Email the completed form to Dr. Pierce-Davis. She will set up an appointment with you for a meeting via Zoom. You will spend an hour with the doctor. She will ask you questions about your family, fertility, medical history, your plans and preparations for starting or expanding your family, and answer any questions you might have about the psychological effects of being a donor recipient or having carrier assisted pregnancy.

She will prepare a report/letter to your fertility specialist and provide you with copies.

Screening for Gestational Carrier Assisted Or Known Egg/Sperm Donor Recipient

Screening begins with an email to Dr. Pierce-Davis, for:

- An initial screening appointment for the intended parent(s). This visit is described in the Screening information to the left.
- An appointment with the carrier/donor for clinical interview and psychological testing, all done virtually. In advance of the appointment, Dr. Pierce-Davis will provide the candidate with instructions for distance administration of MMPI-3, a packet of information to be completed by carrier candidate and spouse if applicable, in preparation for her session; and administration of the MMPI-3. After testing is completed, Dr. Pierce-Davis will meet virtually with the candidate and spouse if applicable, for clinical interview. Once all data is received and clinical interview is completed, she will write a complete Psychological Assessment report for your doctor and agency, if applicable.
- A one hour group appointment for all individuals involved, a counseling and question and answer session. After the session, Dr. Pierce-Davis is responsible for providing your fertility specialist with a summary of all topics discussed, as required by the American Society for Reproductive Medicine.
