 30 has been shifted to avoid impacting the Van Orden Site Locus 1 (Unique Site Number A02705.000281) and identifies how the lot will be protected during construction by the erection of protective fencing, and into the future by a requirement to consult with office for any future changes to the plans. Based on this review it is our opinion that your project will have No Adverse Impact on Historic Resources with the condition that this avoidance plan is followed.
