- B. Section 15.02 of the Declaration permits amendment of the Declaration by a vote of the members of the Association.

- Section 4.10, Subparagraph L is amended by deleting that section in its entirety and replacing it with the following:
- 4.10 L. <u>Landscaping</u>. Native plants and/or drought tolerant plant species are encouraged, although not required, to be used for landscaping around proposed residences. Owners are encouraged, but not required, to retain existing Jeffery Pines where possible and other naturally occurring vegetation.
- 2. <u>Incorporation by Reference.</u> The provisions of the Declaration, except as expressly amended herein, are incorporated herein by this reference, and are expressly declared to be applicable to the Real Property, as described in Section 1.01 of the Declaration, and all real

property annexed to the Declaration, pursuant to Section 3.03 of the Declaration. Except as otherwise provided herein, all capitalized terms used in this Declaration of First Amendment shall have the same meanings as set forth in the Declaration.

3. <u>Effective Date.</u> This Declaration of Fourth Amendment is effective as of <u>October 10</u>, 2006, the date of its certification by the Association Secretary as having been regularly and duly adopted.
