### Rules of the Court/Liability Compliance Waiver

All members or guest participants who are not yet members, must complete and sign a liability waiver in accordance with the rules of the facility where they are playing and the Prescott Indoor Pickleball Association (PIPA). All people wishing to become a member of PIPA, must comply with this request. Beginning in 2024, all PIPA members, new or existing, must also sign a RELEASE, PERMISSION, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT for Espire Sports and PIPA. This form is available on the PIPA website and a copy can be obtained at any PIPA session. Thank you.

**LIABILITY AND INSURANCE:** The Prescott Indoor Pickleball Association (PIPA) currently carries a liability insurance policy. This protects our organization and the owners of the facility where we currently play from any possible litigation due to an accident and/or injury suffered by any player/person at the facility. This includes members and non-members alike. It is the sole responsibility of each player/person involved to provide any insurance coverage, medical cost for services, emergency transport, etc., as it applies to the incident in which the player/person is involved, be it on the court or in any area on the grounds of the facility in question. This also covers the property in and around the courts where PIPA is assigned to play. A copy of the PIPA Liability Insurance information is available upon request.

**RULES AND REGULATIONS:** Prescott Indoor Pickleball Association (PIPA) reserves the right to refuse membership to anyone for any reason seen fit and/or to revoke any membership and/or expel any person from this facility due to any behavior that is deemed unacceptable such as, but not limited to; fighting, unfair play or unsafe play that might result in injury to any player/person, excessive foul language, poor sportsmanship, stealing from another player/person or from PIPA, horseplay that may result in injury to another, etc. If a player/person is expelled from the facility or if their membership is revoked, that person has the right to request a special meeting of a PIPA/Espire Sports committee to discuss and/or challenge the ruling in question. The determination of the committee will be made at that time. The player/person in question will be allowed to continue playing at the facility until a verdict is determined unless the committee feels it is unsafe or a danger to others.
