We had six pontoons from PYC to assist in recovering the paratroopers from Lake Eustis after their drops. Approximately 165 veterans jumped out of the historic Tico Bell (of WW2 D-Day fame). Obviously, the water temperature was a bit cold, so it was imperative that we got these veterans out of the lake as soon as possible as well as recov-

ering their parachutes. Our club received some good recognition and publicity in a local newspaper. The PYC member pontoons which participated were: Karrels, Mest, Smith, Rhoads, Allen, and Williams. 


day morning, we gathered on 8 pontoon boats and floated on down the river to the scuba dive site area and watched the manatees and dolphins play. After a while we returned to the
