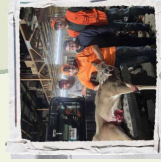


CREATING ADVENTURES AND LONG LASTING MEMORIES

Empowered Dream Hunts Inc. provides opportunities for Veterans, Hometown Heroes, and Outdoor Enthusiasts to enjoy the outdoors. Various options are available.

Non-Fenced Whitetail Hunt



This option provides taxidermy and assistance with processing of the meat. Hunting land and a guide are provided. Average cost: \$500-\$1000.

Fenced Whitetail Hunt



This option provides a guided hunt, lodging, meals, taxidermy, and assistance with processing of the meat. Average cost: \$5000-\$10,000.

Wild Turkey Hunt



This option provides hunting land, guide, use of hunting equipment, and assistance with processing of meat. Average cost : \$100-\$200.

Create Your Own Experience



This option provides a self-driven adventure with the use of an Action Trackchair and other adaptive hunting equipment.

Eligibility Requirements for an Empowered Dream Hunts Inc. Supported Adventure:

- Residency & Age
 - Participant must be a Wisconsin resident.
 - Participant must be age 10 through adult.
- Hunting Participation & Background
 - Participant must have participated in a 9-Day Disabled Gun Hunt or a Youth Hunt.
 - Participant must be able to pass a background check to legally own and use a firearm.
 - If you are unable to use a firearm, this must be disclosed during the application process.
 - Completion of a Hunter's Safety Course is required.
 - A medical waiver confirming ability to safely participate may be requested.
 - Participant will need an accompanying caregiver (if applicable).
 - Parental permission and supervision during adventure for those under 18 years old.
- Personal Circumstances
 - Participant must have a qualifying medical diagnosis.
 - Or, participant must be directly affected by the loss of someone in the line of duty.
- A hunting companion is strongly encouraged.
- Participants must arrange their own transportation to and from the hunt.

Program Expectations:

Candidates are asked to "Pay It Forward" by actively participating in fundraising efforts or sponsorship outreach.

Past recipients help future families—financially or emotionally—so that each hunt becomes a meaningful and memorable experience.

All candidates must complete an in-person interview with Empowered Dream Hunts Inc. personnel.

Empowered Dream Hunts Inc. understands that not every outdoor adventure fits within the time and resources we have available. We appreciate your understanding as we work to provide meaningful experiences for as many individuals as we can.
