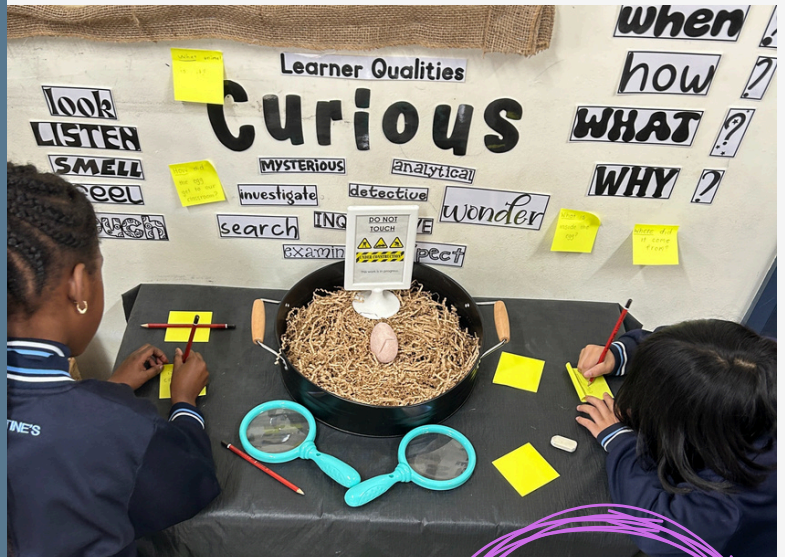


# THE LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

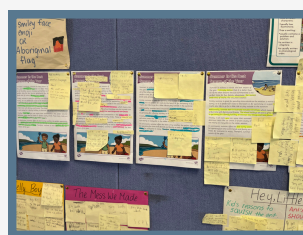
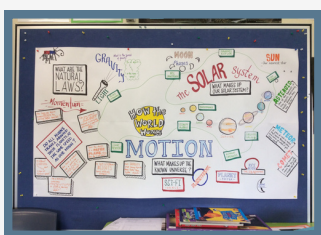
