NOTICE REGARDING BACKGROUND INVESTIGATION

Caddo Nation of Oklahoma may obtain information about you from a consumer reporting agency for employment purposes. Thus, you may be the subject of a "consumer report" and/or an "investigative consumer report" which may include information about your character, general reputation, personal characteristics, driving record, and/or mode of living, and which can involve personal interviews with sources such as your current and past employers, friends, or associates, as well as past employment information in compliance with regulations of the US Department of Transportation (DOT), including 49 CFR Part 40 time after receipt of your authorization and, if you are hired, throughout your employment. You have the right, upon written request made within a reasonable time after receipt of this notice to request disclosure of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report. Please be advised that the nature and scope of the most common form on investigative consumer report obtained with regard to applicants for employment is an investigation into your education and/or employment history conducted by PreHire Screening Services LLC, 1201 Sovereign Row, Oklahoma City, OK 73108. 1(866)405-4473. The scope of this notice and authorization is all-encompassing, however, allowing the Caddo Nation of Oklahoma to obtain from any outside organization all manner of consumer reports and investigative consumer reports now and, if you are hired, throughout the course of your employment to the extent permitted by law. As a result, you should carefully consider whether to exercise your right to request disclosure of the nature and scope of any investigative consumer report.

- Consumer reporting agencies may not report outdated negative information. In most cases, a consumer reporting
 agency may not report negative information that is more than seven years old, or bankruptcies that are more than 10
 years old.
- Access to you file is limited. A consumer reporting agency may provide information about you only to people with a valid need usually to consider an application with a creditor, insurer, employer, landlord, or other business. The FCRA specifies those with a valid need for access.
- You must give you consent for reports to be provided to employers. A consumer reporting agency may not give out information about you to your employer, or a potential employer, without your written consent given to the employer. Written consent generally is not required in the trucking industry. For more information, go to www.ftc.gov/credit.
