

Red Hot Mamas St. Patrick's Day Festival 2020 Manual

Welcome to The Red Hot Mamas!!!

Mikki Stevens originated the "Mamas" in June of the early 90's as a performance opportunity for women over 18, or a mama, a Grandmama, a Great Grandmama, or just plain Great. It was her desire to train and build a performance group in the art of musical-comedy; to hear the healing music of an audience laughing in response to plain and simple comedy; to spread joy and cheer to the community by instructing and directing women who had dreams to perform "someday"; and to present the opportunity for women to be part of a big hearted organization in which they would have a unique and positive impact on each other and the audiences they would entertain. She placed an audition notice in the paper, which accompanied an article on her experience in showbiz, and women came out of the woodwork in hopes of participating. The rest is His-story.

Mikki believes that The Red Hot Mamas is the Lord's creation and perpetuation. Those in the company, who choose to do so, pray for the organization and each other before rehearsals and events.

The Red Hot Mamas official corporate name is Mik's Red Hot Mamas and is a group of amateurs doing professionally styled musical-comedy performances. This doesn't mean professionals can't come out to play. It means there are no cash rewards for individual performers. Women with no previous performance experience are encouraged to apply to the group and learn skills in dance, acting and presentation.

While The Red Hot Mamas resume is extensive and impressive with two Presidential Inaugurations, three Macy's Thanksgiving Parades, and London, England performances, the majority of the shows are Northwest community events.

They support at least one charitable organization monthly such as Veteran's Stand Down, Komen Race for the Cure, Habitat for Humanity, Cancer Charities, Special Olympics, I.C.A.R.E., North Idaho College, Red Cross, Children's Village, Hospice, and Residential Care Homes.

Be encouraged to let down and enjoy your involvement with the Red Hot Mamas! You are automatically a valuable member of a get-real-nosy support group and a valuable sistahchick of a dedicated group of zany performers.

This little manual came into existence to help clarify "stuff". Women of a certain age want to know "stuff". It presents the organization's basic policies, expectations and lines of communication.

WHO WE ARE: The **ZANY** Red Hot Mamas 100% **unique**, capturing the hearts of all ages. The group is composed of women with a **Genuine Zest for Life**, a Mama, GrandMama, Great GrandMama, OR just plain Great! Mamas are 18 to infinity with most members ranging in age from 40 to 60 (But don't try guessing which ones are over 60 unless you can run real fast!!) These women triumph over all life has to throw at them including illnesses and personal losses. **Hi-Spirited**, **Vibrant**, **Full of Fun**, and definitely: **ONE-OF-A-KIND**

WHAT WE ARE: The Red Hot Mamas Parade Unit is a dance/drill team featuring strollers, walkers, mop shopping carts, or any other idea we get. Drill precision and outrageous costumes cause a Rip Roarin' Riot wherever we go. The theatrical group produces the "U.S. Uh-oh" musical/comedy shows, well known for spoofs such as "The Blues Mothers", "Rappin' Dr. Gram", "Stomp" and "Riverprance" as we as infamous ballets. "Hold onto your aching stomach" laughter abounds.

EXPERIENCE: Our "showcase" performances include three Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parades, and two presidential invitations to Inaugural Parades in Washington, D.C. We appeared on Good Morning America, The Today Show, MTV and ABC's Nightline. Our London, England New Year's Day Performance is our "crowning" glory. We have performed in a variety of events nationwide including Philadelphia Independence Day, Hershey Centennial, Fiesta and Holiday Bowls, Seattle Seafair, Dallas Children's Hospital Benefit, Portland Rose Festival and Spokane's Lilac Festival. Many stage performances have been donated to fundraisers such as Red Cross Relief Fund, Habitat for Humanity, American Cancer Society, Service Organizations and Retirement Groups.

HONORS/AWARDS: We were presented the VFW Americanism award for writing and producing "The Triumphant American Spirit" play and leading community response to events of 9/11. The Red Hot Mamas **hilarious** parade unit was selected to be one of the eighty groups nationwide to perform in two Inaugural Parades. The unit consistently wins 1st place awards.

COSTUMES: The Mama's original costumes vary from bright colored housedresses with a variety of interesting glitzy aprons to rhinestoned hard hats and rapper gear. Costumes are customized to event themes.

MUSIC: Exciting music accompanies performances and features **dynamic, crowd-pleasing, up-lifting tunes** such as "We are Family", "We're Not Gonna Take It", "Born to be Wild", "Jump", "R U Ready for This?", "Old Time Rock n Roll", and "Shout". Music reflects event themes.

