It lays out, "The Congress shall have Power To lay and collect Taxes, Duties, Imposts and Excises, to pay the Debts and provide for the common Defense and general Welfare of the United States...To borrow Money on the credit of the United States...To regulate Commerce with foreign Nations, and among the several States, and with the Indian tribes...To coin money...To establish Post Offices and post Roads...To raise and support Armies."

The Constitution does not outline over half of the authority to which the Federal Government spends or taxes today. We need less Federal funding and involvement in our Great State of Idaho.

If you could change one thing the current Idaho State administration has done this past year and a half, what would it be?

Most recently, I would have voted to pass S1381, Pause Act that, "establishes limitations on the ability of private and public entities to impose a requirement that individuals receive a coronavirus vaccination."
