PROGRAMME DIRECTOR'S ANNUAL WORKING REPORT

Dear Members of SUCHI,

I am pleased to welcome you all to this ' FIFTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING ' of SUCHI and present the Society's Statement of Accounts and Auditor's Report. The year ending 31.12.1987 was a great successful year for SUCHI in the sense that during the year SUCHI has taken-up many Developmental and Health activities by ^{us} ~~the Partners~~ with many International Voluntary Agencies and Government Agencies. assistance.

I am giving here under the brief activities of SUCHI during the year ending 31.12.1987.

DEVELOPMENTAL ACTIVITIES:-

The major partners in funding us for developmental activities during the year are ICCO, OXFAM America, MCC, IGSSS, FORRAD, CAPART and AFPRO, with the assistance of above agencies the following Programmes were carried on:-

1. Preventive Health Care & Development Programme, Nonformal, and Adult Education Programme, Cultural & Awareness building, Mass & Leadership Meeting, Purchase of land with the assistance of ICCO.
2. Palm-leaf Vocational training programme, Tailoring, Construction of Women Training Centre Building, Revolving Fund Programme, Purchase of Lease Land, Construction of Community Halls in the Villages and Women awareness programmes with the assistance of OXFAM America and M.C.C.
3. Dairy Development Schemes and education programme with the assistance of Indo-German Social Service Society (IGSSS).

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4. Digging of Community Irrigation wells, Deepening of Community Irrigation Wells, Drinking Water Wells, Community Drinking Water Bores, Fire and Flood relief Programmes with the assistance of CASA.
5. Digging of Trial Pits and organising and Motivating the Agricultural beneficiaries and educating the beneficiaries with the assistance of UELCI.
6. Mobilisation of Bank loans, Government Schemes, Mango Orchard, subsidy and margin money arranged for 53 beneficiaries with the assistance of Government.
7. Sanitation Programme for total 4 villages with the assistance of CAPART.

HEALTH AND DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRAMMES:

Community Ophthalmic Service programmes with the assistance of RCSB and the Co-ordination and Co-operation of CMCH, Schell Eye Hospital, VELLORE. In total 4 Eye Surgery Camps and 11 One Day Eye Camps were Conducted with the Co-operation and Co-ordination of CMCH, Schell Eye Hospital, VELLORE. In Total 5757 Patients were Screened and 301 Catract Patients were Operated and provided with Glass.

IMMUNISATION , SANITATION AND FAMILY HEALTH CARE PROGRAMMES:

We have conducted monthly Camps for Educating the rural women about Sanitation, Child care, Immunisation, Family Planning, Screening for Leprosy and Tuberculosis (T.B) Patients for followup.

CONCLUSION:-

In the Year 1987 a Total Foreign Contribution of Rs. 5,51,208-30 was Utilised Rs. 5,24,528-87 and we have developed very close and strong assurance with our Donors due to our Sincere and methodical efforts.

Our ongoing Programmes were evaluated by third Party agencies and a very impressive evaluation opinion was given to our donars regarding SUCHI's Performance.

During the coming Years SUCHI Plans to construct a own building for all its Vocational Training Programmes and Health care Programmes at Rangempeta cross Road, Puthala Pattu Mandal at a Cost of Rs. 1.50 Lakhs.
