GRANT TO YOUR SERVANTS THAT WITH ALL BOLDNESS THEY MAY SPEAK YOUR WORD

The first part of 2018 has been busy with a renewed focus on Oasis of Love church and leadership training. The theme of the missions' conference this year was "Hold Fast". Notably when you read the entire scripture, this is not at all a scripture accepting defeat. The New International Version of Hebrews 10:23 says it this way: *Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.* Or as Acts 4:29 & 30 declares in the face of adversity and persecution: *"Grant to your servants that with all boldness they will speak your Word³⁰ by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."*

There is no place in the bible where you will see that God leaves us with an expectation of defeat in the face of adversity, persecution, or any other hardship. Instead, 2nd Corinthians 2:14 holds this promise: *But I thank God, who always leads us in victory because of Christ. Wherever we go, God uses us to make clear what it means to know Christ. If we look only at the circumstances in this world, we see that sin has become worse and worse.
