To be considered for the Indian River bred Steer/Swine Award, the mother (cow,dam,sow) of the project animal must have been on/in Indian River Co. soil at the time of servicing (be either artificial insemination or live bull/boar). The offspring (calf or swine project animal) at the time of birth must be dropped/birthed on Indian River County soil. This rule is enforced to eliminate an exhibitor from buying a bred cow or sow out of the County limits and bringing it into the county and calling it an Indian River County Bred animal.

The County Bred Steer/Swine is an award to recognize and <u>support Indian River</u> County producers of Beef & Swine.
