# COLLABORATION IS KEY WORKING TOGETHER

Every year, the Fraternal Order of Eagles and its Auxiliaries bring members for the same reason – **fighting within our Aeries and Auxiliaries.**



Whether that fighting is between Aerie and Auxiliary members, or between members within each of the sides, it is indisputable that a lack of collaboration continues to stifle our potential as a whole.



Roughly 82% of our dropped members each year mention turmoil or politics as a reason they're choosing to leave the organization.



When we let these problems linger, they have lasting effects that can lead to some cases, permanent closure of our Aerie homes.



The most successful locations are the ones where we see Aerie and Auxiliaries that work together, respect each others opinions, and primarily focus on the mission to support the Aerie/Auxiliary and stopping to air off issues before it's too late.



**FOSTERING A POSITIVE ENVIRONMENT** that encourages collaboration and communication can be achieved in many ways, but here are a few:



**JOINT MEETINGS**  
Hold regular joint meetings between the Aerie and Auxiliaries to discuss goals, share updates, and work on future plans together. Give members an avenue to converge and discuss issues that lead to misunderstandings, gossip, or games of telephone that lead to misinterpreted messaging.

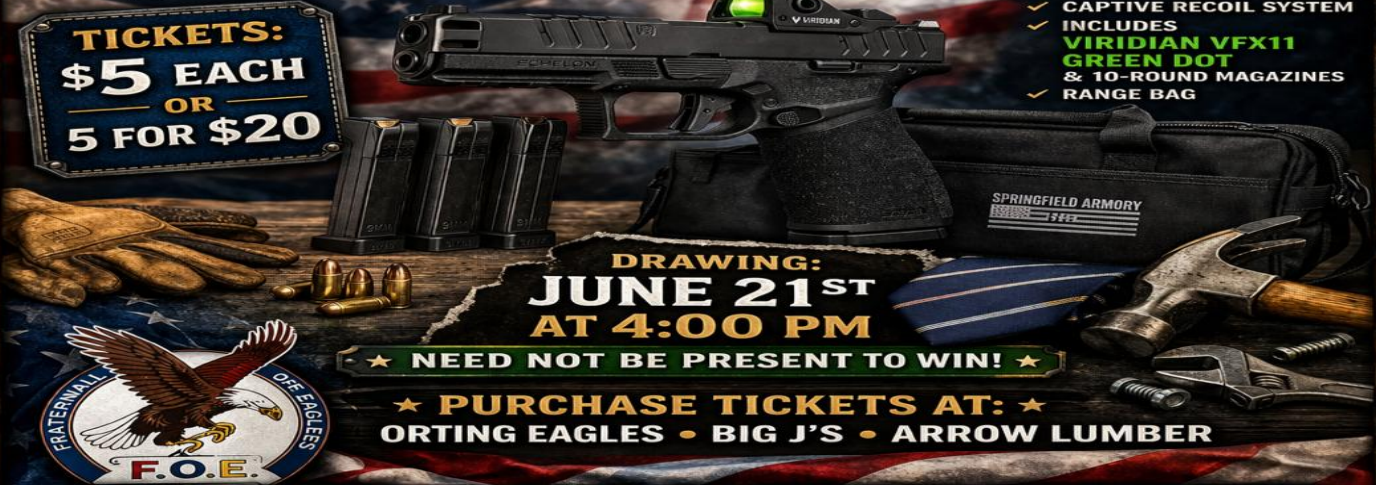