JUBILATION: The Red Hot Mamas **Spirit** of **Mirth** sets a **Tone** of **Celebration**. Audiences spontaneously burst into Joy and Laughter as they sing, dance and scream along. The Red Hots play to the crowd, creating a **Blast of Wholesome Fun**.

Depart to Dublin, Ireland

Day 2 Saturday, March 14 Dublin

Arrive in Dublin

Those who arrive in timing to meet our Tour Manager, will enjoy a

Panoramic tour of Dublin City, discovering the north and south side of the River Liffey. This area offers great striking monuments such as GPO (General Post Office) on the city main thoroughfare, O'Connell Street or the Custom House along the quays, as well as the Phoenix Park, the largest public park in Europe

Lunch, on your own, on the go

See the south side which appears more sophisticated with its vast Georgian squares, such as Merrion Square, where Oscar Wilde's House can still be found (today owned by an American College). View its colorful doors, along with Grafton Street and its quality shops. Not so far from St. Stephen's Green, in Kildare St., you will see the house of Bram Stoker, the author of Dracula. This part of the city is also dominated by the students of Trinity College, where the famous book of Kells is permanently exhibited in the library.

Visit **Trinity College**, Ireland's oldest university. Trinity College contains the **Book** of Kells, which dates from AD 800, making it one of the oldest books in the world. The university faces the medieval district where Dublin Castle and the two Anglican Cathedrals can be found

Dublin is Ireland's capital and its largest, most cosmopolitan city. The 'boom years' came in the 18th century and the city expanded across the river forming a new Dublin of stately squares, streets and Georgian mansions. Today, with its elegant Georgian streets, gregarious inhabitants and long history, it's little wonder Dublin is a city of writers









Breakfast included at the hotel

Morning visit to **Christchurch Cathedral**. Situated in the heart of the city, Christ Church Cathedral is Dublin's oldest working structure, and has welcomed pilgrims and visitors for almost 1,000 years. A working cathedral, Christ Church is renowned for its magnificent architecture and fascinating history. Visitors can admire the stunning stained glass and unique floor tiles of the cathedral nave. Also learn the secrets of **Strongbow's tomb** and uncover the amazing story of the heart of **St. Laurence O'Toole**, Dublin's patron saint

Visit **Dublin Castle**. Originally built in the 13th century on a site previously settled by the Vikings, Dublin Castle functioned as a military fortress, a prison, treasury, courts of law and the seat of English Administration in Ireland for 700 years. Rebuilt in the 17th, 18th, 19th and 20th centuries, Dublin Castle is now used for important state receptions and presidential inaugurations

Lunch, on own, as you choose

Stage Performance in Dublin in collaboration with Irish Performers.

Mamas who would like to do extra routines/songs/dances in this show need to attend extra rehearsals and may need to obtain costume pieces.

Free time or Optional: Enjoy dinner and entertainment at **The Irish House Party**. Located near the city centre in a beautiful 18th century townhouse, the Irish House Party is a truly unique experience in Dublin. It is traditional Irish music and Irish dancing at its very best, performed by all-Ireland champion musicians, dancers and entertaining presenters (Supplement of \$51 per person)

Evening dinner on own as you choose

Overnight in Clontarf Castle Hotel (or similar)

Day 4 Monday, March 16 Dublin / Limerick

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Morning transfer to Limerick with a visit to Rock of Cashel en route

Visit to the Rock of Cashel. Possibly the most photographed site in Ireland, the Rock of Cashel towers over the town of Cashel from its perch on a 200 foot high outcrop of limestone. One of the leading visitor attractions in Ireland, in 2011 it was visited by Queen Elizabeth II on her historic first visit to the Republic of Ireland

Lunch, on own

Irish dancing workshop at the Bru Boru Centre. (translated as "The Palace of Boru") is a national heritage centre at the foot of the Rock of Cashel. This cultural and interpretative village is designed around a village green and is home to the study and celebration of Irish music, song, dance, storytelling, theatre and Celtic studies

Continue on to Limerick

Perform in the St. Patrick's Festival Parade in Limerick

Afternoon visit TBD to **Blarney Stone in Cork OR Bunratty Castle**, the most complete and authentic medieval fortress in Ireland. Built in 1425 it was restored in 1954 to its former medieval splendor. Also visit the **Folk Park**, a living reconstruction of the homes and environment of Ireland of over a century ago. Stroll from house to house or around the charming village street to experience village life in 19th century Ireland

Day 6 Wednesday, March 18 Limerick / Adare

Breakfast included at the hotel

Visit to **St. John's Castle**. King John's Castle is situated on **'King's Island'** in the heart of medieval Limerick city. The Castle overlooks the majestic **river Shannon**. It was built between 1200 and 1210 and was repaired and extended many times in the following centuries. The courtyard and the Castle display some of the trades and traditions of the 16th Century. The Castle also offers panoramic views of Limerick City and the surrounding countryside

