The Mobilize posting has options to sign up for 9-11am and/or 11-1pm on all four days of Labor Day Weekend (Fri through Mon).

Lodi's event is part of a coordinated effort across multiple organizations to have banners This is in coordination with Mobilize.us. The expectation at that time was that there would be overpass banners along Hiway 99 from Lodi to Fresno, as well as on Hiway 5 from Mexico to Oregon.
