



Dog First Aid Checklist

- ☐ Hypoallergenic gloves
- ☐ Syringe/Eye dropper to flush wounds OR give oral meds
- ☐ Sterile gauze rolls
- ☐ Non-stick bandages to secure gauze in place
- ☐ Neosporin
- ☐ Styptic powder to stop light wounds from bleeding
- ☐ Benadryl cap/tab 25mg (1 per 12 to 25 lbs every 8 to 12 hrs) to treat allergies from insects. Include only if approved by your veterinarian
- ☐ Bee sting wipes
- ☐ Saline eye solution OR artificial tear gel
- ☐ Thermometer
- ☐ Petroleum jelly to lubricate thermometer
- ☐ Tweezers & Scissors
- ☐ Hydrogen Peroxide 3% USP used for wound cleansing OR to induce vomiting. Always contact your veterinarian or ASPCA Animal Poison Control Center (888-426-4435) consultation fee may apply
