This is the eighth year that Indian River County has had a "Barn Queen and King" Contest. This is a great way to meet new friends under the barn and to have fun while at the fair.

Elegibility

All participants must be currently registered with IRCYLH, be in good standing and turn in all paper work on time.

Production

The production will take place under the barn, in the arena on Friday, March 9, at 7:30 p.m. All participants shall be ready to go at 7:00 p.m. The participants will enter the arena in a single file line, and will line up according to their age division against the stage. Judges will be sitting in the middle of the arena and the announcers will be standing next to the participants to introduce them and to ask them questions. Each Participant will receive their chance to shine by modeling in front of the judges.

Attire

For the production, all contestants must wear "country wear" in order to participate. We recommend that each participant wears nice jeans and closed in shoes for the production. We will not allow participants to wear hats during the production and **all attire must be "IRCYLH and 4-H appropriate".** This means no shorts more than 4" above the knee, blouse straps must be at least 2" wide, no spaghetti strap, halter or tube tops, no cut-off or muscle shirts and no offensive or inappropriate language, graphics or logo t-shirts.

Prizes Awarded

There will be **eight awards with four different categories:** Senior Barn Queen/King, Jr./Int. Barn Princess/Prince and Cloverbud Barn Princess/Prince. There will be two winners for each category, one male and one female. Females will receive a tiara and sash. Males will receive caps and sashes.
