- Appointed and seated Housing Board;
- Repairing old community building and dance ground and support Caddo Nation cultural resource efforts.
- I serve on the Southwest Indian Health Board representing the Caddo Nation
- Planning a new Veterans wall for our tribal veterans
- Supportive and active with the MMIW and Indian Boarding Schools Initiative
