What attendees need to (or may want to) bring: It will be helpful to use a GPS for this event. 7 tubs with the letter cards will be at locations around Lake Harris. Collect one envelope for each word your boat is playing. Each card tub will be on a map of Lake Harris along with the GPS locations. Collect your 7 envelops, each envelope is marked 1 through 7. Do not open any envelopes until you bring them back to the Scrabble crew at Hickory Point docks where the Scrabble crew will document each letter for each word, any open envelops will be disqualified. You may take your letters back to your boat to create your words. There will be an 8th tub with letter cards that will be available if anyone was not able to find any of the 7 tubs on Lake Harris however each letter not found will cost you \$1/card.

Any restrictions regarding attendees? (e.g., members only, limited to 40, etc.)

Do not open envelopes until they are brought to the Scrabble crew at Hickory Point where you letter tiles will be documented.

Other information:

I anticipate it will take 1.5hrs to locate all your letters. If you do not have a GPS or do not know how to use one, you can follow someone who does have and knows how to use their GPS. This is not a timed event and only 7 tubs need to be located.

There will be 3 cash prizes to the highest word scores. Standard Scrabble rules apply. We will not be using a Scrabble board but there are 2x and 3x cards in each tub which will double or triple your word score if you receive one of these cards, you will have a max of six letters to create your word if you receive one of the double or triple cards.

All cash received will be distributed to the three top scores.