Free time or visit to **Adare**, regarded as one of Ireland's most picturesque villages. Adare is a small village with thatched cottages dotted throughout the town. These were created by the 3rd **Earl of Dunraven** in the 1820's for his estate workers and are used today as craft shops or restaurants

Evening dinner on own

Overnight at hotel

Day 7 1 Thursday, March 19 Cliffs of Moher / Galway

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Transfer to Galway via the Cliffs of Moher


Excursion to the Cliffs of Moher, one of Ireland's most spectacular sights. On a clear day, the views are tremendous

Light Lunch included with a traditional **Irish Music session at the Doolin Music House**. Christy Barry and his partner Sheila have entertained friends and musicians at their home for many years, sitting around the fire playing music and telling stories. Christy talks and discusses the history of traditional Irish music and plays great tunes together with his friend James Devitt. Light lunch can be served during the visit - smoked salmon and brown bread, Irish cheeses accompanied by a glass of wine or a soft drink

Overnight at hotel

Galway is picturesquely situated at the northeast end of Galway Bay, at the point where the short tidal River Corrib, coming from Lough Corrib, pours its' abundant flow of water into the Atlantic. With its narrow streets, old stone and wooden shopfronts, good restaurants and bustling pubs, it is one of Europe's fastest growing cities and ranks fourth in size in Ireland, after Dublin, Cork and Limerick

Day 8 Friday, March 20 Galway / Clonmacnoise / Dublin

Breakfast included at the hotel, followed by check-out

Transfer to Dublin via Clonmacnoise

Clonmacnoise is a wonderful early Christian site founded by St. Ciarán in the mid-6th century on the eastern bank of the River Shannon. In a stunning setting, the site includes the ruins of a cathedral, seven churches (10th -13th century), two round towers, three high crosses and the largest collection of early Christian graveslabs in Western Europe



Qualifications and Requirements to be cast in a role for the Red Hot Mamas' St. Patrick's Day Festival Performances

PERFORMER APPLICATION:

- 1. Attend an audition. Fee per Crew. \$10
- 2. Read the manual for complete requirements, inclusions, and costs.
- 3. Read and sign the two performer agreements (General and Trip) and submit to Crew Leader along with trip deposit.
- 4. Complete online "I Am a Red Hot Mama" registration
- 5. Attend an orientation in TBD in SEP-NOV to order costumes, sign up for committees/teams, sign up for optional *specialty* numbers for the Dublin show, make a travel hat, partayyyy!
- 6. Celebrate with all your new sistahchix.

SERVICE:

Each performer serves on a committee.

COMMUNICATIONS:

- Performers must have email address access and check email at least every other day. If your computer is "down", it is your responsibility to obtain printed copies of RHM emails from another Mama. If you change your email address, you must notify the RHMs.
- **Take full responsibility** to verify information is being passed on to you.
- If you do not hear from the RHM for a while, take initiative to call someone.
- Please don't blame anyone else in the organization for not letting you know. Make contact.
- Membership information may not be used without permission of the Producer.

HONORING COMMITMENTS:

- Check your schedule, your families, and anyone else you know prior to making a sign up commitment.
- Double-check the required rehearsal dates and mandatory requirements.
- Sign up to make a 100% commitment

There are NO refunds of ANY payments made for events for ANY reason other than trip cancelation by the tour company. In event of trip cancelation, Refunds will be as per tour company provided trip insurance (See page 10) and/or additional trip insurance personally purchased directly from tour company (See page 16) Performance related expenditures are not refundable.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To abide by the performer liability agreement.
- To abide by the Red Hot Mama St. Patrick's Day Festival 2020 Manual.
- To communicate internally with members in a positive and unified manner.
- To not be a Wild Hare. Individual performers may not represent the organization in any manner without written consent from the organization. Red Hot Mama costuming designs, routines and material belong to the RHMs. Individual performers do not own the right to use or modify them. They may arrange to do so only with the written consent from the organization.
- PHYSICAL/MEDICAL LIMITATIONS: It is the responsibility of each performer to operate within their own limitations and to request less strenuous roles even if your heart and soul doesn't want to.

ROLE EXECUTION:

The RHM organization may elect to remove a performer from an event or change the performer's role in an event if it becomes apparent that the performer has medical/mental/physical difficulties in the execution of their role. Some of the observations that make these difficulties apparent are a performer's inability to keep up with the rehearsal pace, execute choreography, smile consistently, keep hat in required placement on performers head, guide right and forward, and lead with the left foot. Performer may be required to file a written permission note from a licensed medical physician with the RHM's.

EMERGENCY PERFORMERS:

There may be times emergencies arise and last minute performers will be sought out and included without having met all the criteria for an event. This would only happen if the Producer determined it was in the best interest of the whole unit's performance.



CHAIN OF COMMUNICATION

Our leadership team has worked hard to arrange an orderly and fun time for all, please dop to oach organizers, hotel personnel, drivers, travel agents or anyone else on your own with question gestions or to try to make rearrangements. This looks bad for our group. Let's handle ourselves professionally and go to our mama organizers. Contact your crew leader who will contact RHM Crew Leaders as needed.

A friendly reminder, as per Mik's Red Hot Mamas performer/liability:

- 1. Performers may not, without written permission from the organization:
 - Wear RHM costume designs, present RHM music and routines, perform or appear as a RHM, give interviews or stories or represent themselves as a RHM in any way other than in sanctioned RHM events.
 - Create or recreate apparel, logos, photos or RHM printed material of any kind without written permission from the organization.
 - Sell any RHM related items, ideas, or material without written permission from the organization.
 - Speak for or enter into any agreement or arrangement or make any deals as or for the RHMs. All such opportunities process through the Red Hot Mama President.
- 2. LIABILITY: Participation in Mik's Red Hot Mamas is voluntary and, as such, each participant assumes full responsibility for themselves and any risks involved, including road hazards and unexpected parade route conditions.

REHEARSAL SCHEDULE and REQUIREMENTS



REHEARSALS

Two rehearsals with the RHM group are required weekly January 14 to March 10. All performers must meet the required number of rehearsals in order to perform in the event. Not meeting the requirements is self-elimination from the performance. PAID FEES REMAIN NON-REFUNDABLE. Your choice is to travel with the group as a non-performer or try to sell your reservation to an RHM leadership approved someone else who can meet criteria.

Arriving more than 15 minutes late or leaving more than 15 minutes early is an absence.

Your Crew Leader will post times/days of the mandatory two rehearsals per week. These ARE MANDATORY FOR EVERYONE unless you are on the excused rehearsal chart that was prearranged *prior* to accepting a role in The Ireland Performance Tour.

Emergencies: In the event an emergency causes a performer to unexpectedly miss a required scheduled rehearsal, your Crew Leader must be notified via phone prior to the start of that rehearsal. In the event a performer is unable to make notification prior to the rehearsal, notification must be made within 24 hours. No notification as above will result in an unexcused absence with published consequences. **TEXAS CREW-should text 817-395-3475**

DRESS REHEARSALS ARE FOR *ALL* PERFORMERS, *ALL* COSTUMES, PROPS AND MAKEUP UNLESS OTHERWISE ANNOUNCED. Not meeting deadlines and standards is self-elimination from performances.

- Much as we love sharing a little gift, socializing, and goodies, DO NOT DO IT IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO OR DURING REHEARSALS. *Especially not just before we start*. It is awkward for everyone and takes up designated rehearsal time that other performers want us to hold to strictly. Enjoy special time after rehearsal.
- No family, friends, children, gum, cell phones (turn sound off and do not carry it on your person. If you have an emergency reason, clear it with rehearsal leader before rehearsal).
- **Be prepared to fully participate on time**. Supportive athletic shoes and workout attire on. Water bottle handy. Cell phone off and put away. Ready to rehearse.
- Please don't make us cry. Performers carve out this time to play together. It is our "Happy" time. Please refrain from asking about health issues and personal challenges from the time we arrive until dismissal. We all have 24/7 to ask one another about the issues and challenges we face other than our precious joyful time together.
- Costume issue and return dates TBD are required. If you are not able to attend for any reason, arrange for someone else to do it for you. Please return to Fuller Rhythm Studio.

TENTATIVE COST AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Cost to Participate in the Red Hot Mamas trip to perform in the St. Patrick's Day Festival in Ireland - Ground Package only – self-arrange air and transport to and from airport/hotel/airport. Performer \$3,399. Non-performer \$3,299. (Subject to changes in fees, surcharges, etc.)

MAKING PAYMENTS: TBA by your RHM Crew Leader. **ALL payments are non-refundable for ANY and ALL reasons.** RHM makes a contractual commitment on your behalf when you sign up and will need to honor it even if you don't end up performing.

TEXAS CREW air transportation is separate from the fees above.

We are currently looking at group options and estimate \$1,000 for flights.

