My Best Friend's an Owl!

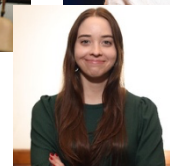
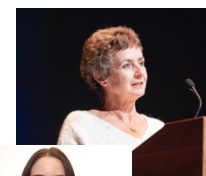
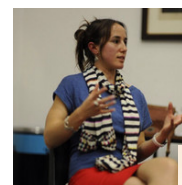

Behind the lens - Creating a Wildlife Filming Garden

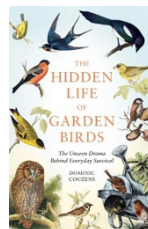

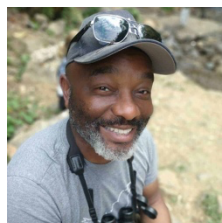
