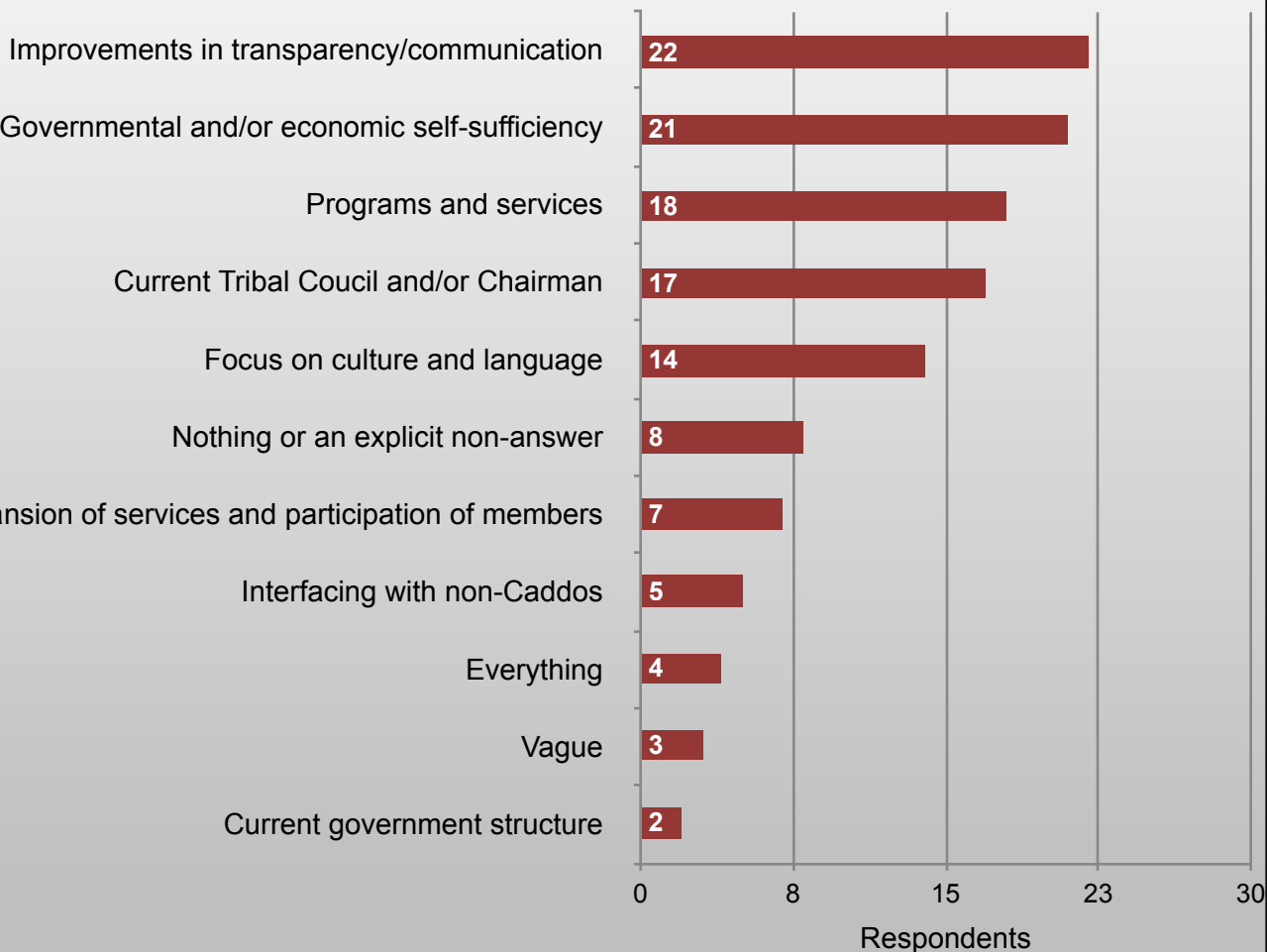
SURVEY 1 RESULTS

2026



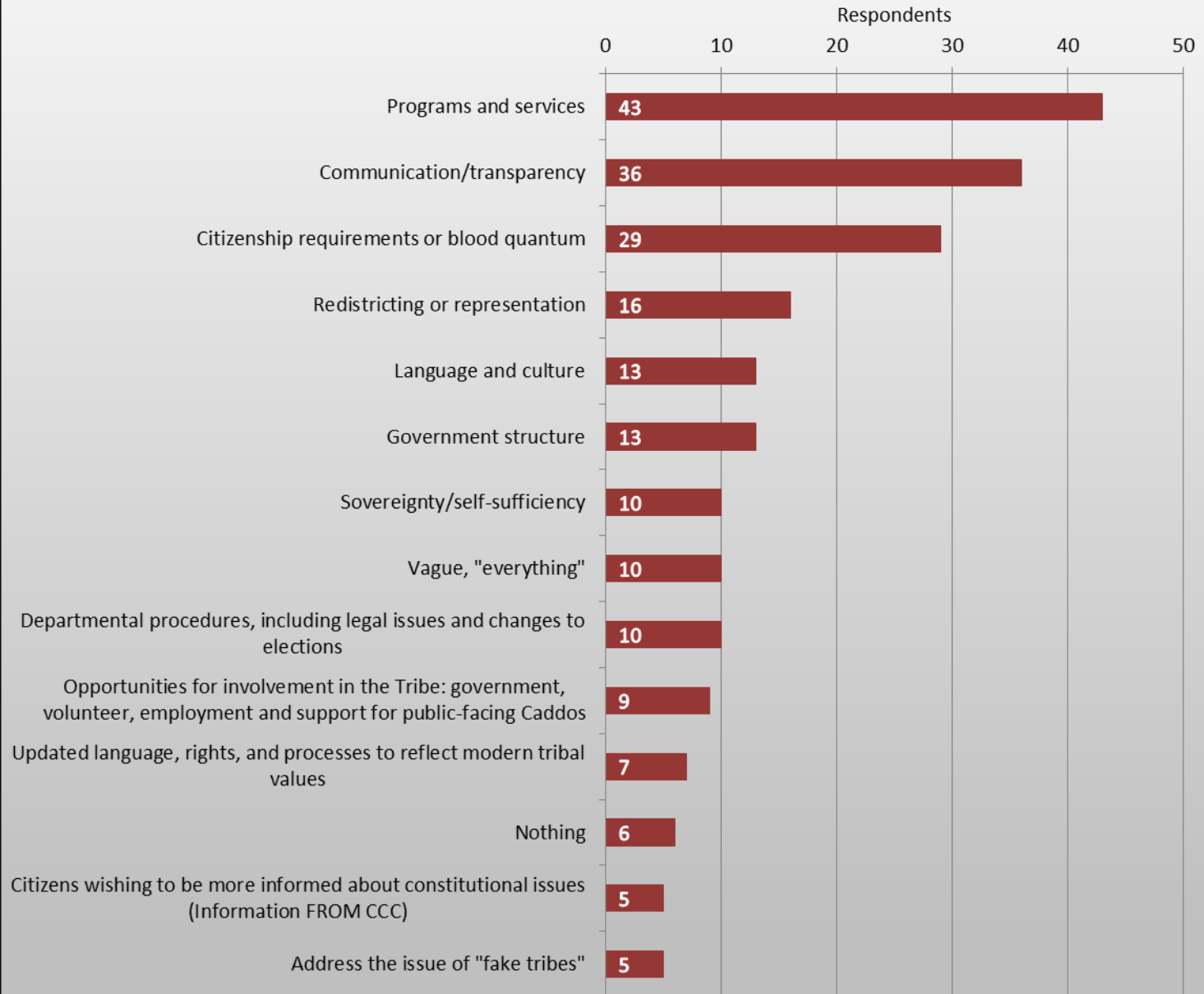
Positives mentioned by more than one respondent October – December 2025



Respondents liked recent improvements in transparency and communication, especially the effort to communicate with members through