

About this project



The focus of this project is a true story occurring in real-time. One of the main themes in the story deals with a family who conspire to defraud an adopted sibling of a sizeable inheritance left to him by the family matriarch.

The story also tells how **Vatican** officials helped the family steal the inheritance for lack of transparency and a desire to hide the misdeeds of several clergy guilty of crimes against children. Because of this lack of transparency on the part of the Vatican, the siblings involved in stealing the adopted son's inheritance, never find out that they too were left a sizeable inheritance, but in a different trust fund that was started decades ago by the family matriarch's employer. There is a catch however, in this second trust, the adopted son is the one named as the trust executor, and the "siblings," must adhere to rules set out in the trust that only the executor knows anything about.

The bulk of the story takes place in the past, however the final chapter of the writings (still in progress,) will give a full accounting of how and why the family took advantage of an individual who had been traumatized and victimized by powerful institutions.
