2023 Middle School & High School Organ Festival & Competition - Winston-Salem, NC The application deadline is December 16 which includes a recording and online application. Those not accepted into the competition are still invited and encouraged to attend the workshops and masterclasses.

#### Advanced Division Recording Requirements:

A Bach Prelude (or Toccata or Fantasy) & Fugue (excluding the "8 Little") or two movements from a trio sonata or concerto One or more contrasting movement(s) from a single work in the 19th - 20th/21st century repertories A hymn (introduction and two stanzas) chosen from the Competition Hymns

Intermediate Division Recording Requirements:

A baroque Prelude (or Toccata or Fantasy including Bach's "8 Little") by any composer One contrasting movement or work from another era

A hymn (introduction and one stanza) chosen from the Competition Hymns

Entry into the competition as well as recitals, workshops, masterclasses, lessons, and two meals are included in the entry fee.
