Robbie Ligon is a Mississippi-based photographer whose work explores the intersection of memory, meaning, and divine presence through visual storytelling. Residing with her husband and their three children, whom they homeschool, Robbie's creative journey began with a desire to preserve the precious moments of family life. Over time, this effort grew into a disciplined and intentional artistic practice rooted in both faith and a profound appreciation for the beauty woven into everyday moments.

Drawing inspiration from the biblical account in Joshua 4:1-8, where God instructs the Israelites to set up stones of remembrance as markers of His faithfulness, Robbie views each photograph as a "Stone of Remembrance." Her work serves as a visual testimony of God's goodness and faithfulness, evident in both seasons of joy and times of hardship. Through her lens, she strives to honor the beauty God places before her, creating images that speak to the soul and encourage reflection.

Robbie's photographic portfolio spans documentary, portraiture, still life, macro, food, fine art, and artistic projects. Robbie's approach is grounded in thoughtfully observing the world around her, with a focus on details, natural light, and authentic moments that convey meaning.

Her artistic philosophy is grounded in the belief that beauty when thoughtfully observed, reveals evidence of God's handiwork. Each image becomes a way of pausing to acknowledge God's presence, celebrating His faithfulness, and inviting others to see glimpses of His work in both the ordinary and the extraordinary. Photography, for her, is both a creative and spiritual practice, a means of bearing witness, of slowing down, and of creating space to remember and reflect.

Robbie's artistic images have been featured on various online platforms, published in magazines, and recognized in contests. In 2025, she was accepted as a Click Pro Elite based on a portfolio review. The judges stated, "Robbie presented a lovely portfolio full of authenticity and simple beauty. Her work has depth and draws in her viewer with her simple yet captivating content."