BASIC INFORMATION

WE PRAY: All Mamas' are **welcome** to join in the prayer circle prior to performances or rehearsals or whenever prayer happens. If you would like someone to pray with/for you, it is our Joy. Just give RHMs prayer team a nudge. Please know performers are not required to believe in or join in prayer. It is totally an individual choice.

PERFORMANCE MATERIAL

- Dublin Stage Show routines
- Limerick St. Patrick's Day Parade routine
- Learn and practice cadences as assigned with choreography
- Optional singing, tap dance, twirling, instruments, etc. for mini shows. For those who are willing to attend extra rehearsals and put additional costume pieces together.

TEAM CHAIRMAMA INSTRUCTIONS

The Creative Director will give all team leaders their job description sheets. Team leaders contact their team members to plan the completion of their part of preparing for the RHM Irish jig!

CONDUCT

Behaving in a disruptive manner, interrupting rehearsals, loud or troublesome comments, disrespecting members or leadership, or using lewd language or innuendo, or cursing during rehearsals or any Mama gathering/function can be cause for elimination from the trips, performances, and events. One verbal warning will be given. The second offense is self-elimination. All payments made for trips, fees, or any other items remain non-refundable.

COSTUMES and PROPS

- We will assemble costumes for Dublin St. Patrick's Festival Show and Limerick St Patrick's Day Parade
- Costumes and Props will differ according to the role in which performers are cast.
- NLY previously approved costumes and Props allowed. A deadline for all approvals will be announced. Performers may not get something else approved after the deadline and may not replace an approved item. The costume teams will be finished with this task on the deadline date.
- Performers showing up for performances missing assigned and approved costume and/or prop items will not perform.
- Exact design of each item with be provided. DO NOT PURCHASE ANYTHING without specific instruction.

PERFORMANCE MAKE-UP

- We will wear full on RHM performance makeup.
- Instructions call for 2 shades darker foundation than normal, applying more of the same shade will not darken the pigment of the product. Please obtain a pigmented product that is darker as per directions.
- Bright lights and cameras draw color from the skin. High cost make-up not needed.
- Apply all eye makeup as if your eye were bigger than it is.

CONCEALER: White or very light. A lighter pigment than you would normally use.

BASE MAKE-UP: To be opaque, heavy coverage, one or two shades darker than normal.

EYEBROWS: Dark brown (yes. even if you have fair complexion) Full. Extended Arch

EYE SHADOW: Dark Brown. Cover eyelid from lashes to just below the brow.

EYE LASHES: **Black mascara** regardless of your natural color. Sorry, no glittery lashes or eye lids. They do not photograph well due to light reflections.

LINING EYES: Line upper + lower eyelid with a wide **black** line not bringing corners together.

BLUSH: Fire engine **RED!** You may use lipstick or powder blush. Cover outer, upper cheekbone and bring out and up toward hairline.

LIPS: Fire engine **RED!** Apply lipstick, blot, dust with loose powder, reapply lipstick. If you have narrow lips, get creative and make them a little fuller!

POWDER: When all make-up is on, cover with translucent or darker shade—not a light shade. Removes the shine and seals colors. Re-apply powder blush if needed.

NAILS: KELLY GREEN! Fancy decorations as you wish. These mamas are Celebrating!!

ROOMING

- No charges to the rooms. If something is ordered, pay for it on the spot.
- No phone service from rooms except room to room.

WHAT TO EXPECT PERFORMANCE DAYS

- EXTRAVAGANT FUN!!!!!
- No family or friends in parade assembly/dispersal.
- No cameras/phones en route. Please refrain from phone until the work is done.
- Watch out for your stuff. Don't leave anything unattended.
- Do not accept instructions from parade officials for the group. Refer anyone and everyone trying to direct you or tell you what to do to Mikki. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Do not give out information to parade officials, as you may not be current. Things can change rapidly and you may not have current info. **ALWAYS refer them to Mikki.**
- Do not leave the area. If you have an emergency, tell squad leader and go with a buddy.
- When we load the bus to the performances, we are in full costume with:
 - Touch up makeup, necessities, and anything you will eat prior to the parade must fit in your jacket pocket. Food not eaten will need to be abandoned.
 - Photo ID, medical form and cash attached inside RIGHT side of costume such as pocket.
 - A small sealed disposable bottle of water or small mixed sport drink or blend of both (This bottle will be abandoned prior to the parade)
 - Clear plastic raincoat.
 - Hard candy or lemon drops in costume pocket as you wish.
 - Props, décor items, music.
 - Plan to meet friends and family on parade day <u>after</u> we are finished putting everything away

ANYTHING BROUGHT OUT OF THE BUS HAS TO BE ABANDONED OR TRANSPORTED. ANYTHING THE RHMS HAVE NOT PLANNED IN ADVANCE TO TRANSPORT DOWN A PARADE ROUTE WILL BE ABANDONED.