a variety of methods: meetings online, newspaper, departmental presence at meetings, website, and social media.

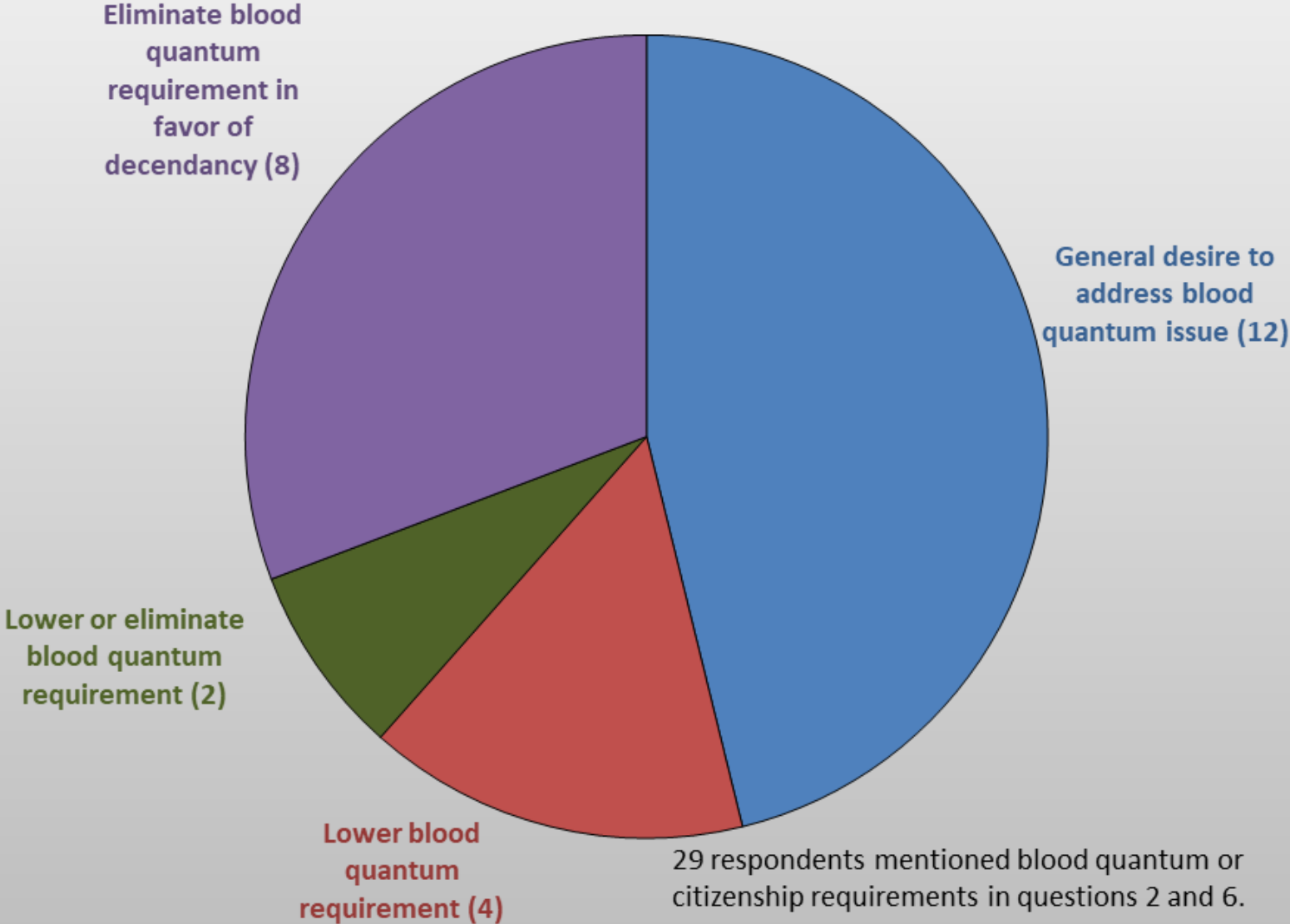
Respondents expressed enthusiasm for some programs and services, with special mentions of the language program (18), Child Care (4) and the Newspaper (5).

