A drive from the port will take you across the McArthur Causeway to the southern part of Miami Beach, known as South Beach, incorporating the Art Deco Historic District. In 1979, the art district was listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Miami Beach is known to have the largest collection of Art Deco buildings in the world, and the Miami Design Preservation League was formed in 1975 to preserve and restore these historic buildings, which are from the 1930s - 1940s. Enjoy a leisurely walk with your guide along Ocean Drive, and the beach boardwalk, to view some of these historic gems, including the Park Central, Beacon, Colony, Cardozo, and the Gianni Versace mansion, where the world famous fashion designer lived and in 1997 was shot and killed on the steps. The walk continues to Lincoln Road, an original pedestrian friendly shopping area of Miami Beach, before you are transferred to Miami International Airport to end the tour. Please note: It is recommended that guests wear comfortable walking shoes. This tour involves a considerable amount of walking. Guests will walk approximately 1 mile on flat terrain. 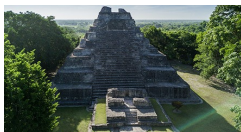

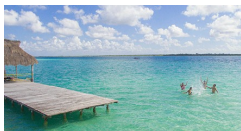

**Costa Maya, Mexico****Monday 6 October 2025****CMY06 - CHACCHOBEN MAYAN RUINS****CULTURE AND HISTORY**

English

The dawn of the once highly developed Mayan civilization can be traced back to around 2,000 B.C. and many of their amazing architectural structures can still be visited in Mexico to this date. In around A.D. 700, these clever people built the pilgrimage site of Chacchoben, your destination on this half-day tour. After meeting your bilingual guide, you'll head inland on an air-conditioned coach with information on the site and the Mayans provided during the ride. On arrival, your guide will show you around the site, explaining the purpose of the various structures. Amazingly, one of the pyramids still features some original red paint on its stucco walls, while a mural depicting the astronomical positions of planet Venus has stood the test of time in one of the temples. For those of an energetic disposition, there'll also be time to climb some of Chacchoben's tallest structures: the imposing Gran Basamento, a place where archaeologists found remains of ceremonial offerings dating back to 1,000 B.C.. The highest point of the temple sits above the tree canopy and affords eminently photo-worthy views. You'll also get to find out a little about the area's diverse wildlife and Mayan medicinal plants, which continue to be used to this day. A complimentary bottle of water is also included in your excursion and the relaxing return drive to your ship at the Costa Maya brings your tour to a close. Guests must be at least 2 years old to participate. Please note: Guests must be at least 2 years old to participate. As the tour involves longer periods of walking over uneven ground and some climbing, is not available for guests with mobility problems. About 10-15 minutes will be allocated for guests to make purchases at the market inside the archaeological site. A government-imposed fee of approx. US\$5 is payable by guests wishing to use video at the archaeological site. It is recommended that guests wear comfortable clothing and shoes, and bring insect repellent, sunscreen, sunglasses, and cash/credit cards for any additional purchases. The walking distance on this tour is approximately 1.05 miles (1,700 meters). The maximum age to participate is 80 years old.

This half-day outing begins with an approximately 1 hour and 30-minute transfer on a coach to reach Bacalar, with your guide filling in details about the port and its history. Once you arrive to Bacalar, take a glimpse from your bus to the Rancho Encantado Eco Resort & Spa. Then you'll board a boat for an approximately 2 hour long relaxing cruise and a chance to take a dip in the waters of lagoon, whose colours are many and varied. Visit the Cenote Negro and continue your journey and pass by La Isla de Los Pajaros until you arrive to the Channel of Pirates. You will have the opportunity to swim in shallow turquoise water. Lastly, soak up picture-perfect views over lunch in one of Bacalar's loveliest restaurants. Your return journey to the ship then lets the tour draw to a close. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. Please note: Drinks at the restaurant have an extra cost. Guests must be at least 5 years old to participate. Guests must be at least 18 years of age to consume alcohol. Alcohol will be served to participants in a spirit of watchful tolerance. All participating guests under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a paying adult at all times. Guests with impaired vision or hearing must be accompanied by a paying assistant, friend or family member as well as an interpreter (for hearing impaired guests); they will not be permitted to go swimming. The tour is not available for guests of limited mobility. Medical restrictions apply to guests wishing to swim in the lagoon. Guests are recommended to wear swimwear under comfortable clothing and to bring a towel, high-factor sunscreen, insect repellent and some cash to cover any additional purchases. This tour does not include entrance fee to visit the fort nor time is allocated for guests wishing to visit it unguided at their own expenses. The transfer to and from Bacalar takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes each way. Depending on the weather conditions, the colours of the lagoon may vary. The maximum age to participate is 70 years old.

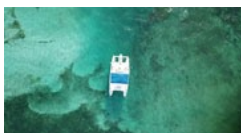
**CMY49 - PROTECTOURS: TRADITIONS AT ALDEA MAHAHAUA**

