FAMILIES DAY 7

Ephesians 5:21-6:4 NIV

²¹ And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. ²² For wives, this means submit to your husbands as to the Lord. ²³ For a husband is the head of his wife as Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of His body, the church. ²⁴ As the church submits to Christ, so you wives should submit to your husbands in everything. ²⁵ For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up His life for her ²⁶ to make her holy and clean, washed by the cleansing of God's word. ²⁷ He did this to present her to Himself as a glorious church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish. Instead, she will be holy and without fault. ²⁸ In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as they love their own bodies. For a man who loves his wife actually shows love for himself. ²⁹ No one hates his own body but feeds and cares for it, just as Christ cares for the church. ³⁰ And we are members of His body. ³¹ As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united into one." ³² This is a great mystery, but it is an illustration of the way Christ and the church are one. ³³ So again I say, each man must love his wife as he loves himself, and the wife must respect her husband.

6 ¹ Children, obey your parents because you belong to the Lord, for this is the right thing to do. ² "Honor your father and mother." This is the first commandment with a promise: ³ If you honor your father and mother, "things will go well for you, and you will have a long life on the earth." ⁴ Fathers, do not provoke your children to anger by the way you treat them. Rather, bring them up with the discipline and instruction that comes from the Lord.

Heavenly Father, we humbly come before You, seeking unity among families in our nation. We affirm that marriage, as ordained by You, is sacred and intended to be between a man and a woman. Grant us understanding and reverence for this divine institution. We decree that within marriage, the man serves as the head of the family, and the woman as his suitable partner, completing the union in Your design. We earnestly pray that You cultivate a desire within people to honor marriage and to refrain from cohabitation outside of this blessed covenant. May Your guidance lead individuals to embrace Your direction and the blessings that flow from a committed marital relationship.

We come in agreement with Your plan and stand against the enemy's agenda to distort and dismantle family unity. In the authority bestowed upon us by the blood of Jesus and in His name, we command every evil spirit assigned to sow discord, perversion, and destruction within families to depart right now.

Lord, we implore You to intervene and shutter any organization aimed at undermining families, including abortion clinics. We lift up every doctor, nurse, and staff member working in these clinics, praying for a divine encounter with You that leads to repentance, salvation, and a redirection of their lives to aid women in need.

Grant the people a deep understanding of the sanctity of life and covenant of marriage. May love and respect abound among all family members. We speak blessings of salvation, love, respect, health, and security over every family in our country in the mighty name of Jesus. Amen.

- ¹⁷ Some were fools; they rebelled and suffered for their sins. ¹⁸ They couldn't stand the thought of food, and they were knocking on death's door. ¹⁹ "LORD, help!" they cried in their trouble, and He saved them from their distress. ²⁰ He sent out His word and healed them, snatching them from the door of death. ²¹ Let them praise the LORD for His great love and for the wonderful things He has done for them. ²² Let them offer sacrifices of thanksgiving and sing joyfully about His glorious acts.
- ²³ Some went off to sea in ships, plying the trade routes of the world. ²⁴ They, too, observed the LORD's power in action, His impressive works on the deepest seas. ²⁵ He spoke, and the winds rose, stirring up the waves. ²⁶ Their ships were tossed to the heavens and plunged again to the depths; the sailors cringed in terror. ²⁷ They reeled and staggered like drunkards and were at their wits' end. ²⁸ "LORD, help!" they cried in their trouble, and He saved them from their distress. ²⁹ He calmed the storm to a whisper and stilled the waves. ³⁰ What a blessing was that stillness as He brought them safely into harbor! ³¹ Let them praise the LORD for His great love and for the wonderful things He has done for them. ³² Let them exalt Him publicly before the congregation and before the leaders of the nation.
- ³³ He changes rivers into deserts, and springs of water into dry, thirsty land. ³⁴ He turns the fruitful land into salty wastelands, because of the wickedness of those who live there. ³⁵ But He also turns deserts into pools of water, the dry land into springs of water. ³⁶ He brings the hungry to settle there and to build their cities. ³⁷ They sow their fields, plant their vineyards, and harvest their bumper crops. ³⁸ How He blesses them! They raise large families there, and their herds of livestock increase.
- ³⁹ When they decrease in number and become impoverished through oppression, trouble, and sorrow, ⁴⁰ the LORD pours contempt on their princes, causing them to wander in trackless wastelands. ⁴¹ But He rescues the poor from trouble and increases their families like flocks of sheep. ⁴² The godly will see these things and be glad, while the wicked are struck silent. ⁴³ Those who are wise will take all this to heart; they will see in our history the faithful love of the LORD.

Lord, with grateful hearts and praise we come before You. We want to lift Your name high and shout to the world of Your wonderful works. Your mercy and love endure forever.