CITIZENSHIP REQUIREMENT SUBGROUPS

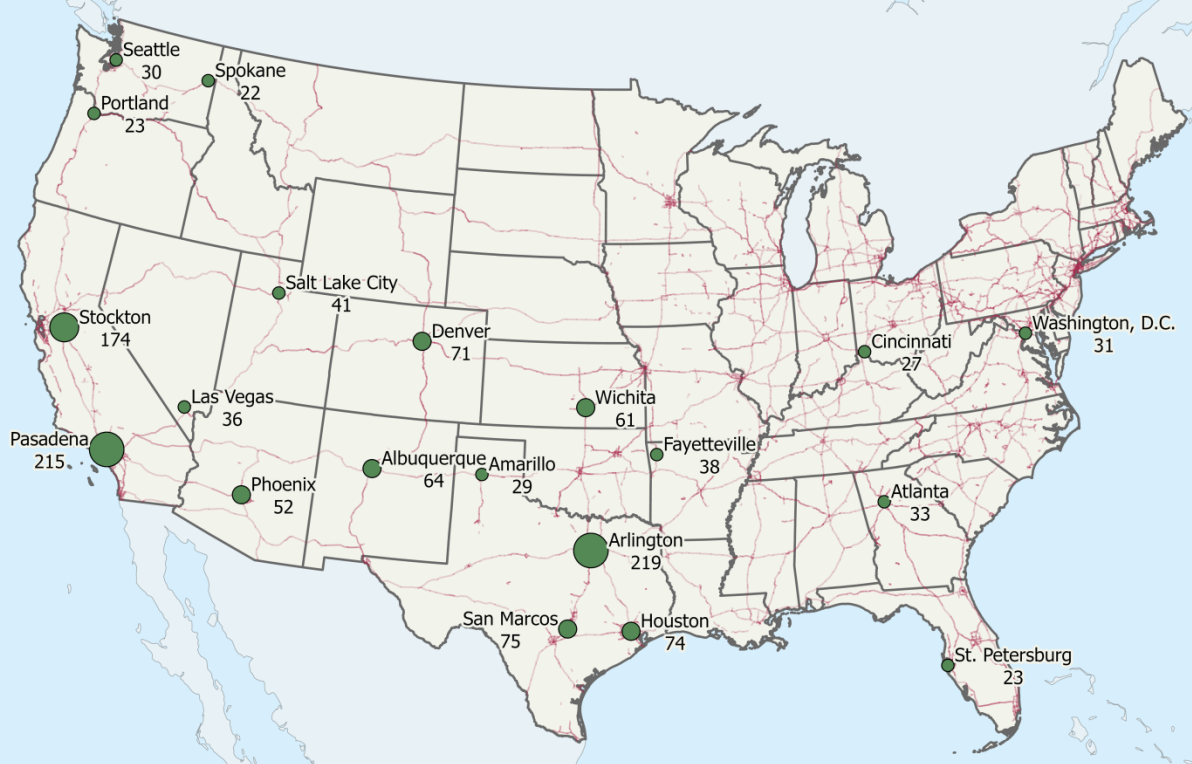