Hop aboard an air-conditioned vehicle and arrive at one of the most unique spots in Costa Maya, Aldea Mahahua. Upon arrival, enjoy a taste of the refreshing "Agua de Chaya", a medicinal and tasty plant. After, a Shaman will lead you to the first part of the tour; a Mayan Ritual, cleansing with copal and purification of the spirit. Learn about the Mayan history, dance to the rhythm of the drums and flutes, surrounded by pre-Hispanic rituals. Then, it's time to delight your palate with four different flavored margaritas and some typical food tastings. Your last stop will be at the Gallo Azul Bar, to enjoy some more tequila, before you are given some free time to explore. Dance, do some shopping, relax at the Xcatik restaurant, or simply walk around before heading back to the ship either at your own leisure or at the assigned return time. Join the expedition to the coastline and snorkel in Mahahual's Mayan reef; known as the second largest living coral reef in the world. Your guide will be happy to welcome you at the end of the pier, where you will be shortly briefed and escorted to your air-conditioned transportation. Along the approximately 20 minutes' drive through downtown, your guide will offer a short history about the town and some safety procedures. Arriving at the dock, you will embark on a motorized catamaran. Enjoy the views and refreshing tropical breezes. You will be given a life vest and the equipment you need for your snorkel activity before jumping into the water. Witness the variety of coloured coral reefs and wildlife below. After you are done snorkelling, you will make your way back to land and return to the ship with your guide. Guests must be at least 10 years old to participate. Please note: Please ensure your sunscreen is fully biodegradable as normal sunscreen is prohibited from use due to the damage it causes to the reef. Presence of seaweed in the Mexican Caribbean Coast is seasonal and could cause limited visibility and be present in the water or beach. Seaweed is not harmful but may cause light itching on sensitive skin. The spotting of wildlife is not guaranteed. Guests who wish to stay in town will be responsible for making their own way back to the pier. This tour is not recommended for pregnant women or guests with back/neck injuries, history of seizures, recent surgeries, vertigo, diabetes, heart, or respiratory conditions, such as, asthma or high blood pressure. With views of the Caribbean Sea, stretches of sandy beach and tiny villages to enjoy on the way, your approximately 1-hour drive will take you south to reach Explora Beach. Before reaching this beach, you will make a stop at a tequila hacienda, where you will learn about the process of manufacturing this Mexican spirit and participate in a tasting experience. Finally arriving to the beach, pristine sands and a secluded location make this the ideal spot to stop for a delicious Mexican-style lunch, followed by time to do whatever you please. The water is just the place for a refreshing dip, the beach perfect for working on your tan, playing beach volleyball or going for a stroll and the stunning surroundings well worth a photo or two. You'll return to the pier and your ship in the same way you came - by jeep. Guests must be at least 4 years old to participate. Please note: Vehicles used on this tour are Jeeps Renegade. All jeeps feature automatic transmission and each jeep seats 4. Every year from spring to autumn, the shores of Cozumel turn into a breeding ground for loggerhead and green sea turtles, two endangered species that this tour gives you a chance to help save. After the female turtle has laid her eggs in a hole, she digs in the sand using her hind flippers, they will hatch about 100 to 150 days later under cover of the night. The little hatchlings then embark on the most dangerous journey of their young lives - the mad scramble over the sand to reach the relative safety of the sea. While this entirely natural process enjoys a high success rate, some 20% of the baby turtles lack the strength or stamina to climb out of their nesting hole. This is where you come in and, instructed by a qualified marine biologist, stand to make a real difference to the previous evening's hatchlings, little lives that would otherwise not survive. You will depart the pier for an approximately 45 minute drive, before starting your task of first digging the young turtles out of their nests and then taking them to Cozumel's Marine Biology Outpost where they will be looked after until their internal organs have matured sufficiently for them to be released into the sea. Don't miss this truly heart-warming experience and make your contribution to wildlife preservation in the most hands-on way possible. At the end of this once in a lifetime experience, you will have approximately 1 hour to relax at the beach, enjoy a swim in the ocean or at the pool, order lunch and drinks (not included) and reflect about the life ahead for the little turtles you just gave a second chance to. Most of the proceedings of this tour are used to fund this turtle saving program. The tour draws to a close with your return 45 minute drive back to the ship. Please note: Guests will be required to wash their hands before and after the animal interaction. **COZ70 - MAYAN RUINS OF CHICHEN ITZA**

Beginning with a transfer to mainland Mexico and then onwards to reach the archaeological site, this all-day excursion seeks to familiarise you with the ancient Mayan city of Chichen Itza. Once a powerful metropolis from c. A.D. 600 to 1200, the generously proportioned site features hundreds of incredible structures that placed it among the Seven New Wonders of the World. Your guided walk around the site will also include a visit to the pyramid of Kulkulkan (also known as El Castillo), the meticulously preserved Mayan ball court and the warriors' temple. But you'll also get to see the observatory, the place where Mayan priests would assemble to precisely predict the constellation of the stars over a time span of a million years. If one takes stock of how Europeans lived during the same time period, the astronomical and engineering feats of these ancient Mayans just seem all the more exceptional. A chance to relax then follows on your journey back to Cozumel and the ship. Please note: guests are advised that there will be an approx. 10-minute walk to and from the ruins from the car park. Guests are recommended to wear high-factor sunscreen, insect repellent and comfortable walking shoes to stay safe on the uneven terrain (limestone paths with loose stones). On this tour we backtrack the previous evenings events and help rescue the 20% of turtles who were not ready for the dash to the sea and recover these turtles until their inner organs are mature enough to be released by digging them out. This process is heart-warming and satisfactory as you will be in direct contact with nature and involved in saving the turtle so it may have a true chance at life. Your next stop is at a Beach Restaurant on the Eastern side of the Island where you will have one of Cozumel's most famous dishes: Caribbean Lobster! Enjoy the traditional delicacy that is true to this culture. Then it will be time to head to the comfort of your ship. Please note: The transfer to and from the Marine Biology Outpost takes approximately 45 minutes each way. Guests will be required to wash their hands before and after the animal interaction. 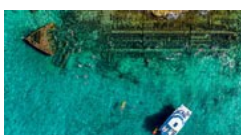
