Dear Friends,

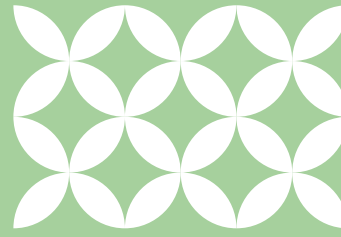

The Impact

- 13,081 bagged meals served
- \$5,709 in money donated
- \$23,058.47 in merchandise vouchers
- 4 counties impacted

KEY PROGRAMS OVERVIEW

- Food Pantries: 2 grab & go food pantries. One inside the store during business hours & a 24-hour pantry outside
- Emergency Vouchers: provides clothing and household items to those in emergent need.
- Bagged Meals: a bagged meal including sandwich, chips, and dessert available every day - no questions asked
- Take & Make Meal kits: 2 complete meals with all ingredients and instructions.

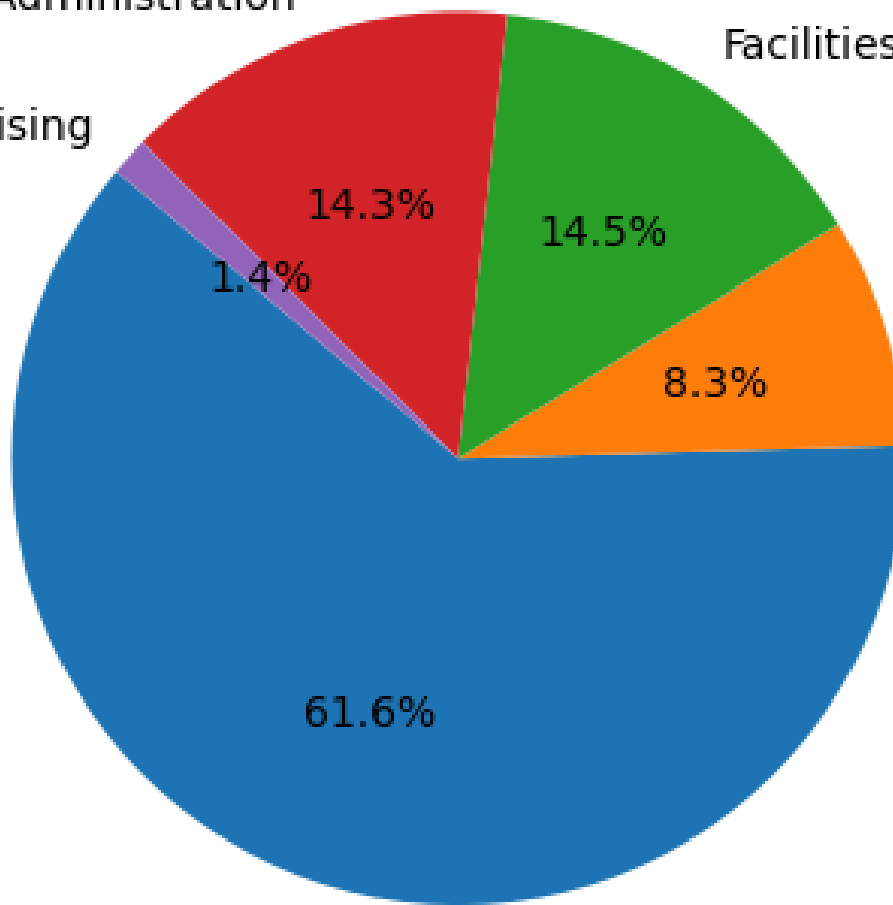
Lighthouse Thriftique - 2025 Expense Breakdown (Grouped)

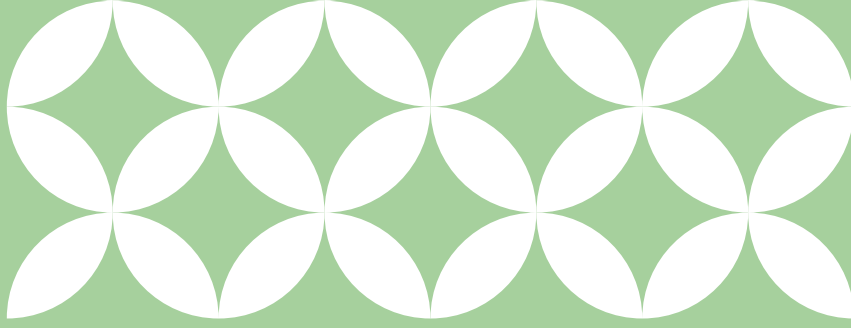


LOOKING AHEAD
