The Child Care participates as a member of the Child Care Team in cooperation with all staff members, being professionally in job performance, complying with the confidentiality policy and personnel policies and procedures. Collaborate with local agencies to establish, promote, and oversee the fulfillment of program goals. Participate in community assessment. Coordinate with appropriate programs to refer for emergency assistance of crisis intervention.

Preferred degree in Sociology, Education, Recreation, or related field. Three years of program management and implementation experience. Preferably one year of proven experience in programming experiences for young children between the ages of 0 to 12.
