The offspring (calf or swine project animal) at the time of birth must be dropped/birthed on Indian River Co. soil. This rule is enforced to eliminate an exhibitor from buying a bred cow or sow out of the County limits and bringing it into the county and calling it an Indian River Co Bred animal.

The County Bred Steer/Swine is an award to recognize and <u>support Indian River</u> <u>Co. producers of Beef & Swine.</u>
