Specified Price Caps

A Maximum Unit Price of 52 p/kwh.

- Maximum Monthly Metering Charges
 - \circ £3.43 for a single-phase meter.
 - £4.65 for a three-phase meter

 Maximum Monthly Standby Charge For "Own-Generators" of £5/kw

Determination Of The Maximum Unit Price (52 p/kwh)

- Formula:
- Pcap (p/kwh) = [AFCC OR] / FC + [FFCC] + K
- AFFC = Allowed Fixed Cost Component
- OR = Other Revenues
- FC = Forecast Consumption
- FFCC = Forecast Fuel Cost Component
- K = Correction Factor

Regulatory Asset Values (RAV) (As At 1st October 2025)

• Existing Assets RAV = £362,545

• Replacement Generator RAV = £25,909

Existing Assets Fully Paid For By October 2030

Replacement Generator Fully Paid For By October 2027

Removal Of The "Legal Levy" (40 p/kwh)

- To pre-fund a judicial review of Chief Pleas' decision to compulsory purchase SEL.
- 40p/kwh = £47,000 per month, up to £600k needed.

Reasons For Rejection:

- Not a cost that needs to be incurred to supply electricity.
- Risk that fund would be used to settle historic legal debts with Collas Crill, in the first instance.
- No Efficiency Incentive

Removal of "Consultation Levy" (20 p/kwh)

- To pre-fund the cost of professional services support to respond to consultations.
- Amounts to c£23,000 per month, up to £100k needed.

Reasons For Rejection:

- £20,000 per year already allowed for such professional services in the unit price cap.
- Risk that fund would be used to settle historic legal debts with Collas Crill, inthe first instance.
- No Efficiency Incentive
- SEL did not make any written or verbal representations on the two September consultations.


Adjustments
