I hope that by the time you read this that you are in a safe place. I hope you have secured your pontoon boat with extra lines and have removed your backdrop and bimini tops.



A Look Back in Time by Kay Weaver, Historian

April 15-18, 2004 Astor Trip on St. John's River - What a trip we had. Most of our members were at Blair's Jungle Den by 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 15th. After settling into the motel, we headed by water to Blackwater Inn for lunch on the second floor outside deck. It was a cool but beautiful day. We took a scenic trip on one of the tributaries north of there off the main river and saw some of the largest gators around - not one, but at least five in close proximity to one another-we are talking 12-14 feet and really fat ones (Picture 1). In the evening, we



gathered for a cookout in front of the north building on the water, Terry Weaver provided a new gas grill for cooking hot dogs, hamburgers and chicken and everyone else brought delicious food to share (Picture 2). Sondra & Kurt Kintzler, Dale & Judy Coon, Kay Weaver and Bob Ebel joined a group in the lounge for Karaoke at Blair's.