PRE PARADE/SHOW PREPARATION

- Prepare to take in all in. Eat a good breakfast. Drink water. Take precautions. The day before the parade is not a good time to try new foods.
- Bring food for pre performance time.
- Watch your coat, props, etc., like a hawk. Don't bring your purse.
- Wear performance hat and full costume to the parade/show
- No drinks on parade route
- NO photography allowed during performances except by RHM photographer and recorder.
- First aid team will have emergency supplies
- Our photographer will take individual photos pre performance as time allows
- Let's make sure to get a group shot in costume

EN ROUTE AT PARADE TIME

- Guide right.
- Hold spacing no matter what.
- Performance face all the time and learn to look up at the people.
- Enjoy the moment. Be present in it. This is our once in a lifetime Irish day!
- Due to liability issues, NO touching audience No hi-fives. Don't let them touch you.

END OF PARADE/SHOW

- TAKE 10 MINUTES TO BE HAPPY, ENJOY EACH OTHER AND CELEBRATE. Hug. Scream. Do the happy dance. Please don't start immediately working. Take time to be "in" the moment. If someone tells you to get busy working, don't do it until you have had your celebration.
- Then...undecorate and load up. Of course, we will be in another culture, so our plans may have to be altered for circumstances. We are not in Kansas anymore. ©
- First Aid team will ensure we have water after performances.

Travel Tips And Information



When cast in a road show role, performers become part of a professionally styled entertainment company going to a contracted engagement. Each event requires specified entertainment, appearances and media coverage from the RHM's. Sometimes it can be very challenging to travel, make costumes, get dressed, put on a happy face and perform, but it is always a valuable theatrical learning experience, and it is always followed by free time to giggle. Remember: life, as we know it, waits for us when we return home from these over-the-rainbow experiences.

This section of the manual addresses standard operating procedure while on the road for a RHM performance. It covers attire, conduct, compensation, expenses, performer obligation and free time. This is meant to inform and clarify to enable everyone to have a great time stirring things up, while leaving the impression of wholesome wackiness in our wake.

CONDUCT

Mama conduct as presented in this manual applies. Never any excessive alcohol, etc., while in performance costumes. Smoking only as needed and discreetly out of sight. While in RHM traveling attire or days wearing RHM identifiable gear (t-shirts, foo-foos) have a gregariously good time, while being moderate with consumptions. (Chocolate excluded)

COMPENSATION

Compensation is the joy of participation and being part of an organization that spreads joy and goodwill to others. Leadership negotiates with event organizers for assistance with things like lodging, transportation, souvenirs, sound equipment and vehicles, carts, media coverage, etc. These compensations vary with each event.


TO BRING ON THE TRIP

- Your costume as per issued costume check sheet
- If you have attended the optional show numbers rehearsals, bring additional costumes for your numbers.
- Safety pins
- All stuff for your team assignments
- FLIGHT CARRY-ON ITEMS: Your carry-on bag containing full *entire* costume and décor items in adherence to current airline criteria. In addition to the one carry-on item, most airlines allow one personal item such as: purse; briefcase; laptop/computer (cannot be checked); camera case; diaper bag; an item of a similar size or smaller size to these listed, but check your airline requirements. Keep a copy of your ID, credit card, and medical release/information in your carryon bag.
- Keep copy of your ID, credit card, and medical release/information on the right side of your body at all times. This is where emergency personnel will be directed for information.
- F needed, pack glue guns, sticks, plug strips and extension cords in checked bag.
- SECURITY WILL BE TIGHT! No scissors, glue guns, long pins, questionable security items in your carryon or on your person. Don't wear jewelry with long pins.

WHAT TO WEAR WHILE TRAVELING ON THE TRIP

Because we often perform along the way in airports etc. take many photos, and it's a lot of fun, we dress in RHM travel attire. Mamas who choose not to dress in RHM travel attire are choosing to step out of any performances and photos without grimace.

- Always modest. NO belly skin, short skirts, upper or lower cleavage.
- To honor our Irish hosts, and avoid anything other than positivity as we travel during St. Patrick's Festival week, traveling/trip attire is mainly **GREEN**. Wear black, silver, gold, green, blue. Red and orange can be seen as controversial, offensive or disrespectful to wear during the St. Patrick's Festival in Irish culture, so we won't.
- Green themed RHM logowear or other black, silver, gold, blue or green green tops without other logos.
- All clothing must meet RHM SOP for modesty. Foo foos, bangles and jewels in same colors. The trip is designated a "green" trip.
- A travel headpiece. Colors are any combination of, green, silver, gold, black, white.
- General guidelines for all travelwear:
- NO MARDI GRAS COLORS (purple, green and gold worn together)
- NO solid WHITE or BLACK. (bad when mixed in group photos and TV)
- NO NATURAL COLORED STRAW HATS THAT SHOW. (too blah)
- NO logowear from any other organization
- NO suggestive apparel or graphics. All mom and apple pie.



