## **Electricity Price Increase From 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026**

The maximum unit price that Sark Electricity Limited (“SEL”) can charge for electricity will increase from 56 p/unit to 62 p/unit from the 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026.

The maximum unit price in the Price Control Order is set at 52 p/kwh but this can be adjusted monthly to account for changes in demand and fuel prices compared to the original forecast.

There are two key reasons for this increase.

First, fuel prices in March 2026 were 54% higher than the forecast in the price control order. This accounts for 75% of the price increase.

Second, consumption in March 2026 was 9% lower than the forecast in the price control order. This accounts for 21% of the price increase.

It is not possible to say for sure what will happen to prices in the months ahead because we do not know for certain what future demand and fuel prices will be. However, international fuel prices are still volatile due to the war in the Middle-East, and this may continue to feed through to electricity prices in Sark.
