PROGRAMME DIRECTOR'S ANNUAL WORKING REPORT

Dear Members of SUCHI.

I welcome all the members of SUCHI, for the ' Seventh Annual General Body Meeting ', presenting the Annual report, statement of accounts and Auditor's report for the year ending 31st March 1990. We have built up good co-ordination with the present aiding agencies and I am happy to say that few more foreign and Indian agencies have come forward aiding certain need based community developmental programmes. First of all I thank ICCO, OXFAM America, M.C.C., for their continuing support and encouragement in our endeavour of Health and integrated community development programmes. I am confident that they will continue to support us in the adopted villages as well as newly adopted villages adjoining to our area as no other voluntary agency is likely to work in these areas.

About the new partners, it is a great privilege to co-ordinate with CANADA FUNDS for having sponsored the Vocational training programmes that is typewriting and carpentry. They have also given us a budget for a building at Jodichinthala, which is under way. In this context we are grateful to Mr. Vincent E. Thakur for all the help during the process.

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I sincerely thank OXFAM America for the sponsored project 'NON-FORMAL EDUCATION' programme, so that those who have not gone to the school so far will have an opportunity of education which is a turning point of their life.

ICCO, who is our principle partner sponsored programme will be completed by April 1991. I will be requesting ICCO to sponsor, new adopted areas, so that with our gained experience all these years could be utilised in a very effective way.

With one of the M.C.C. support we have successfully conducted the eye camps. Two one day eye camps and one 10 days surgical camp were conducted.

Specially we thank Dr. Ravi Thomas, Head of the Department of Ophthalmogy, Schell Eye Hospital, CMCH, Vellore for the eye rehabilitation programme and I thank the institute for extended the facility for the needy poor people. We are grateful to M.C.C. for having assured of a Van during 1991, seeing our expanded area of work and health involvement. In this context we thank Mr. Stephen-Gonsalves, MCC for all the efforts undertaken.

It is a remarkable year in the history of SUCHI that our Maternity Child Health Centre has started functioning. I am sorry to say that yet we are not in a position to inaugurate the same due to work load of our programmes. Our MCH centre is a great assert for the villagers around Rangampet Cross Road.

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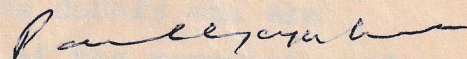

In the aspect of community organising various sangams like Elders, Youths and Women have shown considerable independency. They need only partial assistance from us in their activities. I have no hesitation to say that there is a significant impact of the mass-education in terms of street theatre programme, Video-Coverage, health education covering various topics like wage issue, small savings, environmental sanitation and alcoholism etc., people are much benefitted by certain income generating programmes like Dairy through which they earn considerable amount solving their unemployment problem. One can see people are keen in maintaining the dairy. It is one of the more attractive programme in our area.

I am eagerly looking for further extension of areas so that people will be benefitted to the maximum of our experience.