Snow, rain showers, sun as it is a transition time of year. Bring comfortable shoes, a sweater, clothes you can layer, gloves, scarf, headgear, an umbrella and an all-weather coat. Fancy duds for outings as you wish.

ON THE MOTORCOACH

- Our chartered motor coach will have set times of departure. You must be there and check in with Trip Coordinator 15 minutes prior to all departures or be left behind.
- When loading the chartered motor coach to hotel and parade, we have to ask the front 2 seats on the left and right be made available for tour guides and RHM leadership as they need to communicate with the driver and each other along the way.
- On our tour days, just one front seat is needed so Director is able to communicate with the driver/guide.

MEDICAL RELEASE and PHOTO I.D. OR DRIVERS LICENSE

Suggest keeping copy of ID, credit card, and medical information on right side of body/attire with you at all times. In event of emergency, this is where emergency responders will be directed for your information.

SECURITY TIPS FROM LAW ENFORCEMENT FRIENDS

"Dorothy, we're not in Kansas anymore". Traveling in groups of 3 or more is recommended. Don't walk anywhere late at night. Look and observe street names. Be aware of surroundings. This can save valuable time when calling for assistance. Do not flash large sums of money. Do not carry large amounts of money. Suggest using one credit card and leaving the rest at home. Do not carry a purse with long straps or without zip closure. Do not bring expensive jewelry. Keep credit card in sight when using. Never go with someone, male or female, who claims to need assistance. Always keep security lock on hotel door in use. Check peephole before opening or leaving room. Don't give your camera to strangers to take your picture. Thieves look for individuals who are not paying attention to surroundings, distracted

by others or with the sights they are viewing. PAY ATTENTION, LOOK ALERT! These are not meant to "frighten" you but to make you aware of some things to think about while traveling. While there surely are more security tips to be offered, mostly you'll want to have good ole common sense in your travels.



TRAVELING AND BLOOD CLOTS IN THE LEGS

This information contributed by RHM medical professional buddies.



In the news the last several years there has been items referring to blood clots developing in the deep veins in the legs while sitting for long time in cramped seats. This is known as Economy Class Syndrome. An individual traveling moves less, causing circulation decrease, which allows blood to collect and form a clot. The clot can cause pain and swelling in the leg. The danger is when the blood clot breaks loose and travels to the heart or lung. High Risk: Previous history of blood clot. Medium Risk: Cancer, recent surgery, obesity, diabetes, age and heart disease. Low Risk: Everyone.

Some Suggestions

- 1. Wear loose-fitting comfortable clothes during the flight.
- 2. Eat small meals and drink plenty of fluids.
- 3. Hydration: The dry air in aircraft causes dehydration. Drink plenty of water. Water is better than coffee, tea and fruit juices. Avoid alcohol and caffeine during travel as they contribute to dehydration.
- 4. Do not cross your legs while seated and adjust your position every half hour.
- 5. You may want to wear elastic support hose if you are at medium or high risk.
- 6. Try to walk up and down the aisle at least once an hour or stand in front of your seat shaking your legs once an hour.
- 7. Exercises to do for 15 seconds, once an hour:
 - a. Ankle rotations: Draw a circle with your toes, rotating clockwise then counterclockwise with both feet
 - b. Foot pumps: Slowly alternate between flexing and pointing your toes.
 - c. Leg lifts: With knee bent, lift leg up off the seat and hold a few seconds. Alternate.
 - d. Head and shoulder rotation: Gently roll your head right and then left, keeping your shoulders relaxed. Then gently roll your shoulders forwards and backwards.
 - e. Toe reach: Slowly bend forward. Extend your arms toward your toes. Sit back up.

Techniques for Reducing Jet Lag

Before departing, make sure all you affairs, business and personal, in order. Ensure you are not stressedout with excitement or worry, and not tired. Get plenty of exercise prior to departure, try to avoid flu's, colds, etc. Get a good night's sleep just prior to departure.

Everywhere we go, constantly thank and compliment others, EVEN IF YOU DON'T THINK THEY DESERVE IT.

We are thankful we don't get what we deserve while on a hormonal rampage some days!!

St. Patrick's Day History

To get us gabbing. Not documented facts.

