Dear Friends

Greetings.

I am happy to present the Annual report for the Period from 1st April 2022 to 31st March 2023 to the General Body of SUCHI.

This reporting period covers later part of COVID 19 and Post COVID 19 period.

With the support and coordination of our former funding partners especially we were able to carry out to:

- Distributing COVID -19 Protective and Preventive Kits to 300 front line workers(to ASHA workers, ANMs) with digital thermometer, Pulse oxy - meter Sanitizer, Face mask, Face Shield etc , Covering 07 PHCs our working area.
- Distributed BP apparatus, Digital thermometer, sanitizer, gloves face mask and face shield to 04 PHCs.
- Vaccination Improvement awareness camps and vaccination camps organized in 3 mandals.



During this period SUCHI awaited for the FCRA Renewal, Therefore we could not get a positive response to our Project/ Funding applications for long term support. However Our team was involved in follow up on the families affected and infected with COVID -19.

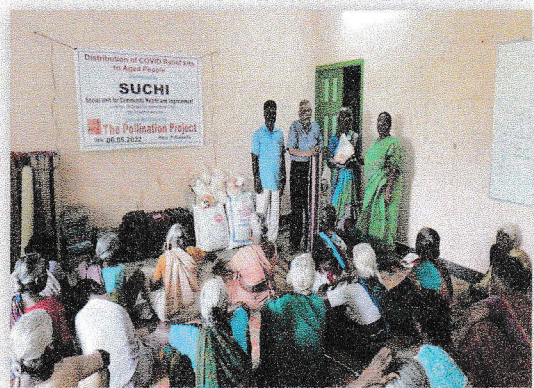
During this period we were able to apply for short term projects based on the needs and problems. We were able to mobilize a couple projects and its reports are as follows:

Post COVID Relief kit /Support to the aged The Pollination Project.

During COVID the aged/ elderly were not recognised and not given priority in any form, during post COVID 19 our team recognised this and through TPP- The Pollination Project we were able to get a small fund and we provided basic need based kits to the aged women above the age of 60 years who are deprived of care and support by their family. we were able to recognise and support the aged women (both aged widows and aged women living with her aged husband.

Following items were given to them. The aged were very much moved and it was a very meaningful event when we distributed the kits to them:

- ✓ Mat - 01
- ✓ Bed sheet - 02
- ✓ Saree - 01
- ✓ Provision Item - (Toor Dhal, Channa, Rava, Salt, Jaggery, Bath Soap, Washing Soap, oil, Nutrition Mix)



Support to Rural School Going Girl Children with Study Stationeries from OTF International Assistance Committee - Project Reference

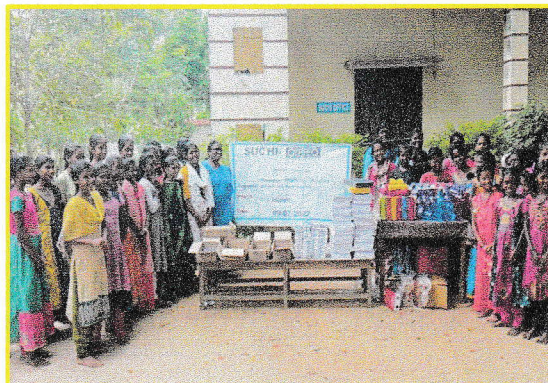
Though the school going children get free study materials / stationeries, due to its usage the students they need more. In order to support and encourage girl students we proposed to extend support to Girl students between 12 to 15 years so that girl students can be motivated in their studies as well they can free from their burden of buying study materials.

Following items were distributed to girls students.

