The 51st Annual Fall Scientific Paper Session of the Rochester Academy of Science will be hosted by The State University of New York at Geneseo on Saturday, November 1, 2025 from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The address for SUNY Geneseo is 1 College Circle, Geneseo, NY 14454.

The purpose of this event is to provide a venue for science students and faculty of local colleges and universities with an opportunity to gather and share their research interests and research results with posters or oral presentations.

The Rochester Academy of Science Annual Larry King Memorial Fall Lecture will be held at this event. Our distinguished speaker is Dr. Marc Abrams, the Nancy and John Steimer Professor of Ecosystem Science and Management at Penn State. His topic is *Native Americans, Smokey the Bear and the rise and fall of eastern oak forests.*

There is no charge to attend, but please register even if not presenting.

If presenting, submit your abstract with the fee of \$10 per abstract, regardless of number of authors. If any authors are members of the Rochester Academy of Science you will receive a \$5 rebate.
