Tax statements will be made available beginning on January 2, 2019. There is a sign-up sheet in the foyer. Please allow a week to process these requests.

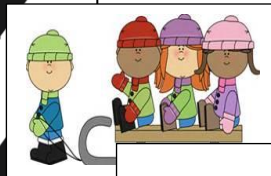
February Events:
