Wednesday March 30, 2022, at 7pm - A Concert Exploring Jesuit Composers of the Bolivian Baroque Period in the Chapel of Jesuit High School, 4701 N. Himes Ave. Tampa, Fl. The Intermediate Chorus, Advanced Chorus, Chamber Orchestra, and Band will present newly discovered compositions of Domenico Zipoli (1688-1726). Zipoli, who was born in Italy, studied with Scarlatti, and served the Jesuit Church in Rome before becoming a missionary to South America. He became the foremost composer of beginner and intermediate level keyboard and choral music that was designed to teach the most basic building blocks of Western music to the indigenous population, and ultimately create the musical forces to perform the music of the church throughout present day Argentina, Paraguay, and Bolivia.