St. Patrick's Day, celebrated every year on March 17, has become synonymous with shamrocks, the color green, pinching, and plenty of guilt-free alcohol imbibing. But the holiday, commemorated in today's green and shamrock- has a long, rich religious history.

The tradition goes all the way back to St. Patrick, who is credited with bringing Catholicism to Ireland. For centuries, his memory was honored with a feast and a trip to church.

Who was St. Patrick?

St. Patrick's story begins as a young man in the fifth century, when at age 16 he was kidnapped from his British home by Irish raiders and taken as a slave to Gaelic Ireland.

It's a grim beginning to a story that would shape Ireland's national holiday. But while captive in Ireland, working as a shepherd, Patrick "found God," who instructed him to escape to the Irish coast, where a ship would be waiting to ferry him home. What happened next is unclear — he either went straight back to Britain or took a detour through France.

What we do know is that he became a Catholic priest and eventually returned to Ireland, where he spent much of the rest of his life proselytizing to pagan Irishmen.

You may wonder why the **shamrock** is so deeply associated with this holiday. It's because in his missionary work, St. Patrick supposedly used the clover to explain the holy trinity. Because he was one of the **first missionaries** sent to the country, he spent much time in its western and northern reaches. Deeply associated with the Catholic Church structure there, he ordained priests, divided the country into dioceses, and founded several monasteries. The mark he left on the country grew in legend over centuries, and now he is considered one of the country's foremost saints. The Irish people remember him each March 17, the day it is said he died. It's unclear whether St. Patrick's body is buried in Ireland, as legend has it. But while he

was still alive, the man often said he was willing to die in Ireland so that his mission might prove

successful.

In Ireland, St. Patrick's Day is not only a time for celebration but also a religious experience. Since the beginning of the 17th century, it has been celebrated as an official religious holiday on the Catholic calendar. The country's banks and other businesses close down, and most Irish chizans attend Mass to give thanks for missionaries working around the world.

Because it's a happy occasion, the Catholic restrictions on eating and drinking during Lent are also temporarily restricted. That might be why drinking, the most indulgent of pursuits, has come to be associated with the holiday.


Even so, the day remained a primarily religious occasion at least through the start of the 20th century, when Ireland — in a show of patriotism — added an annual military parade that ran through the streets of Dublin, Ireland's capital.

But it was not until the 1960s that the parade was transformed into a spectacle primarily meant to entertain. And as a sign of the times, bars actually remained closed on St. Patrick's Day until this decade.

A few other traditions

These traditions are less steeped in history, but they're worth knowing anyway – especially if you want to celebrate the saint properly yourself.

- **Eating corned beef and cabbage:** This is actually more of an American than Irish tradition. It dates back to the 19th century, when most Irish Americans were poor and could only afford the cheapest meat possible, corned beef. As for cabbage, it's most likely included simply because it's a spring vegetable.
- Drowning the shamrock: Simply place a clover at the bottom of your cup, fill with Guinness or Irish whiskey, and drink up. It's up to you whether you'd like to eat the shamrock or chuck it over your shoulder for good luck.
- Wearing green: Actually, this color association is kind of a fluke. Originally, the original color of St. Patrick's Day was blue. But for several reasons, green prevailed. Ireland is often referred to as the Emerald Isle, and its flag displays a green stripe. Irish Catholics typically wear green (Irish Protestants typically wear orange, the other prominent color on the Irish flag). And, of course, shamrocks are green, giving the color an added advantage. Red can be interpreted as being pro-British and may be offensive in some venues. Orange is controversial and may cause negativity in same areas.
- Pinching others who are not wearing green: Rumor has it that leprechauns who are most often imagined wearing green getups pinch those around them who are not sporting similarly green apparel. That has evolved into humans pinching each other to display the disapproval we think the leprechauns would be showing. You won't be surprised to know that this, too, is a largely American tradition. The Irish leprechauns of yore didn't even wear green. But that won't stop strangers from taking a pinch, so choose your outfit wisely.



MEDIA BASICS

It is quite likely you will be approached by interested people and possibly reporters. It is always safe to talk about yourself, family, job, how excited you are for the trip, and the basic information on the media handouts. Don't answer for the group, or make "we" statements. If you get confused or flustered, point out a spokesmodel to the reporter, or call one over. When in doubt, our motto says it all! Just tell them our motto.

SPOKESMODELS: Mikki, Karen, Deborah, Christy, Pam, Others TBD

Spokesmodels are to know the info sheet and be alert for reporters talking to gals who are not comfortable. Go to their side. Jump in *IF* they freeze, or if a question is asked that you should answer, but *NEVER* be rude or pushy.