- ✓ Note books Long - 02
- ✓ Note books Small - 02
- ✓ Geometry Box - 01
- ✓ Writing items - (Pen, Pencil, Eraser, Sharpener and a small Pouch)
- ✓ Drinking water bottle - 01

Giving Study Stationeries to Rural School going girls



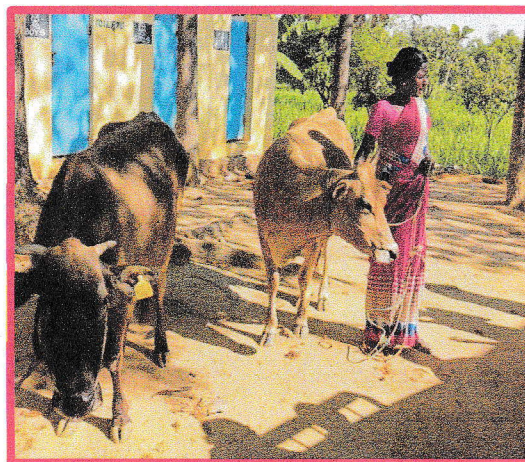
MfM - Mothers in Small Business Project (Ongoing Project)

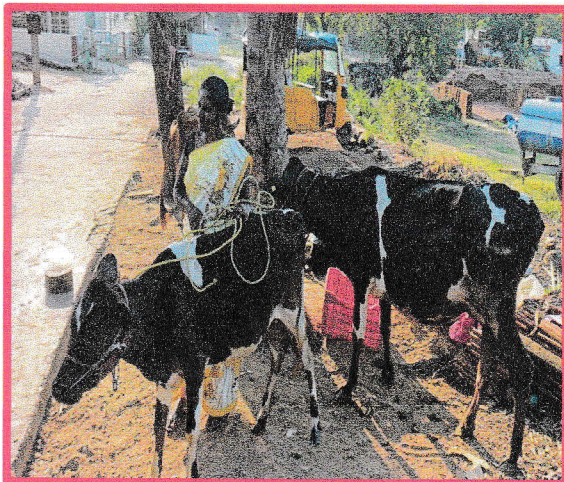
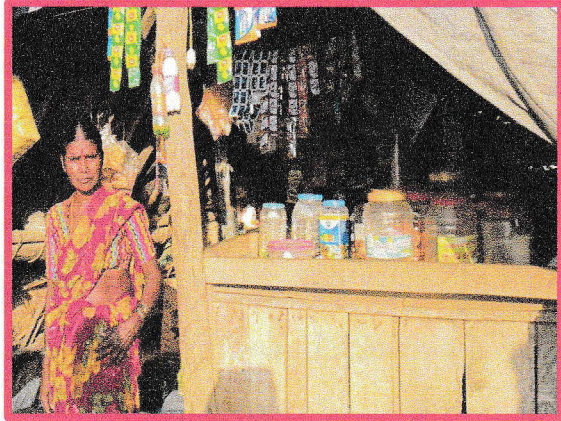
This project was started in the year 2019, to Empower the rural deserving women through Economic development with a specific focus to improve women income/ family income , to promote business asset there by to ensure sustainability of small business and their improved income.

This project is supported by Microcredit for Mothers from the Netherlands.

During this period through this project we have covered 38 women to start small business in cow rearing, Goat Rearing, Sale of Tender coconut, Small Tiffin stall etc.

During the reporting period MfM representative visited SUCHI to assess this project. Visited villages, interacted with our women small enterpruners and were very much satisfied with the visible outcome with our women and extended their support to another new batch of women and SUCHI was choosen to be visited by the Dutch women leaders' jounery team to visit our women empowerment through the economic development during 2023.





Eye Screening Camp & Free Cataract Surgery :

With coordination of Sankara Nethralaya outreach Project “Mission for Vision” every month the team conducts eye screening camp at SUCHI center, SUCHI coordinate in publicity and organizing the camp at our center.

This eye screening camp helps the people from rural remote areas to avail this facility and to get their vision checked, and the cataract identified persons are taken by their vehicle and after free cataract surgery they are brought back to our center, follow up also is done through camps.

During this reporting period 04 Eye screening camp conducted 217 attended the camp, 31 had free cataract surgery and got their eye sight back.
